The County has expended or encumbered \$3,793,158 (\$361,253/month) during the previous ten and one half (10.5) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. \$4,152,442, which is the original amount of the contract, is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new twelve (12) month renewal term contract. Additionally, approval is requested to add/delete locations and services during the term of the contract. This term contract has three (3) twelve (12) month renewal options remaining. Awardee is located in Palm Beach County. The original bid was established by a competitive selection process. This contract was awarded to a vendor utilizing an SBE subcontractor; however the SBE subcontractor is no longer participating. The Goal Setting Committee has determined that this contract be rebid with a twenty percent (20%) S/M/WBE subcontracting goal. This contract is being renewed until such time as a new solicitation and award is made and will be terminated for convenience upon award of a new contract.

The County has expended or encumbered \$1,590,692 (\$227,242/month) during the previous seven (7) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. The Water Utilities Department requests an increase of \$1,090,900 over the previously authorized amount of \$1,750,100, inclusive of the Purchasing Director's ten percent (10%) authority, during the remaining five (5) months of the current term contract.
