I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) the fourth amendment to the structural engineering annual contract (R2017-0026) dated January 10, 2017 with Alan Gerwig & Associates, Inc. (AGA); and
- B) a work task order to the contract with AGA in the amount of \$309,498.60 for professional services for the Donald Ross Road Bascule Bridge Equipment Rehabilitation (Project).

SUMMARY: Approval of this fourth amendment will update the language of the termination section, access and audits section, criminal history records check section, non-discrimination section, scrutinized companies section, and add the vendor self service registration required section to be compliant with current Palm Beach County standards. Approval of this work task order will provide the design services necessary for the Project. The services include rehabilitation of the hydraulic, mechanical and electrical systems for the project. The solicitation for structural engineering design professionals was advertised on August 7, 2016 and August 14, 2016. The contract was approved on January 10, 2017, prior to the effective date of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance and pursuant to the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance at the time. The SBE goal for all contracts is 15%. AGA proposed 100% SBE participation. Their SBE participation for this work task order is 10.18% due to there being no available SBE subconsultants for bascule bridge work. cumulative SBE participation to date including this work task order is 63.7%. Prior to this work task order, AGA's cumulative SBE participation was 96.1%. AGA is a Palm Beach County (County) based company and a certified SBE company. Anne Gerwig, Mayor of Wellington, is owner of 1% of AGA. In the event any item would come before her that would offer a special financial benefit to her or her business relating to this contract, AGA has disclosed that it would require her to recuse herself from that item, thereby removing any conflict of interest for herself, AGA or the County. Anne Gerwig also serves as chair of the Citizens Advisory Committee on Health and Human Services as a Palm Beach County League of Cities representative, which is purely advisory and without oversight of this contract. Disclosure of these contractual relationships at a noticed public meeting is provided in accordance with the provisions of Section 2-443, of the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics. District 1 (YBH)

Background and Justification: On January 10, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved Contract R2017-0026 with AGA to provide professional services required for structural engineering throughout the County. (Continued on page 3)

Background and Justification: (Continued from page 1)

The fee as detailed in Exhibit B of the attached work task order, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:

Basic Services (Lump Sum) \$164,915.40 (Design Rehabilitation, Temporary Traffic Control).

Optional Services (Not to Exceed) \$144,583.20 (Post Design Phase, Span Balance).

The first amendment to the contract (R2017-1876) dated December 19, 2017, extended the expiration date from January 9, 2018 to January 9, 2019, modified the fee schedule and replaced Section 5.2 – Payments. The second amendment to the contract (R2018-0816) dated June 5, 2018, added Section 22 – Additional Reporting. The third amendment to the contract (R2018-1973) dated December 18, 2018, extended the expiration date from January 9, 2019 to January 9, 2020, and modified the fee schedule.

After reviewing the attached work task order for professional services and finding it in proper order, the Engineering Department recommends BCC approval.

FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING SERVICES ANNUAL CONTRACT NO. R2017-0026 DATED JANUARY 10, 2017, BY AND BETWEEN ALAN GERWIG & ASSOCIATES, INC., AND PALM BEACH COUNTY

This Fourth Amendment to the Contract for Annual Structural Engineering Services (PROJECT)
(R2017-0026), dated January 10, 2017 (ANNUAL CONTRACT), is made and entered into the
day of, 2019, by and between Palm Beach County, a political
subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners
(COLINTY) and Alan Gorving & Associated I. (CONINTY)
(COUNTY) and Alan Gerwig & Associates, Inc. (CONSULTANT) (individually Party and
collectively Parties).

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the CONSULTANT and COUNTY entered into the ANNUAL CONTRACT for structural engineering services required for COUNTY user departments, on an as needed basis, hereinafter referred to as the PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, by this Fourth Amendment, the CONSULTANT and the COUNTY mutually agree to amend the ANNUAL CONTRACT as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The above recitations are true and correct and incorporated herein.
- 2. **SECTION 7.1 TERMINATION** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 7.1 – TERMINATION

This Contract may be terminated by the CONSULTANT upon sixty (60) days prior written notice to the COUNTY in the event of substantial failure by the COUNTY to perform in accordance with the terms of this Contract through no fault of the CONSULTANT. It may also be terminated, in whole or in part, by the COUNTY, with cause upon five (5) business days written notice to the CONSULTANT or without cause upon ten (10) business days written notice to the CONSULTANT. Unless the CONSULTANT is in breach of this Contract, the CONSULTANT shall be paid for services rendered to the COUNTY'S satisfaction through the date of termination. After receipt of a Termination Notice, except as otherwise directed by the COUNTY, in writing, the CONSULTANT shall:

A. Stop work on the date and to the extent specified.

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- B. Terminate and settle all orders and subcontracts relating to the performance of the terminated work.
- C. Transfer all work in process, completed work, and other materials related to the terminated work to the COUNTY.
- D. Continue and complete all parts of the work that have not been terminated.
- 3. **SECTION 7.13 ACCESS AND AUDITS** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 7.13 ACCESS AND AUDITS

The CONSULTANT shall maintain adequate records to justify all charges, expenses, and costs incurred in estimating and performing the work for at least four (4) years after completion or termination of this Contract. The COUNTY shall have access to such books, records, and documents as required in this section for the purpose of inspection or audit during normal business hours, at the CONSULTANT'S place of business.

Palm Beach County has established the Office of the Inspector General in Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 - 2-440, as may be amended. The Inspector General's authority includes but is not limited to the power to review past, present and proposed County contracts, transactions, accounts and records, to require the production of records, and to audit, investigate, monitor, and inspect the activities of the CONSULTANT, its officers, agents, employees, and lobbyists in order to ensure compliance with contract requirements and detect corruption and fraud.

Failure to cooperate with the Inspector General or interfering with or impeding any investigation shall be in violation of Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 - 2-440, and punished pursuant to Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, in the same manner as a second degree misdemeanor.

4. **SECTION 9 - CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 9 – CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK

The CONSULTANT, CONSULTANT'S employees, subcontractors of CONSULTANT and employees of subcontractors shall comply with Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-371 - 2-377, the Palm Beach County Criminal History Records Check Ordinance (Ordinance), for unescorted access to critical facilities (Critical Facilities) or criminal justice information facilities (CJI Facilities) as identified in Resolution R-2003-1274, as amended. The CONSULTANT is solely responsible for the financial, schedule, and/or staffing implications of this Ordinance. Further, the CONSULTANT acknowledges that its Contract price includes any and all direct or indirect costs associated with compliance with this Ordinance, except for the applicable FDLE/FBI fees that shall be paid by the COUNTY.

This Contract may include sites and/or buildings which have been designated as either critical facilities or criminal justice information facilities pursuant to the Ordinance and

Resolution R2003-1274, as amended. COUNTY staff representing the COUNTY department will contact the CONSULTANT(S) and provide specific instructions for meeting the requirements of this Ordinance. Individuals passing the background check will be issued a badge. The CONSULTANT shall make every effort to collect the badges of its employees and its subcontractors' employees upon conclusion of the contract and return them to the COUNTY. If the CONSULTANT or its subcontractor(s) terminates an employee who has been issued a badge, the CONSULTANT must notify the COUNTY within two (2) hours. At the time of termination, the CONSULTANT shall retrieve the badge and shall return it to the COUNTY in a timely manner.

The COUNTY reserves the right to suspend the CONSULTANT if the CONSULTANT 1) does not comply with the requirements of County Code Section 2-371 - 2-377, as amended; 2) does not contact the COUNTY regarding a terminated CONSULTANT employee or subcontractor employee within the stated time; or 3) fails to make a good faith effort in attempting to comply with the badge retrieval policy.

5. **SECTION 12 - NON-DISCRIMINATION** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 12 - NON-DISCRIMINATION

The COUNTY is committed to assuring equal opportunity in the award of contracts and complies with all laws prohibiting discrimination. Pursuant to Palm Beach County Resolution R2017-1770, as may be amended, the CONSULTANT warrants and represents that throughout the term of the Contract, including any renewals thereof, if applicable, all of its employees are treated equally during employment without regard to race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, or genetic information. Failure to meet this requirement shall be considered default of the Contract.

As a condition of entering into this Contract, the CONSULTANT represents and warrants that it will comply with the COUNTY'S Commercial Nondiscrimination Policy as described in Resolution 2017-1770, as amended. As part of such compliance, the CONSULTANT shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry, sex, age, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, or genetic information in the solicitation, selection, hiring or commercial treatment of subcontractors, vendors, suppliers, or commercial customers, nor shall the CONSULTANT retaliate against any person for reporting instances of such discrimination. The CONSULTANT shall provide equal opportunity for subcontractors, vendors and suppliers to participate in all of its public sector and private sector subcontracting and supply opportunities, provided that nothing contained in this clause shall prohibit or limit otherwise lawful efforts to remedy the effects of marketplace discrimination that have occurred or are occurring in the County's relevant marketplace in Palm Beach County. The CONSULTANT understands and agrees that a material violation of this clause shall be considered a material breach of this Contract and may result in termination of this Contract, disqualification or debarment of the company from participating in County contracts, or other sanctions. This clause is not enforceable by or for the benefit of, and creates no obligation to, any third party.

CONSULTANT shall include this language in its subcontracts.

6. **SECTION 20 - SCRUTINIZED COMPANIES** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 20 - SCRUTINIZED COMPANIES

As provided in F.S. 287.135, by entering into this Contract or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the CONSULTANT certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that boycott Israel List, or is engaged in a boycott of Israel, pursuant to F.S. 215.4725.

When contract value is greater than \$1 million: As provided in F.S. 287.135, by entering into this Contract or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the CONSULTANT certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Scrutinized Companies With Activities in Sudan List or Scrutinized Companies With Activities in The Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List created pursuant to F.S. 215.473 or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.

If the County determines, using credible information available to the public, that a false certification has been submitted by CONSULTANT, this Contract may be terminated and a civil penalty equal to the greater of \$2 million or twice the amount of this Contract shall be imposed, pursuant to F.S. 287.135. Said certification must also be submitted at the time of Contract renewal, if applicable.

7. **SECTION 23 – VSS REGISTRATION REQUIRED** is hereby added to the ANNUAL CONTRACT:

SECTION 23 – VSS REGISTRATION REQUIRED

In order to do business with Palm Beach County, CONSULTANTS are required to create a Vendor Registration Account OR activate an existing Vendor Registration Account through the Purchasing Department's Vendor Self Service (VSS) system, which can be accessed at

https://pbcvssp.co.palm-beach.fl.us/webapp/vssp/AltSelfService.

If CONSULTANT intends to use sub-consultants, CONSULTANT must also ensure that all sub-consultants are registered as consultants in VSS. All subcontractor agreements must include a contractual provision requiring that the sub-consultant register in VSS. COUNTY will not finalize a contract award until the COUNTY has verified that the CONSULTANT and all of its sub-consultants are registered in VSS.

8. It is the intent of the parties hereto that this Fourth Amendment shall not become binding until the date executed by the COUNTY.

PROJECT NAME: Donald Ross Road Bascule Bridge over ICWW Rehabilitation

PART 1.0 PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

HDR shall provide construction plans for the rehabilitation of the Donald Ross Road Bascule Bridge in Palm Beach County, Florida. The bridge consists of a hydraulic operated twin single leaf span bascule bridges (bridge numbers 934160 and 934161). These elements are referred to herein as Bridge and/or Structure. HDR shall design the rehabilitation in accordance with the Project Scope of Work detailed herein, per the discussions held during the site visit carried on May 1st, 2018, and per the County's 'Interoffice Memorandum' dated March 8th, 2017 and titled '2017-2018 Proposed Budget Items".

PART 2.0 SCOPE OF BASIC SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY HDR ON THE PROJECT:

Palm Beach County is seeking the professional services of an engineering consultant to design; prepare plans; develop construction specifications; develop construction cost estimates; and provide engineering services for the Mechanical and Electrical Systems Rehabilitation of the Donald Ross Road Bascule Bridge.

The anticipated scope of work includes the following proposed work:

A. Hydraulic System Rehabilitation

Hydraulic Power Units (HPU) – Removing the existing HPU's. Installing new HPU's in an adjacent location to the existing to maintain operation of the span. New HPU's are to be designed with (2) hydraulic pumps, directional control valve (non-proportional), system pressure relief valve, and seating valve with reduced pressure relief. New HPU will have all the required pressure gauges and flow meter for proper trouble shooting. Reduce HPU footprint to increase walkway clearance and improve maintenance access.

Hydraulic Cylinders – Replace cylinder seals. Remove (2) cylinders at a time for seal replacement while still maintaining operation of the spans.

Hydraulic Piping - Re-use existing hydraulic piping where viable.

Valving Controls - Re-use existing ball valves and hydraulic cylinder manifolds where viable.

B. Control System Rehabilitation

Control Console – Upgrade operator's control console with AASHTO compliant desk top, replace all switches and pushbuttons with heavy duty switches, pushbuttons and indicating pilot lights.

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Bridge Controls - Modify system to simplify adjustment and troubleshooting including introducing a full relay based control system with a PLC system for monitoring purposes only. New PLC system will be composed of the latest available systems for extended life cycle.

Pump Controls - The pump control system will be modified in order to also simplify adjustment and troubleshooting. Span speed will be controlled by the use of Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs) instead of the existing proportional valves and control cards. This also increases the life cycle of the hydraulic control systems as VFDs can be replaced in-kind while proportional controls are unique to each system and become obsolete within a few years.

Monitoring System - The existing monitoring system will be replaced with a new PC based Human Machine interface (HMI), where a graphical representation of the bridge will be displayed along with status of devices and equipment, and alarms.


Power Distribution system - Modifications to the Motor Control Center (MCC) to accommodate the HPU system replacement with two hydraulic pumps instead of three pumps.

Engineering services include an initial evaluation and assessment of the bridge's hydraulic and controls systems integrity, capacity and any substandard conditions, including identifying conditions that impact the bridge safety, usability, durability and integrity. HDR shall evaluate all conditions that are site specific and applicable in determining the extent of the eventual proposed rehabilitation.

The project limits for construction are the bascule piers and spans of the Donald Ross bridge over the ICWW.

The engineering services include the following Tasks:

- 1. General Tasks
- 2. Design Memorandum
- 3. Rehabilitation Design
- 4. Temporary Traffic Control Plans



Task 1: **General Tasks**

Coordination, Meetings and Field Reviews

HDR shall attend project meetings including a pre-design/kick-off meeting; field reviews, project progress meetings, coordination meetings, and technical meetings. HDR shall provide sketches, graphics and narrations required to depict the project or any other aspect related to it. HDR shall prepare agendas and keep accurate minutes of all meetings and distribute copies to all attendees.

HDR shall provide a meeting agenda for COUNTY review 2 business days prior to each meeting and must provide written minutes of each meeting within 7 business days of the

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meeting for COUNTY approval prior for distribution to attendees. Meetings anticipated are as follows:

- Meeting #1 pre-design/kick-off meeting
- Meeting #2 post Design Memorandum Submittal
- Meeting #3 post 65% Plans Submittal
- Meeting #4 post 96% Plans Submittal
- Meeting #5 post 100% Plans Submittal

Quality Control Plan

HDR shall provide a project specific quality control plan detailing their quality control process and staff performing the work.

Cost Estimate & Quantities

HDR shall develop construction cost estimates for the project. These estimates shall be based on the best engineering assumptions available at the time of the respective plans submittal. HDR shall provide an updated cost estimate with each phase submittal.

HDR shall prepare bid quantities that include all bid items, which comprise the project design. Bid items shall be referenced to COUNTY & Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) measurement and pay items as applicable. Bid proposal sheets to be included in the contract documents shall be prepared by the COUNTY based on HDR's provided quantities.

Preliminary bid quantities and opinion of probable construction costs shall be submitted with the design Memorandum, 65%, 96% and 100% design review submittals. Final quantities and final estimate of probable construction costs shall be submitted with the Final design review submittal. Construction costs are to be based on the most current cost available at the time of the Final deliverable, obtained from the COUNTY and other bridge owners in Florida utilizing similar bid unit costs.

Bidability and Constructability Review

HDR shall provide bidability and constructability reviews as follows:

- Perform a constructability review as part of the 96% and 100% Plans reviews.
- Perform a bidability review as part of the 100% Plans review.

Specifications Package Preparation Support

HDR shall assist the COUNTY in preparation of a complete specifications package. HDR shall provide applicable Technical Special Provisions for work not covered by the COUNTY's Technical Specifications or the FDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and the workbook of implemented modifications. HDR will review of all required COUNTY and FDOT supplemental specifications as applicable for all items and areas of work. HDR shall utilize the appropriate COUNTY approved pay item structure.

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Task 2: Design Memorandum

HDR shall gather and review all bridge available documents, inspect the bridge, perform preliminary analysis, provide recommendations for rehabilitation including supporting documentation, and deliberate findings and recommendations with the COUNTY. The Memorandum shall serve as the final detailed scope of services so that the design tasks may begin. HDR shall provide/perform the following:

- Data Collection and Documentation Review
- Bridge Inspection
- Draft Memorandum
- Final Memorandum

Data Collection and Documentation Review

HDR shall gather and review all bridge available documents related to the bridge's electrical and mechanical systems, and structural systems that may impact the recommended rehabilitation work including bascule span details, bascule pier layouts, and Control House details. These documents include:

- Structures Plans
- As-Built Plans
- Repair Plans
- Inspection Reports
- Work History Work Orders
- Other Documents that pertain to Electrical and Mechanical Deficiencies, Repairs and/or Maintenance

Bridge Inspection

HDR shall perform a field review of the project site inspections of the electrical and mechanical systems. Relevant conditions shall be documented and photographed for ease of interpretation in the Memorandum.

The inspection shall be performed by a minimum of one mechanical and one electrical engineer. The COUNTY shall provide access to all equipment HDR deem necessary to inspect. The following devices, equipment and sub-systems shall be inspected:

- Controls System Control console and panels, and limit switches and sensors.
- Hydraulic Drive System HPU, hydraulic cylinders, hydraulic piping, and hydraulic control valving.
- Electrical System Conduit and wiring system, and power distribution equipment.
- Bridge Counterweights Counterweight pockets and remaining balance block capacity.

During the course of the inspection if additional discrepancies are noted that the engineers deem crucial for the reliable operation of the bridge, these discrepancies will be documented

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and included in the Memorandum. Measurements of the structure such as room layouts, supporting structural elements, mechanical dimensions and clearances, and electrical equipment dimensions shall be taken. Electrical and hydraulic equipment ratings and characteristics shall also be documented.

Draft Design Memorandum

Based on the bridge inspection and evaluation, HDR will perform a preliminary analysis of the systems and assess which solutions are available for the rehabilitation of the hydraulic and control systems. The draft memorandum scope includes the following:

- Description and overview of hydraulic and control systems and their overall conditions, description of all discrepancies found, photo log of findings.
- Rehabilitation and improvement recommendations, preliminary construction cost estimate for repair and improvement recommendation.
- Preliminary analysis of the proposed Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) for any work requiring lane closures or detours.

Final Design Memorandum

A final draft of the memorandum shall be prepared by HDR based on the comments received by the COUNTY and the Draft Design Memorandum post-submittal meeting. Any additional analysis and information deemed necessary by HDR after COUNTY's comments and meeting discussions shall be included in the Final Design Memorandum.

Technical Meetings

HDR shall attend technical meetings necessary to coordinate the development of the MOT plans. HDR shall provide a meeting agenda for COUNTY review 2 business days prior to each meeting and shall provide written minutes of each meeting within 7 business days of the meeting for COUNTY approval prior to distribution to attendees. Meetings anticipated are as follows:

- Technical meeting after Draft Memorandum
- 65% Phase review meeting

Task 3: Rehabilitation Design Bridge Design

HDR shall design the Rehabilitation of the Electrical and Mechanical Systems in accordance with the recommendations of the Final Design Memorandum. HDR shall design the bridge rehabilitation in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Minimum Standards for Design, Construction and Maintenance for Streets and Highways (commonly known as the "Florida Greenbook".) and the FDOT Structures Manual as appropriate, including the following referenced standards, guidelines and/or manuals:

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- American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO) Roadside Design Guide
- AASHTO Highway Safety Manual Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD)
- AASHTO D1.5/AWS D1.5 Bridge Welding Code
- American Institute of Steel Construction (AISC) Manual of Steel Construction
- AASHTO LRFD Movable Highway Bridge Design Specifications and Interims
- AASHTO Standard Specifications for Structural Supports for Highway Signs, Luminaires and Traffic Signals, and Interims.
- Florida Building Code (for Control House Equipment)
- National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) Life Safety Code
- NFPA 70 National Electrical Code

HDR shall prepare bridge plans sheets necessary to define the bridge rehabilitation work. Plan sheet elements anticipated for the project include 27 Plan Sheets, and are as follows:

- Index of Drawings
- General Notes and Summary of Quantities
- General Plan & Elevation
- Bascule Machinery Plans and Details
- Electrical Power & Control Plans & Details

HDR shall provide Design Documentation to the COUNTY with the 100% and Final submittals consisting of design calculations and other supporting documentation developed during the development of the plans. The design calculations submitted shall adequately address the complete design of the contract elements. These calculations shall be neatly and logically presented on digital media and on 8 ½"x11" paper and all sheets shall be numbered. The final design calculations (at the final submittal) shall be signed and sealed by a Florida-licensed professional engineer on the hard and digital deliverables. A cover sheet indexing the contents of the calculations shall be included and the engineer shall sign and seal that sheet.

HDR's Plans shall incorporate measures to maintain passage of boats currently requiring an open center span or as per agreed with the United States Coast Guard (USCG).

Technical Special Provisions

HDR shall provide Technical Special Provisions for all bridge items of work not covered by the FDOT's Specifications. Technical Special Provisions shall be submitted on standard size sheets. The final Technical Special Provisions shall be signed and sealed by a Florida-licensed professional engineer.

Task 4: Temporary Traffic Control

Traffic Control Analysis

HDR shall design a safe and effective Traffic Control Plan to move vehicular traffic during all phases of construction. HDR will analyze and document the maintenance of traffic in accordance with the applicable Florida Department of Transportation, Palm Beach County manuals, guidelines and standards.

Traffic control phasing shall be developed considering the recommendations contained in the Design Memorandum. The analysis shall evaluate three different options for vehicle traffic:

- Two way traffic on the North Bridge. South bridge closed.
- Two way traffic on the South Bridge. North Bridge closed.
- North & South bridges closed and all traffic detoured to PGA Blvd.

It is anticipated that construction will require a cross-over, where traffic will be maintained in both directions on one of the bridges at a time. Based on the coordination meeting held with the County Project Manager and bridge superintendent, lane transitions will utilize the existing openings since median noses were pulled back from the intersections to facilitate the movement. Existing opposing signals are anticipated to handle the traffic at bridge closures. Aerials will be used to convey the existing striping with some markups on top. Typical sections are not anticipated to be needed.

Traffic Control Plans

Plans shall be prepared in accordance to Palm Beach County CADD Standards and contain the 3 options included in the analysis. The following is a list of plan sheets to be included for Temporary Traffic Control:

- General Notes
- Summary of Quantities
- Phasing Notes
- Plan Sheets / Detours
- Special Details

The first Traffic Control Plans submittal will be provided at Phase III (96% Submittal) as stated on the Palm Beach County Thoroughfare Road Design Procedure. HDR will provide written responses to all formal comments made by the County at submittal phase.



PART 3.0 OPTIONAL SERVICES, NOT PART OF BASIC SERVICES:

Task 5 - Span Balance Measurement and Analysis

If during the Design Memorandum task and with approval by the COUNTY, HDR deems necessary to analyze the bridge bascule spans balancing due to either noticed exiting

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imbalance issues or possible imbalance issues caused due to the proposed rehabilitation, HDR shall perform span balance measurements and analysis. A balance report shall be provided as an attachment to the Final Design Memorandum. Any recommended span balance adjustments shall be addressed in the design Plans and Specifications.

The following are the activities and man-hour required for this task:

- Span Balance Measurements two mechanical engineers during two days of data collection including set-up.
- Span Balance Data Analysis one mechanical engineer performing data analysis including QC by senior mechanical engineer.
- Span Balance Report one mechanical engineer preparing report including QC by senior mechanical engineer.

These services shall be compensated on a lump sum basis as shown in PART 4.0.



Task 6 - Post Design Services

When authorized, HDR shall perform post design services, including plans updates, review of submittals including requests for information, shop drawings, attend COUNTY pre-construction meeting, participate in monthly construction progress meetings, and witness shop tests, major equipment installation and bridge commissioning.

The following are listed Scope Items and Exclusions for Post Design Services.

- MOT Observation and Temporary Traffic Control Modification HDR will perform up to fourteen site visits to observe the contractor's MOT and note deviations from the traffic control plans. When requested by the County, HDR will provide up to two temporary traffic control design changes.
- Request for Information (RFI) Up to a total of 20 RFIs during the bidding and construction phases combined.
- Plans Updates Plans updates and revisions derived from RFIs during the bidding phase. Proposal includes the update of a maximum of 6 sheets.
- Meetings HDR will participate in monthly construction progress meetings based on a 12 month construction schedule. While participating in these meetings, HDR may perform site cursory review of construction progress.
- Shop Drawings Each Shop Drawing package is expected to have a maximum of 2 review iterations. The following is a list of the shop drawing reviews included within this proposal:


