The County has expended or encumbered \$9,594,956 (\$221,849/month) during the previous forty-three and one quarter (43.25) months of the current sixty (60) month term contract. Palm Tran requests an increase of \$5,000,000, over the previously authorized amount of \$9,625,809.60, inclusive of the Purchasing Director's ten percent (10%) authority, during the remaining sixteen and three quarter (16.75) months of the current term contract. This increase is necessary due to an increase in repairs required for aging buses that have been failing frequently. Timeframe for replacement of aging buses is estimated to be at the end of 2020. Per the Pre-Qualification Contract, approval is also requested to add qualified vendors that may become pre-qualified during the term of the contract. This term contract has no renewal options. Fifteen (15) Awardees are located out of State, seven (7) Awardees are located in Palm Beach County, and seven (7) Awardees are located outside Palm Beach County in the cities of Miami, Tampa, Riverview, Sunrise, Fort Lauderdale, Fort Pierce, and Apopka, Florida. No S/M/WBE vendor submitted a bid on this project.
