Summary: The FTA distributes Section 5307 funds to provide public transportation capital and operating assistance for public transportation-related projects. The FY2018 5307 allocation will fund items necessary for the continued operations of the Palm Tran system including: \$1,328,567 to replace buses that have reached their useful life; \$165,680 for the one-percent project security requirement; \$4,573,769 for facility rehabilitation and South County Expansion; \$2,000,000 for Fare Collection Equipment; and \$8,500,000 for preventive maintenance. FTA has authorized Palm Beach County the submittal of a Super-Grant application to consolidate the three (3) pending Section 5307 allocations for FY2016, FY2017, FY2018 and Flex funds for Fixed Route capital projects.

The FY2018 allocation has a match requirement of \$4,142,004 or 20% of the total project cost. The source of the matching funds are Toll Revenue Credits provided by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). The grant also requires execution of the Disclosure of Lobbying Activities, Form LLL. **No County funds are required.** Countywide (DR)

Background and Policy Issues: The FTA option to submit a Super Grant application provides recipients with the flexibility to include funding from multiple program sources when the funds are being used for the same capital improvement project. Palm Tran will include the funds listed on the POP for the South County Expansion and Fare-Collection equipment in two separate Super Grants that consolidate the funding for these projects.

Execution of the FTA award represents the County's legal affirmation to abide by FTA and other federal requirements as described in The Master Agreement FTA MA (24) dated October 1, 2017, approved by the Board on April 10, 2018 under item 3-AA1. The Master Agreement is incorporated by reference and made part of each FTA grant award, and amendment thereto. The Standard Form LLL is an FTA requirement when lobbying services are procured with non-federal funds. Palm Tran's 2019 budget included this grant in the amount of \$16,168,585. The budget amendment of \$399,431 reconciles the approved budget to the actual grant award.

The Program of Projects (POP) for Section 5307 FY2016 and FY2017 have been amended to increase the total amount of preventive maintenance that will be charged to the grant. Preventive maintenance, according to Federal Transit Administration (FTA) policy, is defined as all the activities, supplies, materials, labor, services and associated costs required to preserve or extend the functionality and serviceability of the asset in a cost effective manner.

In previous years, the BCC approved POP for FY2016 (R-2016-0822) and FY2017 (R-2018-0943), due to an application back-log at FTA these funds have not been obligated. The BCC approved the filing of the FTA application for Flex Funds on November 20, 2018 (Agenda Item 4.B.1.) Each designated recipient of Section 5307 program funds must certify that of the amount apportioned in a fiscal year, the recipients will expend at least one (1) percent on public transportation security projects.
