I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A) a Contract with Florida Design Drilling Corporation (Contractor) for the Water Treatment Plant (WTP) No. 11 High Service Pump Station Electrical Building Improvements (Project), in the amount of \$3,590,000.00; and **B)** a \$2,327,000 Budget Transfer in the Water Utilities Department's Capital Improvement Fund to fund the project from reserves.

Summary: On June 19, 2019, the Water Utilities Department (WUD) received two (2) bids for the Project to construct improvements to the high service pump station electrical building at WTP No. 11. The Contractor was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in the amount of \$3,590,000.00. The Project was presented to the Goal Setting Committee on May 1, 2019, and a minimum mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting goal was the Affirmative Procurement Initiative (API) applied to this Project. The Contractor has met the established API for this Project. The Contract provides for 47.60% SBE participation which includes 0.76% MBE (H) participation, and 0.30% WBE participation. The Contractor is a Palm Beach County Company. The Project is included in the WUD FY19 budget. (WUD Project No. 18-005) <u>District 6</u> (MJ)

Background and Justification: WTP No. 11 serves the Cities of Belle Glade, South Bay and Pahokee, in addition to unincorporated Palm Beach County. During Hurricane Irma in 2017, the high service pump station electrical building was at risk of inundation. Investigations have determined the electrical building was constructed more than two feet lower than the established flood elevation for the WTP No. 11 site. The Contractor will construct a new high service pump station electrical building above the established flood elevation mitigating risks associated with flooding. In addition, the Project will increase operational efficiency by providing variable frequency drives on the high service pumps and clearwell transfer pumps and installing process analyzers to improve monitoring and control of the treatment process.

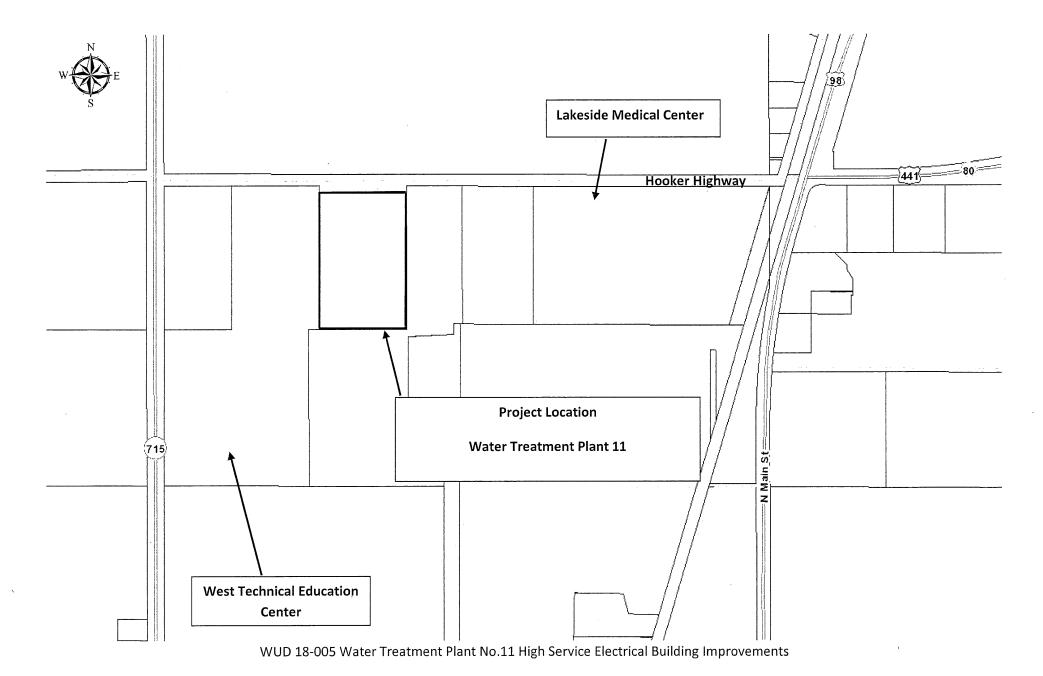

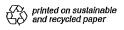
