I. **EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Work Authorization (WA) No. 19 to the Pipeline Continuing Construction Contract 2017 (Contract) with Hinterland Group Inc., (Hinterland) for the Utility Relocations for Belle Glade Citywide Sidewalk Improvements (Project) in the amount of \$625,761.75.

Summary: On January 10, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Water Utilities Department (WUD) Contract (R2017-0072) with Hinterland. WA No. 19 provides for the installation and relocation of various existing WUD facilities and associated appurtenances located within the limits of the Project. This Contract was procured under the requirements of the 2002 Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance (R2002-0064) prior to the adoption of the new Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance on October 16, 2018. The SBE participation goal established under the 2002 Ordinance was 15% overall participation. The Contract provides for 15.00% SBE participation. Work Authorization No. 19 includes 100% SBE participation. The cumulative SBE participation including WA No. 19 is 100%. Hinterland is a Palm Beach County company. The Project is included in the WUD FY19 budget. (WUD Project No. 19-013) District 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: Florida Department of Transportation is proposing approximately two (2) miles of sidewalk and drainage improvements at ten (10) locations throughout the City of Belle Glade. These sidewalk and drainage improvements will require the installation and relocation of WUD's existing water and wastewater facilities that are located within the FDOT project limits to prevent the possibility of shallow utilities from being damaged during construction.




Location Sketch
