I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

(A) A contract (Contract) with Stryker Electrical Contracting, Inc. (Stryker) in the amount of \$4,962,752 and 635 Calendar Days for the Public Address (PA) System Replacement at Palm Beach International Airport (PBI); and

(B) A Budget Transfer of \$29,748 in the Airport's Improvement and Development Fund to increase project cost budget by \$29,748 and a transfer from Reserves of \$ 29,748.

Summary: This project was advertised utilizing the County's competitive bid process. On March 17, 2020, two (2) bids were received for the PA System Replacement at PBI. Of the two bids, Stryker, a Martin County, Florida company has been identified as the lowest responsible/responsive bidder in the amount of \$4,962,752. The existing public address system was installed in the terminal in 1988. It was upgraded in 1999, but the speakers and the cabling were not replaced. The system can no longer be maintained due to the lack of available compatible parts. This project includes demolition of the existing system and the installation of new conduit, wiring, software, speakers, and amplifiers. It also includes repairs to the existing soffits and ceilings required as a result of the work. A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal of 15% was established for this project. Stryker has committed to 15% DBE participation for this Contract.

Countywide (AH)

Background and Justification: The public address notification system is essential to operations at an airport as it provides airline paging and emergency notifications. The existing system has exceeded its useful life and has become difficult to maintain due to the availability of compatible parts. The existing system is to remain operational while the new system is installed in the terminal and concourses. The scope includes a new head end system along with new amplifiers, speakers, conduit and wiring. The work will be completed in phases primarily at night to minimize the impact to the traveling public. Builder's Risk Insurance for this work will be provided by the Contractor prior to start of construction.



The prices named in the Bid are for the completed work, and include the furnishing of all materials and all labor, tools, and appliances and all expense, direct or indirect, connected with the proper execution of the work and of maintaining the same until it is accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

Time is of the essence. The Contractor shall commence the work to be performed under this Contract on the date set by the Owner in the written notice to proceed, continue the work with due diligence and shall complete the entire work per Attachment No. 2 to the Bid Form. Further, in the event interim milestone completion dates are established in Attachment No. 2 of the Bid Form for separable portions of the work, the Contractor agrees to complete said separable portions of the work in accordance with said milestone dates.

In case of failure on the part of the Contractor to complete the work within the time(s) specified in the Contract, or within such additional time(s) as may be granted by formal action of the Board of County Commissioners or fails to prosecute the work, or any separable part thereof, with such diligence as will insure its completion within the time(s) specified in the Contract or any extensions thereof, Owner will suffer damage, the amount of which is difficult, if not impossible to ascertain. Therefore, the Contractor shall pay to the Owner, as liquidated damages, the amounts indicated in the Milestone and Damages Data (Attachment #2 of the Bid Form) for each calendar day of delay that actual completion extends beyond the time limits specified in said Attachment until such reasonable time as may be required for final completion of work. In no way shall costs for liquidated damages be construed as a penalty on the Contractor.

Liquidated damages due to the Owner may be deducted from payments due to the Contractor, or may be collected from the Contractor or its surety or sureties. These provisions for liquidated damages shall not prevent the Owner, in case of the Contractor's default, from terminating the Contractor's right to proceed as provided in General Provision section 80-09 "Default and Termination of Contract".

As provided in F.S. 287.132-133, by entering into this contract or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the contractor certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the Convicted Vendor List maintained by the State of Florida Department of Management Services within the 36 months immediately preceding the date hereof. This notice is required by F.S. 287.133 (3) (a).

AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) has reviewed the submitted bids for the referenced project. The Bid Opening was conducted on March 17, 2020 at 2:00 PM, the established deadline for submission of bids.

A total of two (2) bids were received. The bids received were from Stryker Electrical Contracting, Inc. (Stryker) and The Weitz Company, LLC (Weitz). The base bids are arranged from lowest to highest along with the Engineer's Estimate in Table 1 below.

Stryker Electrical Contracting, Inc.	\$4,962,752.00

The Weitz Company, LLC	\$6,438,027.38 **

AECOM's review of the bids indicated that both Stryker and Weitz provided all supporting documentation required per the bid documents, including acceptance of all six (6) issued addenda.

The low bidder, Stryker, acknowledged all the addenda in the Bid Form but did not return the signed addenda sheets. Stryker provided multiple previous projects that serve to validate their experience as well as references for these projects. From our evaluation, it appears Stryker's bid submittal meets the qualifications, licenses, and experience that this contract requires. Stryker also has experience performing major electrical projects at PBIA of the similar scope and scale.

The second bidder, Weitz, did not correctly multiply the quantity by the unit cost presented; as stated on Instructions to Bidders Section 5.0 Bidding Procedure, Subsection 5.2.3, "the unit price shall govern and the amount will be corrected accordingly." Weitz provided multiple previous projects that serve to validate their experience as well as references for these projects. From our evaluation, it appears Weitz's bid submittal meets the licenses that this contract requires. However, the Weitz bid submittal does not provide an electrical qualification section for Davco Electrical Contractors Corp, identified as electrical subcontractor on Designation of Subcontractors (Attachment No. 3 to the Bid Form).



The Bid Tabulation analysis and the Bid Review Checklist are attached. Based on the qualifications of the two (2) bids submitted, all bidders provided their past experience for similar public address system projects.

Based on AECOM's evaluation of the base bid; qualifications, experience and the bids obtained per Section 6.3 Award of Contract in the Bid Form, it is our recommendation that the DOA award the PB 20-1, Public Address System Replacement Contract to the lowest responsible/responsive bidder, Stryker Electrical Contracting, Inc., contingent on the DOA's legal and DBE review of the bid documents.




