I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) the third amendment to the civil engineering services annual contract (R2016-0310) dated March 22, 2016 with Mock Roos & Associates, Inc. (MRA);
- B) supplement no. 2 (Supplement) in the amount of \$25,689.19, to the work task order dated January 30, 2019 with MRA for the design of Belvedere Heights Phase I (Project); and
- C) a budget amendment of \$40,000 in the Capital Outlay Fund to recognize reimbursement funding from the Westgate Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency (Westgate CRA) and appropriate it to the Project.

SUMMARY: Approval of this third amendment will update the language of the termination section, criminal history records check section, non-discrimination section, scrutinized companies section and add the vendor self-service registration required section to be compliant with current Palm Beach County standards. Approval of this supplement will provide for the completion of the civil design and construction plans preparation necessary for the Project. The solicitation for design professionals was advertised on August 9, 2015 and August 16, 2015. The annual contract was approved on March 22, 2016, prior to the effective date of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance and pursuant to the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance at that time. The SBE goal for all contracts was 15%. MRA proposed 100% SBE participation. Their SBE participation for this supplement is 100%. Their cumulative SBE participation to date including this supplement is 96.82%. MRA is a Palm Beach County (County) based company. The Westgate CRA received a Local Agency Program (LAP) federally funded grant through the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the project. This grant requires that the County perform the design and construction as we are LAP certified. District 7 (YBH)

Background and Justification: On March 22, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the annual contract R2016-0310 for civil engineering services with MRA.

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
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Background and Justification: (Continued from Page 1)

The original work task order for the project was approved by the Contract Review Committee (CRC) on January 30, 2019 to provide 35% design plans, survey, and a cultural resource assessment for the design of sidewalks and lighting along five residential streets within the Westgate CRA. Supplement #1 provided 35% to 96% design plans. This supplement will provide for the finalization of design, and the construction plans, as required by the FDOT LAP funding. The fee as detailed in **Exhibit B** of the attached supplement, has been negotiated as just and reasonable compensation as follows:

The first amendment to the contract (R2017-0142) dated February 7, 2017, extended the expiration date to March 21, 2018. The second amendment to the contract (R2018-0134) dated February 6, 2018, extended the expiration date to March 21, 2019, modified the payments section, and added the public records and additional reporting sections. The Westgate CRA provided \$40,000 toward funding the project and the Belvedere Heights Phase 1 work task order was approved by the CRC on January 30, 2019. After reviewing the attached supplement for professional services and finding it in proper order, the Engineering Department recommends BCC approval.

AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO THE ANNUAL CIVIL ENGINEERING PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND MOCK, ROOS & ASSOCIATES, INC.

This Amendment No. 3 to the Annual Civil Professional Services Contract (R2016-0310), dated March 22, 2016, (ANNUAL CONTRACT), is made and entered into the ______ day of ______, 20_____, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners (COUNTY) and Mock, Roos & Associates, Inc. (CONSULTANT) (individually Party and collectively Parties).

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CONSULTANT entered into the ANNUAL CONTRACT on March 22, 2016 (R2016-0310), as amended on February 7, 2017 (R2017-0142), February 6, 2018 (R2018-0134) and March 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the ANNUAL CONTRACT extended the expiration date to March 21, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 2 to the ANNUAL CONTRACT extended the expiration date to March 21, 2019, modified the payments section added public records section, and additional reporting section; and

WHEREAS, by this Amendment No. 3, the CONSULTANT and the COUNTY mutually agree to amend the ANNUAL CONTRACT as provided herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises, and agreements herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

The above recitations are true and correct and incorporated herein.

1. **SECTION 7.1 - TERMINATION** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Section 7.1 – TERMINATION

This Contract may be terminated by the CONSULTANT upon sixty (60) days prior written notice to the COUNTY in the event of substantial failure by the COUNTY to perform in accordance with

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the terms of this Contract through no fault of the CONSULTANT. It may also be terminated, in whole or in part, by the COUNTY, with cause upon five (5) business days written notice to the CONSULTANT or without cause upon ten (10) business days written notice to the CONSULTANT. Unless the CONSULTANT is in breach of this Contract, the CONSULTANT shall be paid for services rendered to the COUNTY'S satisfaction through the date of termination. After receipt of a Termination Notice, except as otherwise directed by the COUNTY, in writing, the CONSULTANT shall:

- A. Stop work on the date and to the extent specified.
- B. Terminate and settle all orders and subcontracts relating to the performance of the terminated work.
- C. Transfer all work in process, completed work, and other materials related to the terminated work to the COUNTY.
- D. Continue and complete all parts of the work that have not been terminated.
- 2. **SECTION 9 CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 9 – CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK

The CONSULTANT, CONSULTANT'S employees, subcontractors of CONSULTANT and employees of subcontractors shall comply with Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-371 - 2-377, the Palm Beach County Criminal History Records Check Ordinance (Ordinance), for unescorted access to critical facilities (Critical Facilities) or criminal justice information facilities (CJI Facilities) as identified in Resolution R-2003-1274, as amended. The CONSULTANT is solely responsible for the financial, schedule, and/or staffing implications of this Ordinance. Further, the CONSULTANT acknowledges that its Contract price includes any and all direct or indirect costs associated with compliance with this Ordinance, except for the applicable FDLE/FBI fees that shall be paid by the COUNTY.

This Contract may include sites and/or buildings which have been designated as either critical facilities or criminal justice information facilities pursuant to the Ordinance and Resolution R2003-1274, as amended. COUNTY staff representing the COUNTY department will contact the CONSULTANT(S) and provide specific instructions for meeting the requirements of this Ordinance. Individuals passing the background check will be issued a badge. The CONSULTANT shall make every effort to collect the badges of its employees and its subcontractors' employees upon conclusion of the contract and return them to the COUNTY. If the CONSULTANT or its



subcontractor(s) terminates an employee who has been issued a badge, the CONSULTANT must notify the COUNTY within two (2) hours. At the time of termination, the CONSULTANT shall retrieve the badge and shall return it to the COUNTY in a timely manner.

The COUNTY reserves the right to suspend the CONSULTANT if the CONSULTANT 1) does not comply with the requirements of County Code Section 2-371 - 2-377, as amended; 2) does not contact the COUNTY regarding a terminated CONSULTANT employee or subcontractor employee within the stated time; or 3) fails to make a good faith effort in attempting to comply with the badge retrieval policy.

3. **SECTION 12 - NON-DISCRIMINATION** of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

SECTION 12 - NON-DISCRIMINATION

The COUNTY is committed to assuring equal opportunity in the award of contracts and complies with all laws prohibiting discrimination. Pursuant to Palm Beach County Resolution R2017-1770, as may be amended, the CONSULTANT warrants and represents that throughout the term of the Contract, including any renewals thereof, if applicable, all of its employees are treated equally during employment without regard to race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, or genetic information. Failure to meet this requirement shall be considered default of the Contract.

As a condition of entering into this Contract, the CONSULTANT represents and warrants that it will comply with the COUNTY'S Commercial Nondiscrimination Policy as described in Resolution 2017-1770, as amended. As part of such compliance, the CONSULTANT shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, religion, ancestry, sex, age, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, or genetic information in the solicitation, selection, hiring or commercial treatment of subcontractors, vendors, suppliers, or commercial customers, nor shall the CONSULTANT retaliate against any person for reporting instances of such discrimination. The CONSULTANT shall provide equal opportunity for subcontractors, vendors and suppliers to participate in all of its public sector and private sector subcontracting and supply opportunities, provided that nothing contained in this clause shall prohibit or limit otherwise lawful efforts to remedy the effects of marketplace discrimination that have occurred or are occurring in the COUNTY'S relevant marketplace in Palm Beach County. The CONSULTANT understands and agrees that a material violation of this clause shall be considered a material breach of this Contract and may result in termination of this Contract, disqualification or debarment of the company from participating in COUNTY contracts, or other sanctions. This clause is not enforceable by or for the benefit of, and creates no obligation to, any third party.



CONSULTANT shall include this language in its subcontracts.

SECTION 20 - SCRUTINIZED COMPANIES of the ANNUAL CONTRACT is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

4. SECTION 20 - SCRUTINIZED COMPANIES

As provided in F.S. 287.135, by entering into this Contract or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the CONSULTANT certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Scrutinized Companies that boycott Israel List, or is engaged in a boycott of Israel, pursuant to F.S. 215.4725.

When contract value is greater than \$1 million: As provided in F.S. 287.135, by entering into this Contract or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the CONSULTANT certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Scrutinized Companies With Activities in Sudan List or Scrutinized Companies With Activities in The Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List created pursuant to F.S. 215.473 or is engaged in business operations in Cuba or Syria.

If the COUNTY determines, using credible information available to the public, that a false certification has been submitted by CONSULTANT, this Contract may be terminated and a civil penalty equal to the greater of \$2 million or twice the amount of this Contract shall be imposed, pursuant to F.S. 287.135. Said certification must also be submitted at the time of Contract renewal, if applicable.

5. SECTION 23 – VSS REGISTRATION REQUIRED is hereby added to the ANNUAL CONTRACT:

SECTION 23 – VSS REGISTRATION REQUIRED

In order to do business with Palm Beach County, consultants are required to create a Vendor Registration Account OR activate an existing Vendor Registration Account through the Purchasing Department's Vendor Self Service (VSS) system, which can be accessed at

If CONSULTANT intends to use sub-consultants, CONSULTANT must also ensure that all subconsultants are registered as consultants in VSS. All subcontractor agreements must include a contractual provision requiring that the sub-consultant register in VSS. COUNTY will not finalize a contract award until the COUNTY has verified that the CONSULTANT and all of its subconsultants are registered in VSS. It is the intent of the Parties hereto that this Amendment No. 3 shall not become binding until the date executed by the COUNTY.

Except as hereby amended, changed or modified, all other provisions of the ANNUAL CONTRACT, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

Palm Beach County Project No. 2018027 **SUPPLEMENT NO. 2 SCOPE OF SERVICES** Revised November 5, 2019

OVERVIEW

ale Palm Beach County is assisting the Westgate/Belvedere Homes CRA in obtaining a FDOT LAP Grant for installing sidewalks and lighting along five residential streets. Mock Roos has provided the necessary preliminary engineering and related services to prepare construction plans for the project up to approximately 35% complete under the initial work authorization for this project. This included environmental studies under a FDOT LAP grant funding for the following five (5) streets in unincorporated Palm Beach County:

- Upland Road (660 feet long)
- Ardmore Road (660 feet long)
- Kenwood Road (660 feet long)
- Whitney Road (660 feet long)
- Worthington Road (1320 feet long)

Each street is proposed to receive 6-foot wide sidewalks (totaling about 8,000 feet long) on both sides of each paved roadway, and six streetlights dispersed in a zig-zag fashion on each 660-foot long road, eleven streetlights on the 1320-foot long road, for a total of 35 pedestrian lights. Sidewalks must conform to current ADA standards, possibly requiring reconstruction of driveway aprons within the rights-of-way. The existing right-of-way width of each street is 50 feet, except for Kenwood Road which is 60 feet wide. No additional right-of-way acquisition is anticipated.

The following tasks have been completed under the initial authorization for this project:

- Topographic Surveys of each street and a Specific Purpose Survey approved by Palm Beach County Survey Department.
- A Master Plan depicting the proposed improvements has been prepared and accepted by the County.
- Conceptual Lighting options have been provided to the County for selection by the Community Redevelopment Agency.
- A Cultural Resource Assessment Study and Report has been completed and transmitted to FDOT.

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• 35% Progress construction plans are currently proceeding forward. The 35% progress submittal and review of County and FDOT comments are included in the initial authorization.

The following tasks will be completed under Supplement No. 1 for this project:

- 65% Progress construction plans for Submittal to County.
- 96% Progress construction plans for progress submittal and review of County and FDOT comments.

Once the 96% plans are complete and submitted to FDOT for review, this final scope of services will be completed. Therefore, to complete the construction plans for approval by FDOT and securing appropriate LAP funding, this supplemental services authorization is necessary to progress the design.

Continued basic services required for completion of this project include:

- 1. Civil Engineering & Project Management (by Mock Roos)
- 2. Electrical Engineering (by C&W Engineering)

All additional work to be performed under this scope of services shall be in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Basic Services agreement as an Annual Civil Engineering Consultant, including amendments, between Palm Beach County and Mock Roos, dated March 22, 2016. Any additional services requested by the County beyond this scope of services shall be performed under a separate authorization.

SCOPE OF SERVICES DESCRIPTION

Project Management:

Mock Roos will continue to provide project team management through the LAP Funding process by:

- 1. Preparing a team project schedule to meet the requirements of the established FDOT schedule and monitor the team's progress.
- 2. Coordinate directly with the County on the progress schedule, making submittals, and communicating directives from either the County or FDOT. Up to two (2) additional meetings are anticipated with the County and/or FDOT.
- 3. Providing plans for County & FDOT reviews, and prepare responses to agency comments, as follows:
 - a. Final (100%) submittal to County; make revisions resubmit to County for FDOT Production Package submittal; make FDOT revisions, if any resubmit Final Production Package to County for FDOT.

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All submittals to be made electronically and as hardcopy (2 sets each).

4. Assist Palm Beach County by addressing questions and providing relevant data to FDOT for obtaining the LAP Funding on this project.

Civil Engineering:

Professional services shall include the preparation of the final set of construction plans, technical specifications, and estimated costs for the construction of the above described sidewalks on the designated five residential streets. The following tasks will be performed:

- 1. Continue preparation of the 100% construction drawings in accordance with Palm Beach County Design Standards, consisting of:
 - a. Street Typical Sections showing the proposed improvements (sidewalks and streetlights).
 - b. Plan Sheets (6 estimated, 1"=40' scale 11x17 format) for new construction, indicating finished grading, supporting data, etc. (no profiles of streets required)
 Project L section/Course Sheet
 - c. Project Location/Cover Sheet.
 - d. General Construction Notes and Legends.
 - e. Street Cross Sections, as determined necessary.
 - f. Completion of Summary of Quantities table with Pay Item footnotes, as required.
- 2. Finalize utility coordination with County staff and affected utility companies. Determine any potential above-ground or underground utility conflicts that may affect the components of the project. Resolve such conflicts as necessary.
- 3. Final calculate quantities of the proposed improvements at each progress submittal and provide an estimate of construction cost based on unit prices provided by Palm Beach County.
