I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: **Staff recommends motion to approve**: Change Order No. 29 to the contract with Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc. (R2016-0430) decreasing the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for the Detention Facilities Renewal/Replacement-West Detention Center Pods A & B project in the amount of \$351,944.

Summary: On May 1, 2018, the Board approved Amendment No. 3 to the contract with Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc., (R2018-0663) in the amount of \$7,553,277 to complete the renewal and replacement project at the West Detention Center Pods A&B. The project replacements include, but are not limited to, the roof, doors, windows, hot water heaters, generators, intercom, locking control /intercom wiring, epoxy flooring and the creation of a backup control room in pod A. Advanced diagnostic testing of the existing wiring for the locking control that operates the door systems was conducted, and it was determined that the existing wiring did not need to be replaced. Change Order No. 29 is to delete the requirement to replace the locking control conduits and wire. The solicitation for construction manager (CM) was advertised according to the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance in place at the time, with a 15% SBE participation goal. The CM is not an SBE. The new cumulative SBE participation for this contract, including the decrease defined in Change Order No. 29 is 75.66%. Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc., is a Palm Beach County business. The funding source for this project is from the Infrastructure Sales Tax Fund. All savings will be returned to the infrastructure sales tax fund. (Capital Improvements Division) Countywide/District 6 (LDC)

Background and Justification: Construction Manager (CM) at Risk is a project delivery method in which the CM provides design phase assistance, evaluation of cost, schedule and implications of alternate designs, systems and materials, and serves as the general contractor bidding the subcontracts for construction. On April 5, 2016, Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc. was selected for construction management services for both the Main Detention Center Electronics Replacement project and Detention Facilities Renewal Replacement Project. These two major projects were combined as a result of 1) concurrent work requirements, 2) to eliminate duplicative and contractor general costs; 3) reduce the probability of repetitive extraordinary security awareness/training required for construction crew, and 4) set performance accountability with a single contractor. After testing the existing locking control system, it was determined that the locking controls/intercom wiring did not need to be replaced, which resulted in a credit to the County in the amount of \$351,944.

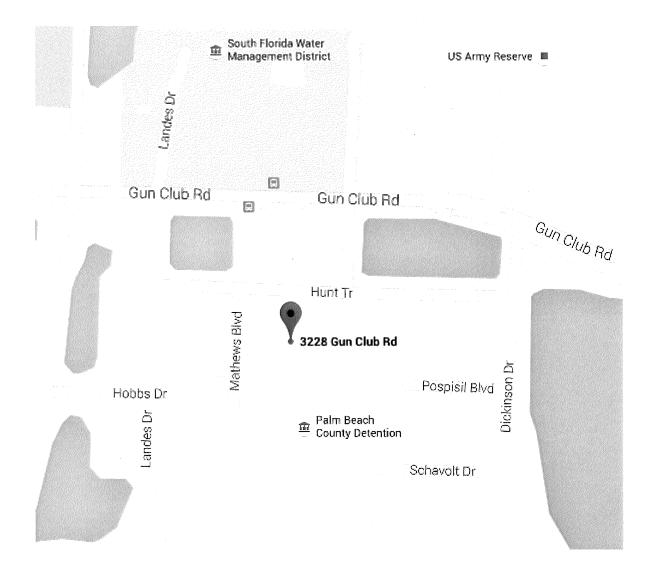
LOCATION MAP

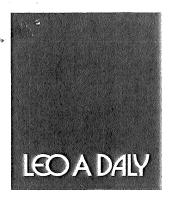

Re: Results of survey performed on door locking and intercom systems in "Pod B"

Mike,

A survey of the existing detention cell door locking, and intercoms were conducted for the cell locations in "B"-Pod.

The protocol followed for testing the detention cell door locking was operating all locks several times for proper function. Issues found are stated below.

The protocols followed for testing the cell door locks was to ensure proper voltage and wiring to locks through testing and identify problems with the locks not operating properly. The findings are listed below.

The protocol followed for testing the cell intercoms was to test through operation and results are identified in Note #5 on page 2.

Based upon this survey conducted, the following deficiencies were noted:

B-Pod: Level 1

Cell # B101 (Per Sheet E203)/ B101 (Field): The Intercom although working, is muffled and does not appear to be functioning properly.

Cell # B203 (Per Sheet E203)/ B203 (Field): Daytime Door Release not Functioning Cell # B204 (Per Sheet E203)/ B204 (Field): Daytime Door Release not Functioning

B-Pod: Mezzanine

Cell # B222 (Per Sheet E203)/ B208 (Field): Daytime Door Release not Functioning Cell # B223 (Per Sheet E203)/ B209 (Field): Daytime Door Release not Functioning and the Intercom although working, is muffled and does not appear to be functioning properly.

Cell # B424 (Per Sheet E203)/ B412 (Field): Door Lock is not functioning and Daytime Door Release not Functioning

After our survey was conducted, we were made aware on 08-09-18, of a prior letter from ESS that states the following:

"Holding Cell Pod's A & B cell doors are sharing a ground wire. Each door should have a dedicated ground wire back to the Security Electronics Room. In Pod B, holding cell B412, when the call button is pressed, holding cell door B412 door opens along with several other holding cell doors."

We do not believe this issue is related to "shared grounding" for the following reason:

The conductor referred to is the equipment grounding conductor and serves to provide a fault current path by connecting normally non-current carrying metal enclosures of electrical equipment to the system grounded conductor so it is not a conductor that is related to the door lock system wiring as it pertains to control thereof.

As to the multiple doors opening simultaneously this would be more likely a programming issue not an electrical one.

Upon receipt of the letter from ESS, the electrical subcontractor reached out to Com-Tec for additional input. Comtec made a site visit on 09-13-18. The following actions were performed and observations noted:

- 1. Within the Terminal Cabinet, the control and status wires for non-functioning Door (B412) were removed from the I/O associated with B412 on the door control board and re-landed to a working door. All wiring determined to be functioning properly.
- 2. Within the terminal cabinet, The control and status wires for a functioning Door were removed from the I/O associated with the functioning door on the door control board and re-landed to non-functioning Door B412. As this door did not function properly, it has been determined that the lock is faulty.
- 3. The black status wire was found to be mis-labeled for Dr B412 (corrected in field)
- 4. Within the Terminal Cabinet, it was discovered that the status connectors on the door boards were not fully seated. Comtec re-seated all the connectors on all the door boards and the previously non-functioning Daytime Door Release Buttons: B203, B204, B208 and B209 are now functioning. Daytime Door Release Button B412 is not functioning (due to faulty lock).
- 5. Upon inspection, it appeared that soap had been grated into the speaker holes and is likely causing the muffled-sound. Comtee explained there are security baffles between the speaker and faceplate and upon cleaning the faceplate, the units will likely function properly.

On 09-19-19, Hedrick Brothers removed one of the cell intercom speakers, cleaned the grated soap out of the faceplate and reinstalled. The unit appears to be functioning properly.

Conclusion

Based upon surveys, site visits and field investigations conducted, it is our opinion that the only work requiring to be performed related to the "B"-Pod cell locking and intercoms is to have Door B412 lock replaced and remove the soap from the intercom speakers faceplates and reinstall.
