The County has expended or encumbered \$614,648 (\$64,700/month) during the previous nine and one half (9.5) months of the current twelve (12) month term contract. Facilities Development & Operations Department (\$195,480) and the Department of Airports (\$30,000) are requesting a total increase of \$225,480, over the previously authorized amount of \$682,220, inclusive of the Purchasing Director's ten percent (10%) authority, during the remaining two and one half (2.5) months of the current term contract. This increase is necessary due to four (4) vacant A/C positions; an increase in repairs required for aging HVAC systems at various County locations; payment of outstanding invoices; and unanticipated repairs. This term contract has four (4) twelve (12) month renewal options remaining. Awardee is located in Palm Beach County. No responsive S/M/WBE vendor bid within 10% of the low bidder.
