Summary: On April 3, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners approved the addition of an at-large seat on the County Financing Committee (CFC). The Committee is currently comprised of the Director of the Office of Financial Management & Budget (Sherry Brown), a representative from the Clerk & Comptroller's Office (Stephen Weiss), two (2) representatives from local government agencies (Ron Horan, Palm Beach County School District Treasury Manager and Paul Dumars, Director of Financial Services, Palm Beach County Solid Waste Authority), and a County Department Director, if needed. A memo dated February 7, 2020 was circulated to the BCC notifying the Board that the at-large seat on the CFC is currently vacant. The Board appointee will serve a term of three years, at which time the appointee may be re-appointed, or a new appointee selected by the Board. The Committee has 5 seats and the diversity count is: 1 African-American (20%), 4 Caucasian (80%). The gender ratio (female: male) is 1:4. Countywide (DB)

Background and Justification: The appointee should have substantial experience in the financial services industry but cannot be employed or recently retired from a firm that is on contract or rotation of contract to do business with the County. The following firms are under contract with the County in regards to underwriting services: CitiGroup Global Markets, Morgan Stanley and Company, Bank of America Merrill Lynch, JP Morgan Securities, Goldman Sachs & Company, RBC Capital Markets, Wells Fargo Securities, Stifel, Raymond James & Associates, and PNC Bank. The following firms are under contract with the County to provide bond counsel and disclosure counsel services respectively: Locke Lord LLP and Bryant Miller Olive. The County's financial advisory services are provided by Public Financial Management (PFM).

These exemptions are described in the Code. This prohibition does not apply when the advisory board member's board provides no regulation, oversight, management, or policy-setting recommendations regarding the subject contract or transaction and the contract or transaction is disclosed at a public meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. To determine compliance with this provision, it is necessary that you, as a board member applicant, identify all contractual relationships between Palm Beach County government and you as an individual, directly or indirectly, or your employer or business. This information should be provided in the space below. If there are no contracts or transactions to report, please verify that none exist. Staff will review this information and determine if you are eligible to serve or if you may be eligible for an exception or waiver pursuant to the code.
