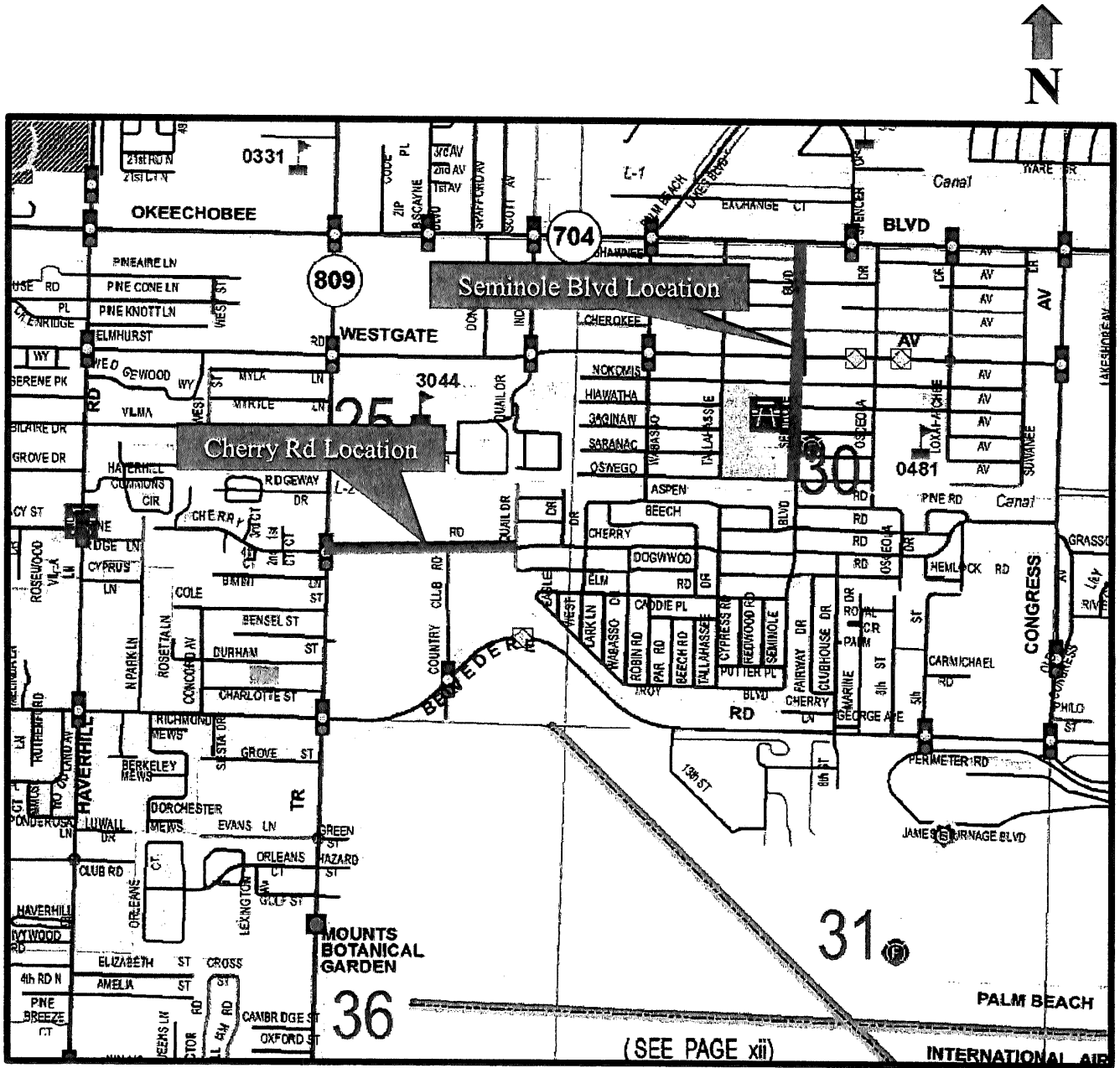


PROJECT LOCATION

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (BCC) OF PALM BEACH COUNTY (COUNTY), FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION TO THE PALM BEACH COUNTY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING AGENCY (TPA) FROM THE WESTGATE BELVEDERE HOMES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (WESTGATE CRA) FOR THE FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS, A MEDIAN AND STREETLIGHTS ON CHERRY ROAD BETWEEN MILITARY TRAIL AND QUAIL DRIVE IN THE BELVEDERE HOMES NEIGHBORHOOD.

WHEREAS, the Westgate CRA has identified a need to develop a complete streets project to install sidewalks, a median and streetlights on Cherry Road in the Belvedere Homes neighborhood (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Board of the Westgate Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency (Westgate CRA) has unanimously authorized the budgeting to provide funding for maintenance of the Project and any amounts not covered by the Federal Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant; and

WHEREAS, the Project qualifies for the TAP, a cost-reimbursement program where projects are submitted to the TPA for ranking and prioritization for funding; and

WHEREAS, the Westgate CRA has requested that the County, a certified agency for the Local Agency Program, sponsor the TAP grant application on its behalf; and

WHEREAS, the Westgate CRA will execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the County's Engineering Department for the implementation of the Project from its design through construction if it is approved by the TPA; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined execution of this Resolution to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the BCC of Palm Beach County, Florida, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Resolution.

The Westgate Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency Board has authorized its staff to budget funds to fully fund and maintain the above mentioned projects if the Transportation Planning Agency Transportation Alternatives Program (TPA TAP) grants are approved.

This letter is provided to affirm the Board decision to provide funding for the design, the construction and the maintenance of the projects to cover expenses that are not covered by the TPA TAP grant. Maintenance funds will be included in the CRA BCC-approved budget in future years after the projects are completed.

These projects will provide wider pathways and streetlights to enhance safety for pedestrians in the Westgate and Belvedere Homes area.
