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**I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt:** a Resolution to support the submittal of a Local Initiatives Program (LIP) grant application through the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) to the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for funding to construct 7' buffered bicycle lanes on Cresthaven Boulevard between Jog Road and Military Trail/S.R. 809 (Project); and to commit to fund the local share of project delivery and the associated ongoing operation and maintenance expenses.



**SUMMARY:** Adopting this Resolution will support Palm Beach County's (County) LIP application submittal for funding to construct the project on both sides of Cresthaven Boulevard for an approximate 2.1 mile segment. If selected, the proposed project will be built within the existing road right-of-way and the County will enter into a grant reimbursement agreement with the FDOT. As part of the application process, the TPA requires this resolution to support the LIP application submittal, and the County's commitment to fund design, construction management, and operation and maintenance of the project. The LIP grant will fund 100% of the project's construction at an estimated cost of \$3,916,325.91. The County's local participation funding for the project's design and construction management is estimated at \$758,509.88. Funding for Construction provided by the LIP will be programmed in 2024. **This project is partially funded through the infrastructure sales tax.** County surtax funds programmed in 2024 for resurfacing this segment of Cresthaven Boulevard in the amount of \$300,000 will offset the County's local participation funding. **Background and Justification:** The FDOT's LIP is a cost-reimbursement program where projects are submitted to the TPA for ranking and prioritization. This road segment is adjacent to residential communities, shopping centers, and Palm Tran routes and is in close proximity to public schools and parks. The project will enhance the safety of bicyclists along Cresthaven Boulevard between Jog Road and Military Trail/S.R. 809.

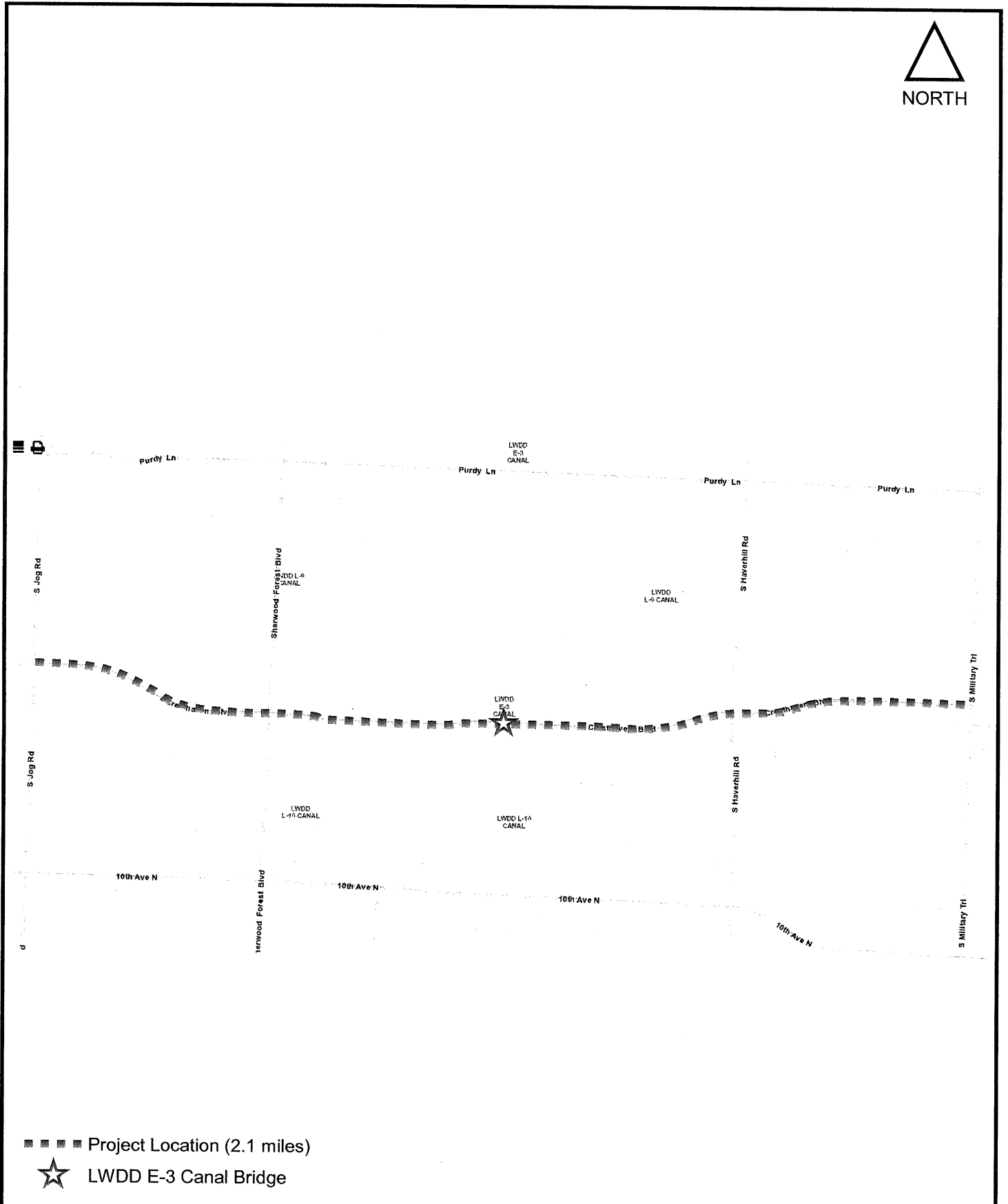

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-\_\_\_\_\_**

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION TO THE PALM BEACH TRANSPORTATION PLANNING AGENCY FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCAL INITIATIVES PROGRAM FOR FUNDING THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUFFERED BICYCLE LANES ON CRESTHAVEN BOULEVARD BETWEEN JOG ROAD AND MILITARY TRAIL/SR809; COMMITTING TO FUND THE LOCAL SHARE OF PROJECT DELIVERY AND THE ASSOCIATED ONGOING OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE EXPENSES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Palm Beach County (County) is eligible to apply for funding in an amount not to exceed \$5 million from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Local Initiatives Program (LIP) through the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA); and

**WHEREAS**, the County desires to make improvements to Cresthaven Boulevard (Road) between Jog Road and Military Trail/SR809 (Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project includes constructing 7' wide, buffered bicycle lanes on both sides of the Road, milling and resurfacing the Road, widening the Lake Worth Drainage District (LWDD) E-3 Canal bridge, and modifying or upgrading three traffic signals on the Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project will be constructed completely within County right-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, FDOT will reimburse the County only for the eligible construction costs associated with the Project in an amount not to exceed \$5 million; and

**WHEREAS**, eligible construction costs associated with the Project to be funded by the LIP is estimated at \$3,916,325.91; and

**WHEREAS**, the County's share of the Project's cost which will cover design and construction management is estimated at \$758,509.88; and

**WHEREAS**, the County's surtax funds programmed for resurfacing of the Road can be used to offset the County's share of the Project's cost; and

**WHEREAS**, after construction of the Project, the County agrees to appropriate such funds as may be necessary for the continued operation and maintenance of the Project.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
2. The County hereby supports the submittal of the application to the TPA for the LIP funding of the Project.
3. If the Project is selected for funding by the TPA, the County agrees to appropriate such funds as may be necessary to design the Project, to manage the construction of the Project, and to construct the Project.
4. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
