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- A) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Sunco TH LLC, SDA #02-01153-000 (District 3). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located at the Southwest Corner of Melaleuca Lane and Mathis Street, 25.20 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five years.
- B) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Glades 95th Owner, LLC, SDA# 09-01088-000 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located at the Southwest Corner of Glades Road and 95th Avenue South, 498.65 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five years.
- C) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with SFD 441, LLC, SDA #09-01089-000 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located at the Southwest corner of W. Atlantic Avenue and SR 7/US 441, 36.60 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for water and 36.30 ERC's for wastewater for five years.
- D) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Colony at Lake Worth, LLC, SDA #02-01154-000, (District 2). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located at the Northwest corner of Lantana Road and Myers Road, approximately 1,200 feet West of South Haverhill Road, 34.00 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for both water and wastewater for five years.
- E) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Boynton Beach Associates XXVI, LLLP, SDA # 03-01045-000, (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located approximately 2 miles North of Atlantic Avenue between Lyons Road and US 441 (SR7), 403.55 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for water and 390.20 ERC's for wastewater for five years.
- F) Standard Potable Water and Wastewater Development Agreement with Lakeside Centre (Edens), LLC, SDA # 09-01090-000 (District 5). The Agreement authorizes the Property Owner located at 8180 Glades Road, Boca Raton, 27.40 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC's) for water and 27.40 ERC's for wastewater for five years.
