## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title:** Staff recommends motion to approve: a Contract with Insituform Technologies, LLC, (IT) for the Palm Beach County Sanitary Sewer Collection System Rehabilitation Project Phase 1 (Project) in the amount of \$3,713,242.30.

Summary: On April 4, 2018, three (3) bids were received for the Project, which provides for the rehabilitation of wastewater gravity pipelines, manholes and associated service laterals. The lowest bidder, Ric-Man Construction Florida, Inc. (RM), did not meet the minimum experience requirement specified in the bid document. As a result, RM's bid was determined to be non-responsible. As the second lowest bidder, IT was determined to be the lowest responsible and responsive bidder for the Project. RM subsequently filed a bid protest claiming that the experience requirements were properly met per the requirements of the solicitation. On June 26, 2018, the Director of Purchasing recommended the bid protest be denied. RM then proceeded with a Request for a Hearing before a Special Master. On October 9, 2018, the Special Master recommended the bid protest be denied. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation goal established by the 2002 SBE Ordinance under which this Project was solicited, is 15% overall. The Contract with IT provides for 0.6% SBE participation, as one of the sub-contractors was found to not qualify as an SBE at the time of bid. IT is not a Palm Beach County Company. IT's headquarters are located in Chesterfield, Missouri. The Project is in the FY19 Water Utilities Department (WUD) budget. (WUD Project No. 15-098A) Countywide (MJ)

**Background and Justification:** WUD is currently undertaking the rehabilitation of aging wastewater gravity infrastructure throughout the WUD's service area as it is approaching its life expectancy. The work provided by the Project includes the rehabilitation of eight (8) lift station service basins. Approximately 50,000 linear feet of gravity sewer pipe, 150 manholes and 1,400 lateral services will be rehabilitated with Cure-In-Place lining and point repair. This rehabilitation of existing collection system infrastructure will improve the service level and extend system reliability.


