Emergency operating expenses for evacuations, temporary emergency service, disaster preparation, and repairs due to Hurricane Irma, Palm Beach County went into Level 2 activation status at 7:00 AM on Thursday, September 7, 2017 through Wednesday September 13.

Project Benefits

Fixed Route and Paratransit Services provided by Palm Tran after a declared emergency, facilitated Palm Beach County residents hurricane preparation, evacuation, safety return and mitigation activities after the Hurricane. Palm Tran provided 2,371 Fixed Route trips and 2,342 Paratransit trips. After the emergency, Palm Tran assisted with the evacuation of animals shelters, and the provision of temporary services to allow County residents to apply for the Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) which gives food assistance to low-income households with food loss or damage caused by a natural disaster.

Location Description

Palm Tran, Inc. provides public transit service in Palm Beach County, Florida. Palm Tran has several "facilities" located throughout Palm Beach County that include administrative services; bus, relief vehicle and employee parking; and maintenance operations. Maintenance Facilities are located in the cities of West Palm Beach, Delray Beach and Belle Glade. Palm Tran serves 3,200 bus stops with 34 Fixed Routes that cover Palm Beach County as far north as the Town of Jupiter and as far south as the City of Boca Raton. One route travels to the rural western boundary of the County where it

connects with a circulator route that serves the communities of Belle Glade, Pahokee Canal Point and South Bay. Palm Beach County is one of the three counties in South Florida that make up the Miami metropolitan area (Miami-UZA). There are 39 incorporated municipalities within Palm Beach County including Boca Raton, Delray Beach and the largest city being West Palm Beach. The county has a total area of 2,383 square miles, Palm Beach County borders Martin County to the north, the Atlantic Ocean to the east, Broward County to the south, Hendry County to the west, and extends into Lake Okeechobee in the northwest.
