I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 13 to the Consulting/Professional Services General Utility, Architectural, and Value Engineering Services Contract (Contract) with Baxter & Woodman, Inc. (Consultant) for Operation and Condition Assessments for Repump Stations System 5 and 9-South (Project) for a fixed price of \$181,476.44.

Summary: On June 20, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2017-0815) with Consultant. CSA No. 13 provides for engineering services to identify and recommend improvements at the repump stations for the Project. The services include evaluation of existing system flows, assessment of existing operating conditions, and identification of improvements to be incorporated into the detailed design. This Contract was procured under the requirements of the 2002 Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance (R2002-0064) prior to the adoption of the new Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance on October 16, 2018. The SBE participation goal established under the 2002 SBE Ordinance was 15% overall participation. The Contract provides for 26% SBE participation. CSA No. 13 includes 42.80% SBE participation. The cumulative SBE participation including CSA No. 13 is 34.56%. Consultant is headquartered in Crystal Lake, Illinois, but maintains an office in Palm Beach County from which the majority of the work will be undertaken. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY20 Budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 20-024) Districts 3 and 5 (MJ)

Background and Justification: The Repump Stations Nos. 5, 9-South, and 4100 are integral components of the wastewater network serving Palm Beach County, particularly for west Boca Raton, west Boynton Beach, and the Royal Palm Beach regions. They convey flow from dozens of lift stations toward their respective destinations at the Southern Region Water Reclamation Facility and the East Central Regional Water Reclamation Facility. Operation and condition assessments to Repump Station Nos. 5, 9-South, and 4100 are needed to increase reliability, safety, and operability of the wastewater collection system.
