In cooperation with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, the Board of County Commissioners enacted the Home Caregiver Ordinance on October 20, 2015, as a way to curtail abuse, neglect, and exploitation of the elderly and disabled persons by home caregivers. The ordinance requires individuals who receive compensation from a vulnerable adult in exchange for assisting with covered activities and/or instrumental activities of daily living to undergo a level 2 criminal background screening. The Ordinance exempts most relatives of the vulnerable adult, volunteers of charitable organizations, and specific licensed professionals. Once processed and no disqualifying offenses are identified, applicants are licensed, issued a photo ID, and are available on the Division of Consumer Affairs website for the public to search.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION R-2016-0298, AND ESTABLISHING FEES AND FINES FOR THE HOME CAREGIVER ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Home Caregiver Ordinance codified at Chapter 17, Article XV of the Palm Beach County Code Ordinance was enacted on October 20, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Sections 17-464 and 17-466 of the Home Caregiver Ordinance provide that the ID badge fees, civil fines, administrative appeal filing fees, and fines for violations shall be established by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, R-2016-0298 establishes the current fee schedule of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the fee schedule established in 2016 does not generate sufficient revenues to recoup the costs of administering the program; and

WHEREAS, this resolution shall repeal and replace R-2016-0298 with an updated schedule of fines and fees.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1) The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2) Resolution R-2016-0298 establishing fees for the Home Caregiver Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced with this resolution.
- 3) The schedule of fees and fines set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, the Home Caregiver Schedule of Fees and Fines, is hereby approved and adopted and made a part of hereof.
