I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) ratify the signature of the Mayor on a Waterways Assistance Program (WAP) grant application submitted to the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) on March 14, 2019, requesting \$125,000 to fund 50% of the planning, design and permitting cost associated with the redevelopment of the southern portion of Bert Winters Park; B) adopt a Resolution for Assistance under the FIND WAP for grant funding for planning, design and permitting of Bert Winters Park Phase IB in the amount of \$125,000; C) authorize the County Administrator or designee to execute the Grant Project Agreement, as well as task assignments, certifications, standard forms, or amendments to the Agreement that do not change the scope of work or terms and conditions of the Agreement, if the grant is approved; and D) authorize the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department to serve as the Project Director and E) authorize the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or designee to serve as Project Liaison.

Summary: The total cost of the project identified in the FIND WAP grant application is \$250,000. This grant application requests up to \$125,000 to fund up to (50%) of the planning, design and permitting costs associated with the redevelopment of the southern portion of Bert Winters Park. If the FIND grant is awarded, the County will provide matching funds using Infrastructure Sales Tax (IST) funding. Due to grant-related items requiring timely execution by the County, staff is requesting Board approval for the County Administrator or designee to approve grant documents and the Parks and Recreation Director to act as the Liaison Agent for this project, if this grant is approved by FIND. District 1 (AH)

Background and Justification: FIND offers grants to local governments through its WAP for public recreation projects directly related to its waterways. The County is requesting WAP funding to cover 50% of the planning, design and permitting cost associated with the redevelopment of the southern portion of Bert Winters Park.

FIND's timeframe for this application did not allow for prior approval by the Board of County Commissioners. In order to meet the grant application deadline, Mayor Bernard signed the application on behalf of the Board as authorized by Palm Beach County Administrative Code, Section 309.00. The code requires the grant application be presented to the Board for approval at their next available meeting after signature by the Mayor.



PROJECT NARRATIVE (Please summarize the project in space provided below in 2 paragraphs or less.)

The Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department is requesting \$125,000 in WAP funding to cover 50% of the planning, design and permitting required to redevelop the southern portion of Bert Winters Park (Phase 1B). In April 2013, the County acquired the one acre Palm Beach Marine Institute (PBMI) site with an old school building. The school will be razed by April 2020, as required by the WAP funding agreement. This portion of the park will be repurposed into a public use area with a large group shelter, waterfront walkway promenade, canoe/kayak launch, and additional parking. The day use docks will be renovated and the existing restroom will remain. The design consultant will also look at potential uses for the western portion of the site, this area is not included in the grant request. A waterfront area at the southern end of the park will be set aside for use by North Palm Beach Rowing Club, which offers public outreach events. The majority of the proposed improvements are located on the uplands and environmental permitting should not be lengthy or problematic. These improvements will provide the public a waterfront location to recreate, as well as create a boater destination.

The County has \$1.5 million in infrastructure sales tax revenue which will become available in October 2020, and the County will be seeking future WAP funding to cover a portion of the construction costs. In July 2018, the County completed redevelopment and expansion of the boating facilities located in the northern portion of Bert Winters Park. The project included renovation of the boat ramps, new staging docks, restroom, 45 additional car/trailer parking spaces and a new entrance drive for enhanced circulation. This project which was made possible by FIND's funding assistance has greatly improved boat launching in this park.

2) WATERWAY RELATIONSHIP:

a) Explain how the project relates to the ICW and the mission of the Navigation District.

Once complete this project will provide a canoe/kayak launch on the Intracoastal Waterway, the renovation of the existing day use docks will provide a boater destination in northern Palm Beach County with access to the restrooms, group shelter and playground.

b) What public access or navigational benefit to the ICW or adjoining waterway will result from this project?

This park with over eight hundred feet on the Intracoastal Waterway serves not only as a boat launching facility, but also as a boater destination.

3) PUBLIC USAGE & BENEFITS:

It is difficult to quantify public usage, Bert Winters Park car/trailer parking is full most nice weekends and holidays. Expansion of the waterfront facilities will provides the public with a venue to recreate and enjoy the Intracoastal Waterway.

b) Discuss the regional and local public benefits that will be provided by the project. Can residents from other counties of the District reasonably access and use the project? Explain.

The project site is located less than 8 miles from the Martin/Palm Beach County line and it is reasonable residents from other counties to use the park's boating and recreational facilities.

c) Are there any restrictions placed on commercial access or use of this site?

The park is deed restricted limiting the use to a public park for recreation purposes. The County sometimes allows commercial dock/sea wall construction companies to use the boat ramps for loading material with a use permit, no other commercial activity is allowed on this site.

Paddle boarding, canoe and kayaking have taken off in popularity in the last several years. This project will provide an additional access point on the Intracoastal Waterway to help meet the growing demand for these sports. Once the project is complete the renovated day use docks will allow boaters to tie up and use the park as a boater destination.

b) Clearly demonstrate how the project will continue to be maintained and funded after District funding is completed.

Bert Winters Park will continue to be maintained by the Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department. The maintenance division has 295 permanent full time employees and an annual operating budget of \$33.8 million.

c) Will the program result in significant and lasting benefits? Explain.

Once completed, this project will provide the public greater access to the Intracoastal Waterway. A restrictive covenant will be recorded in public records dedicating the project area for public use for a period of 25 years from the date of completion.

d) Please describe any environmental benefits associated with this project.

This Phase I project and the design will address stormwater concerns, and if warranted project may expand the existing stormwater treatment area.







LOCATION




County/City Location Map
