



Jog Road, West Palm Beach, FL 33411-2745, hereinafter called the COUNTY.

WHEREAS, on <u>February 1, 2017</u>, the parties entered into a County Incentive Grant Program Agreement, hereinafter referred to as the Agreement, wherein the COUNTY agreed to provide certain improvements in connection with Financial Management (FM) No. 431645-1-54-01 for intersection improvements at SR809/Military Trail and Northlake Blvd. in Palm Beach County, Florida and hereinafter referred to as the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended on May 2, 2019 (Amendment No. 1); and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to further amend the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto mutually agree that this Amendment is in their best interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representations herein, the parties agree to amend that certain County Incentive Grant Program Agreement dated <u>February 1, 2017</u> as follows:

- 2. This Amendment extends the term of this Agreement. Paragraph 2 of Amendment No. 1 is amended as follows:

Except as otherwise set forth herein, this Agreement shall continue in effect and be binding to both the COUNTY and the DEPARTMENT until the Project is completed as evidenced by the written acceptance of the DEPARTMENT or June 30, 2020, whichever occurs first.

All provisions, covenants, terms and conditions of the Agreement between the parties theretofore entered on February 1, 2017, and Amendment Number One entered on May 2, 2019 as originally set forth therein, which are not hereby expressly amended or modified and not in conflict with the terms hereof, are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain the same and be unaffected by these presents.

THIS AMENDMENT, made and entered into this <u>27</u> day of <u>December</u>, 20 19, by and between the State of Florida Department of Transportation, hereinafter called the DEPARTMENT, and Palm Beach County, located at 2300 North Jog Road, West Palm Beach, Florida 33411, hereinafter called the COUNTY.

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on October 24, 2013 the parties entered into a County Incentive Grant Program Agreement, hereinafter referred to as the Agreement, wherein the COUNTY agreed to provide certain improvements in connection with Financial Management (FM) No. 433064-1-38-01 for the design of a three lane roadway on Congress Avenue Extension from Northlake Boulevard to Alt A-1-A/Richard Road in Palm Beach County, Florida hereinafter referred to as the "Project"; and

WHEREAS, the parties amended the Agreement on December 17, 2015 (Amendment Number One), November 29, 2017 (Amendment Number Two), June 7, 2018 (Amendment Number Three), December 4, 2018 (Amendment Number Four); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto mutually agree that this Amendment is in their best interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and representations herein, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are deemed incorporated herein.
- 2. This Amendment extends the term of this Agreement. Paragraph 2 of Amendment Number Four is amended as follows:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. R-2012-** 0035

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA;

AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS TO EXISTING FUNDING AGREEMENTS WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORATION CONCERNING THE EXTENSION OF THEIR EXPIRATION DATES AND THE ADDITION OF E-VERIFY LANGUAGE

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) routinely awards

Grants to the County to help fund roadway improvements; and

WHEREAS, the FDOT requires that the County enter into a Joint Participation Funding Agreement outlining the responsibilities of each party with respect to the Grants; and

WHEREAS, through these Funding Agreements, the County will accomplish the projects including design, right-of-way acquisition, construction and construction engineering inspection; and

WHEREAS, these Funding Agreements often require an extension of time to complete the project and receive the Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, these time extensions now also require that E-Verify language be added if it was not in the original Funding Agreement whereby the County and its contractors attest to the employment eligibility of all those working on the project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that the delegation of authority to the County Administrator or his designee to execute amendments to the Funding Agreements for extensions of time and addition of E-Verify language is necessary for the efficient and timely processing of time extensions and to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of Palm Beach County.

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, that the County Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to execute Amendments to Funding Agreements with the Florida Department of Transportation to extend expiration deadlines and add E-Verify language.
