I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Increase in the maximum dollar value of the minor construction annual contracts by \$1,500,000 for general construction services on an annual contract basis.

Summary: On February 3, 2015 (R2015-0155 through R2015-0168), the Board initially approved the annual minor construction contract for an initial term of one (1) year, with four (4) renewal options each for a period of one (1) year, at the sole option of the County. During the first four years of the contract, the County awarded \$10,696,004.44 in work orders. Staff is requesting the cumulative limit be increased by \$1,500,000 for a total cumulative value of \$12,000,000 in order to accommodate the current and anticipated new projects required to be accomplished before the term of this contract expires on February 2, 2020. Work is to be awarded as work orders on a lump-sum, competitively bid basis. Contractors are allowed to qualify at any time and be added to the contract. Projects \$100,000 and over are advertised on Vendor Self-Service (VSS) while projects \$200,000 and over are advertised in the newspaper. For projects under \$100,000, the bid pool consists of the pre-qualified contractors. For projects over \$100,000, the bid pool is expanded to include any additional bidders responding to the specific project advertisement. The annual minor construction contract was presented to the Goal Setting Committee (GSC) on January 2, 2019 where an Affirmative Procurement Initiative (API) of Sheltered Market for projects under \$100,000 was applied to projects advertised under this contract from January 2 -- October 2, 2019. On October 2, 2019, the minor construction contract was again presented to the GSC where the following API was applied: 1) Sheltered Market for projects under \$100,000; 2) Price Preference for Single Trade projects over \$100,000; and 3) 25% small business enterprise (SBE) subcontracting goal for multi-trade projects over \$100,000, which will apply to projects advertised under this contract between October 2, 2019 - February 2, 2020. S/M/WBE actual participation will be identified on each work order, and will be tracked cumulatively over all work orders issued. Current cumulative S/M/WBE participation for all work orders to-date is 56.55%. (Capital Improvements) Countywide (LDC)

Background and Justification: These contracts were last solicited in 2014 and the original list of sixteen (16) contractors were prequalified to provide general construction services associated with repairs, improvements and renovations to County properties. Since approval, the number of participating contractors is now twenty-two (22) of which nine (9) are SBE's and six (6) are minority business enterprises (MBEs). Along with this agenda item, staff is submitting before the board Work Order # 19-067 in the amount of \$796,640. The amount designated for Work Order # 19-067 reduces the remaining capacity of funds available for the minor construction annual contract. In order to accommodate the anticipated new projects identified in the annual minor project list before the term of this contract expires on February 2, 2020 staff is requesting an increase of \$1,500,000. Work is awarded as work orders on a lump-sum, competitively bid basis among the pool of pre-qualified minor construction contractors. Additionally projects \$100,000 and over are also advertised on VSS, projects \$200,000 and over are advertised in the newspaper. Contractors are allowed to qualify at any time throughout the term of the contract and be added to the annual contract.
