I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) approve an Impact Fee Affordable Housing Assistance Program (IFAHAP) funding award in the amount of \$211,849 to Ocean Breeze East Apartments, LLC (OBEA) for the Ocean Breeze East project; B) authorize the Mayor to execute a Certificate of Award to be released to the recipient pursuant to IFAHAP Guidelines; C) approve a Budget Transfer of \$211,849 in Impact Fee Assistance Program – Roads Zone 4 to appropriate funds for OBEA.

Summary: Staff recommends Board of County Commissioners' (BCC) approval for an IFAHAP funding award in the amount of \$211,849 to OBEA for the Ocean Breeze East project. On April 1, 2019, the Department of Housing and Economic Sustainability issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) making \$1,822,458 in IFAHAP funding available from Palm Beach County's Fiscal Year 2018 funding cycle. OBEA submitted a request for assistance in response to the NOFA on April 15, 2019. Staff recommends that OBEA be provided up to \$211,849 as a credit for Roads Zone 4 Impact Fees for the construction of Ocean Breeze East. OBEA will pay impact fees above the allocated \$211,849. The project is located at 700 North Seacrest Blvd. in Boynton Beach, and will have 123 multifamily apartment units for affordable rental to very low, low, and moderate income persons or households. According to IFAHAP requirements, all 123 apartment units assisted by IFAHAP will be rented to households with incomes no greater than 140% of Area Median Income (AMI). The assisted units will be deed-restricted to remain affordable for 20 years. Since 2009, the County has authorized the use of impact fee investment earnings from roads, parks, and public buildings to be used for affordable housing projects. These funds are from interest earned by the Impact Fee Fund. District 7 (HJF)

Background and Policy Issues: On November 17, 2009, the BCC authorized the use of impact fee investment earnings from roads, parks, and public buildings for affordable housing projects. On April 10, 2018, the BCC approved the current IFAHAP Guidelines. The IFAHAP NOFA made funds available to for-profit and non-profit developer entities seeking to build affordable rental housing units or for-sale housing units and to individuals seeking to build owner-constructed/occupied housing units for use as their principal place of residence. On February 5, 2019, Agenda Item #5B-1, the BCC approved \$106,399 for OBEA through the Fiscal Year 2017 funding cycle. At the time, this was the IFAHAP amount remaining available for the project, but was insufficient to fund the full amount of Roads Impact Fees associated with the project. Subsequently, OBEA submitted an application for the current Fiscal Year 2018 funding cycle for the unfunded balance of Roads Impact Fees. The 2018 NOFA funds must be encumbered no later than March 12, 2020, and Certificate(s) of Occupancy from the jurisdictional building department must be obtained for all Assisted Units and such units must be occupied by eligible households within four (4) years after the date of funding approval by the BCC. A responsiveness review determined that the OBEA was responsive thus warranting recommendation for a funding reservation of impact fee credits.


