I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: **Staff recommends motion to approve**: Amendment No. 4 to the contract with Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc. (R-2016-0430) in the amount of \$477,518 for the Main Detention Center (MDC) East and West Tower exterior painting establishing a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for construction management services for the period of 210 days or until project is completed.

Summary: This Amendment authorizes Hedrick Brothers Construction to prepare, caulk and weatherseal the exterior walls and doors of the east and west towers at the Main Detention Center. The duration of construction is 210 days. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal established by the SBE Ordinance for this contract is 15%. Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc.'s SBE participation for this Amendment is 67%. Including this Amendment, Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc.'s overall SBE participation is 61.6%. This Amendment will be funded from Countywide Building Repair/Replacement funds (Ad Valorem). Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc. is a Palm Beach County business and it is anticipated that 100% of the work will be performed by Palm Beach County businesses. (Capital Improvements Division) Countywide/District 2 (LDC)

Background and Justification: Construction Manager (CM) at Risk is a project delivery method in which the CM provides design phase assistance, evaluation of cost, schedule and implications of alternate designs, systems and materials, and serves as general contractors issuing the subcontracts for construction. Hedrick was selected on April 5, 2016 via a RFP issued for both the Main Detention Center Electronics Renewal Replacement Project and the Detention Facilities Renewal/Replacement Project. The two major projects were combined as a result of; 1) concurrent work requirements, 2) to eliminate duplicative and contractor general costs; 3) to reduce the probability of repetitive extraordinary security awareness/training required for construction crew, and to set performance accountability with a single contractor. This amendment is for a portion of Phase III and Phase IV of the Detention Facilities Renewal/Replacement Program being moved forward as a priority due to water infiltration into both buildings.



AMENDMENT #4

HEDRICK BROTHERS CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. TO CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK SERVICES

MAIN DETENTION CENTER (MDC) EAST AND WEST TOWER EXTERIOR PAINTING PROJECT NO. 15218 DISTRICT #2

This Amendment No. 4 is for Construction Management Services for construction activities associated with the MDC East and Wet Tower Exterior Painting project located on Gun Club Road in West Palm Beach.

Construction services shall include the cleaning, preparing, caulking and weathersealing of the exterior walls and doors of the West and East Towers.

Construction services are required to provide painting, caulking and weathersealing of the exterior walls of the east and west towers due to water infiltration into the buildings.

The SBE goal for this contract is 15%. Construction Manager anticipates providing 67% SBE participation in this Amendment.

CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK SERVICES MAIN DETENTION CENTER (MDC) EAST AND WEST TOWER EXTERIOR PAINTING PROJECT NO. 15218

This Amendment is made as of ______ by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as Owner, and Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Construction Manager".

WHEREAS, the Owner and Construction Manager acknowledge and agree that the Contract between Owner and Construction Manager dated 04/05/16 (R2016-0430) (hereinafter the Contract) is in full force and effect and that this Amendment incorporates all the terms and conditions of the Contract as may be supplemented and amended by this Amendment.

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated a Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Project, including the Construction Manager's fees calculated in accordance with the terms of the Contract, whereby the Construction Manager will render construction and warranty services and other services as set forth herein and in the Contract;

NOW THEREFORE, in exchange for the mutual covenants and promises set forth herein and the sums of money agreed to be paid by the Owner to the Construction Manager, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Construction Manager's Representations. The Construction Manager represents that:

The Construction Manager, Trade Contractors, Sub-subcontractors, material and equipment suppliers have compared Phasing, Demolition, Architectural, Structural, Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing, Civil and Site Drawings and Specifications and have compared and reviewed all general and specific details on the Drawings and that all conflicts, discrepancies, errors and omissions, which are within the commonly accepted knowledge base of a licensed general contractor, subcontractor, trades persons, manufacturers or other parties required to carry out the Work involved in this Amendment, have been corrected or clarified prior to execution of this GMP Amendment to the Contract, and therefore Construction Manager warrants that the GMP (exclusive of contingency) includes the cost of correcting all conflicts, discrepancies, errors, or omissions which Construction Manager identified, or should have identified through the exercise of reasonable skill and care, during the preconstruction phase of the Project.

The Construction Manager's review and comparison of all Drawings has taken into consideration the total and complete functioning of all systems and therefore the Construction Manager represents that the GMP represents the total cost for complete and functional systems.

- 3. Guaranteed Maximum Price. Pursuant to Section 2.2 and Article 6 of the Contract between Owner and Construction Manager, the parties have agreed to a Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$477,518.00 for the construction costs of the Project. The GMP is based on the following: Exhibit A.
- **4. Schedule of Time for Completion.** The time of completion for this Amendment will be as follows: The Construction Manager shall substantially complete the work within **210** calendar days from the Notice to Proceed from Owner. Liquidated Damages are \$309.00/day for failure to achieve certification of substantial completion within the contract time or approved extension thereof.
- **5.** Attachments. The following attachments are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference:

6. Except as specifically modified herein, the Contract remains in full force and effect. All capitalized terms herein shall have the same meaning as set forth in the Contract.
