### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

## Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file:

- A) a Sponsorship Agreement with the West Palm Beach Fishing Club, Inc. providing a platinum level sponsorship in the amount of \$3,680 in services or goods for the Lake Worth Lagoon Fishing Challenge (LWLFC) on May 24 July 7, 2019, beginning upon execution and terminating July 24, 2019;
- **B)** a Sponsorship Agreement with the Angler Action Foundation, Inc. providing a platinum level sponsorship in the amount of \$5,000 in services or goods for the LWLFC on May 24 July 7, 2019, beginning upon execution and terminating July 24, 2019;
- **C)** a Sponsorship Agreement with Go Fish! Publications LLC providing a silver level sponsorship in the amount of \$714 in services or goods for the LWLFC on May 24 July 7, 2019, beginning upon execution and terminating September 1, 2019; and
- **D)** a Sponsorship Agreement with MANG, LLC providing a gold level sponsorship in the amount of \$1,093 in services or goods for the LWLFC on May 24 July 7, 2019, beginning upon execution and terminating July 24, 2019.

Summary: The LWLFC was designed as a citizen-science fishing event for the public to participate in the collection of valuable fisheries information while working alongside partners in the LWL Initiative and other community partners. The sponsors contribute additional advertising, prizes and venue for award ceremony, and the digital platform to run the tournament (cell phone app). On December 18, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners approved Resolution No. 2012-1905 authorizing the County Administrator or designee to execute a Standard Sponsorship Agreement. The Standard Sponsorship Agreement allows the sponsor access to commercial and/or marketing potential associated with specific environmental programs or special events hosted by the Department of Environmental Resources Management (ERM). In accordance with County PPM CW-O-051, all delegated contracts/agreements/grants must be submitted by the initiating Department as a receive and file agenda item. There is no cost to the County. 

This Agreement is made on this 25 day of February, 2019, by and between Palm Beach County, a Political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, ("County") and West Palm Beach Fishing Club, Inc., an individual or corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, ("Sponsor"), both being referred to collectively as the "parties."

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representation contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

#### Section 1 Term

The term of this Agreement shall commence upon execution by both parties and shall terminate on July 24, 2019.

#### Section 2. Sponsor's Responsibilities

- C. County has sole discretion to approve or deny the use/display of any logo/advertisement/material at or relating to the Event. County's approval of Sponsor's logo/advertisement/material shall not be construed as promotion or endorsement of Sponsor's business, products, or services.

#### Section 5. Termination

This Agreement may be terminated with or without cause by either party upon fifteen (15) days prior written notice by the other party.

#### Section 6. Independent Contractor Relationship

Sponsor is and shall be, in the activities under this Agreement, an independent contractor, and not an employee, agent, or servant of County. Sponsor does not have the power or authority to bind County in any promise, agreement or representation.

#### Section 7. Indemnification

Sponsor shall protect, defend, reimburse, indemnify and hold County, its agents, employees and elected officials harmless from and against any and all claims, liability, loss, expense, cost, damages, or causes of action of every kind or character, including attorneys' fees and costs, whether at trial or appellate levels or otherwise, arising during and as a result of Sponsor's performance of the terms of this Agreement or due to the acts or omissions of Sponsor. This provision shall survive termination or expiration of this Agreement.

#### Section 8. Remedies

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Any action to enforce this Agreement shall be brought in Palm Beach County, Florida. Sponsor's sole remedy for County's breach of this Agreement shall be return of all or part of the sponsorship funds paid by Sponsor to County. No provision of this Agreement is intended to, or shall be construed to, create any third party beneficiary or to provide any rights to any person or entity not a party to this Agreement.

#### Section 9. Notices

All formal notices between the parties shall be deemed received if sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, or facsimile with confirmation receipt to the Parties' Representatives set forth below:

Failure to cooperate with the Inspector General or interfering with or impeding any investigation shall be in violation of Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 - 2-440, and punished pursuant to Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, in the same manner as a second degree misdemeanor.

#### Section 12. Non Discrimination

The Sponsor warrants and represents that its employees are treated equally during employment without regard to race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or genetic information.






