I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) ratify the Mayor's signature on a Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program (FRDAP) grant application submitted to the State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) on October 10, 2019, requesting \$200,000 to fund the project elements associated with the development of Canyon District Park; B) authorize the County Administrator or designee to execute the grant Project Agreement, time extensions, task assignments, certifications, standard forms, or amendments to the Agreement that do not change the terms and conditions of the Agreement if the grant is approved; and C) authorize the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department to serve as designee with FDEP for this project.

Summary: This grant application requests \$200,000 from FRDAP for the development of Canyon District Park. Project elements include three new multipurpose fields, picnic facilities, playground, exercise/hiking trail, restroom, and parking and associated infrastructure. The grant request is for \$200,000 and will be matched with \$200,000 from Zone 3 Impact fees. If the grant is awarded, and once the project is completed, the Project Agreement requires a Notice of Limitation of Use to be recorded in public records limiting the project site to outdoor recreation in perpetuity. District 5 (AH)

Background and Justification: The 52 acre Canyon District Park property is located south of Canyon Town Center in western Boynton Beach. The park, which is currently under design, will be developed in two phases. Phase 1 will include three multipurpose fields, a restroom/concession building, picnic facilities and related infrastructure. The County anticipates commencing construction of Phase 1 in the spring of 2020, and the project will take approximately 12 months to complete. The recreational amenities for Phase 2 have not been finalized pending School Board assistance but are scheduled for a late-2020 notice to proceed.

FRDAP grants are provided by FDEP, and the State's deadline for submitting this application did not allow for prior approval by the Board. In order to meet the grant application deadline, Mayor Bernard signed the application on behalf of the Board, as authorized by Administrative Code 309.00. This code requires that the grant be presented to the Board for ratification at the next available Board meeting after signature by the Mayor.
