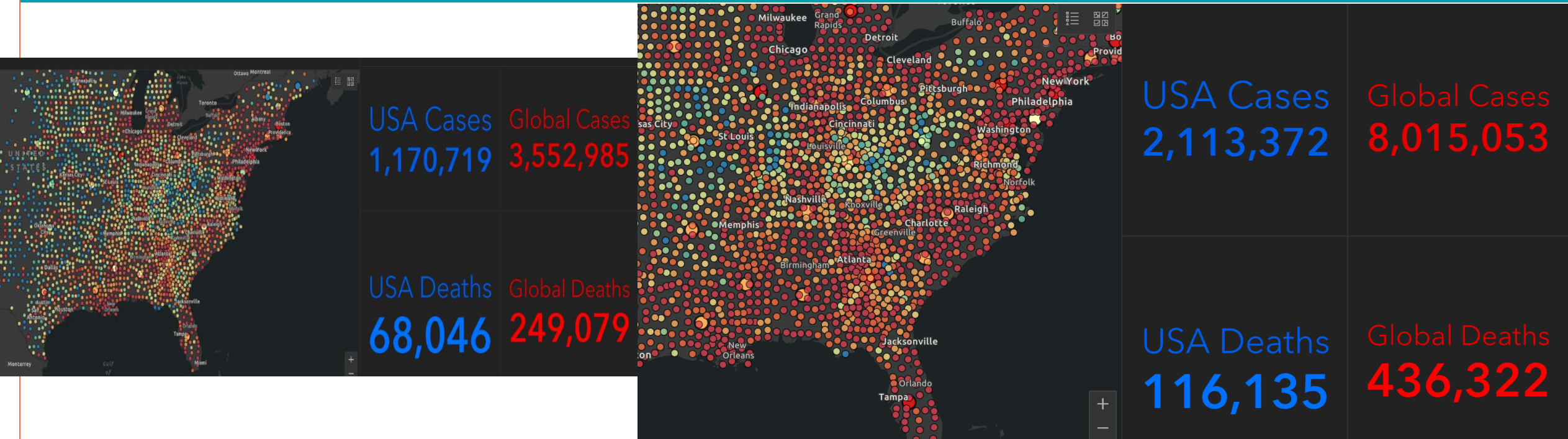

Total COVID Cases – Global and U.S.



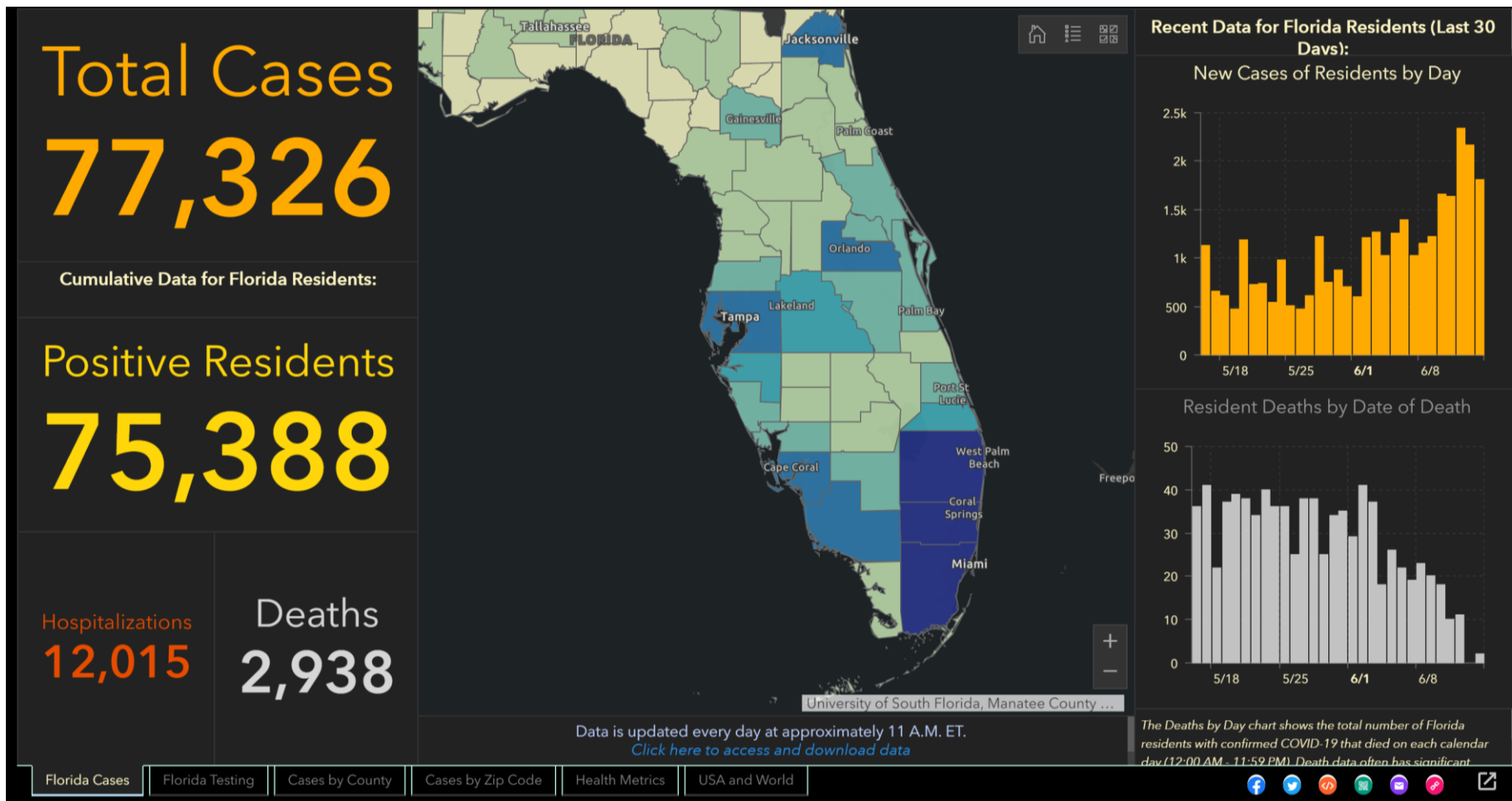

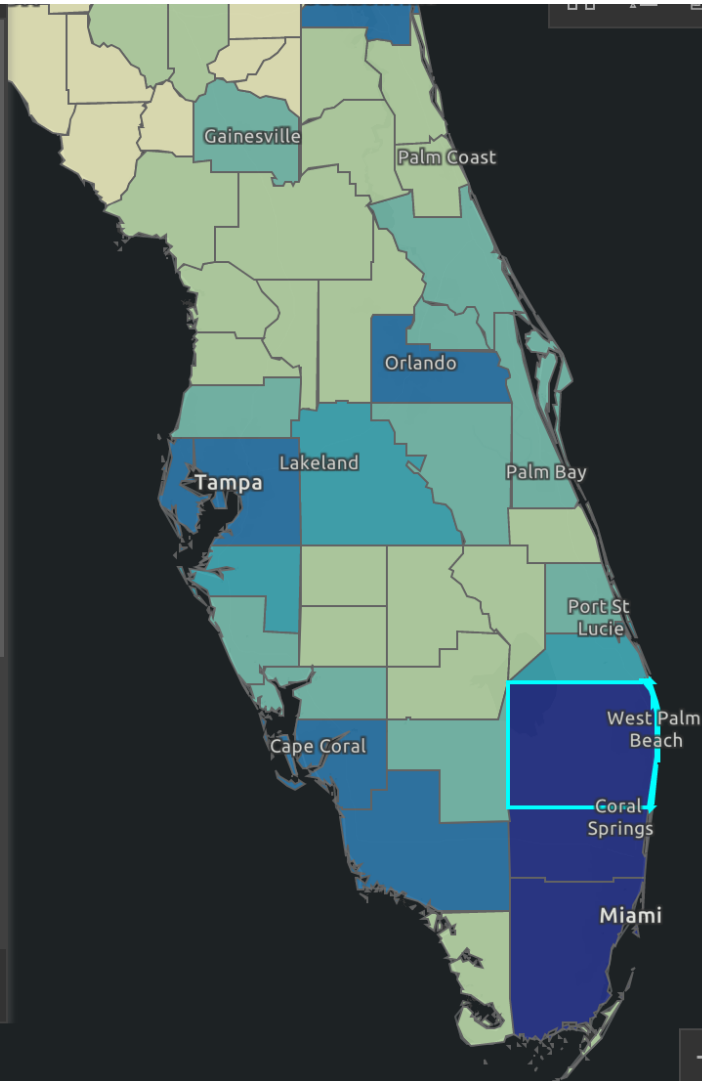

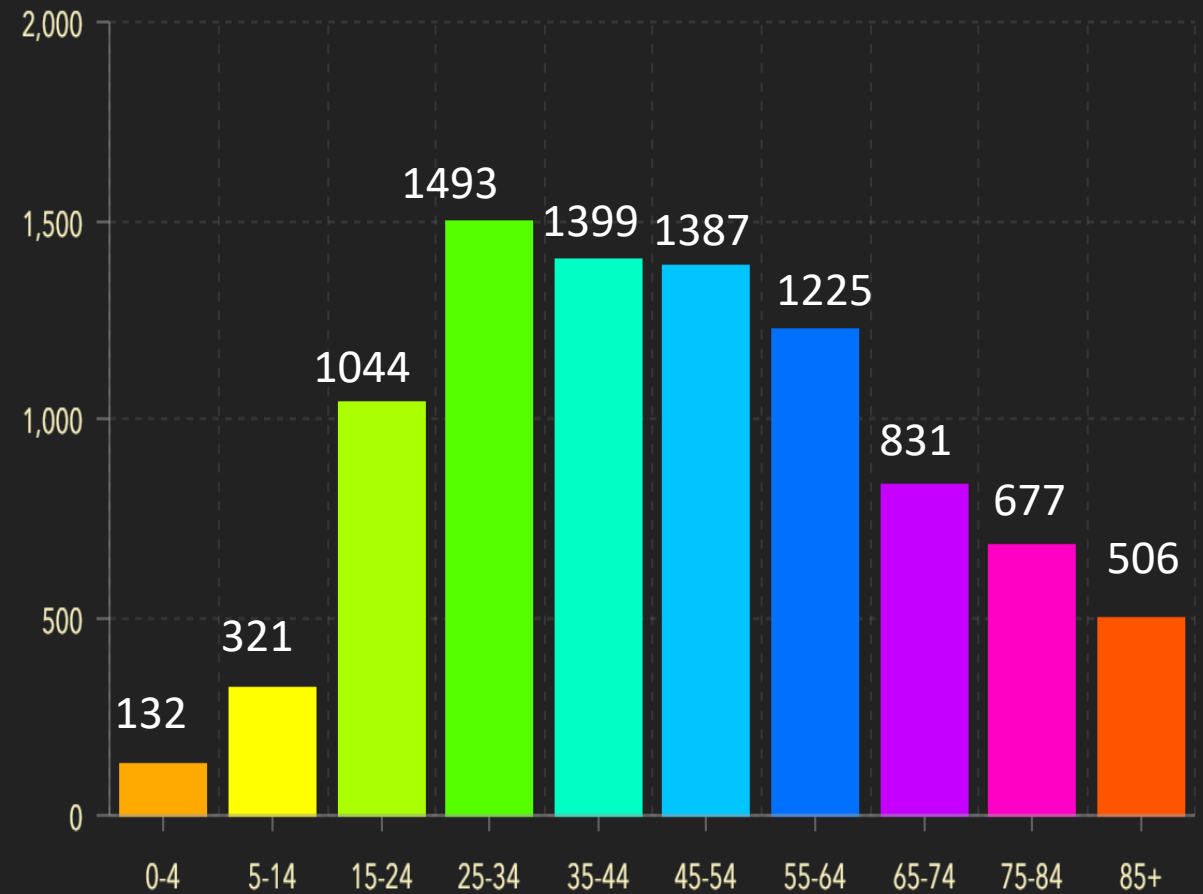

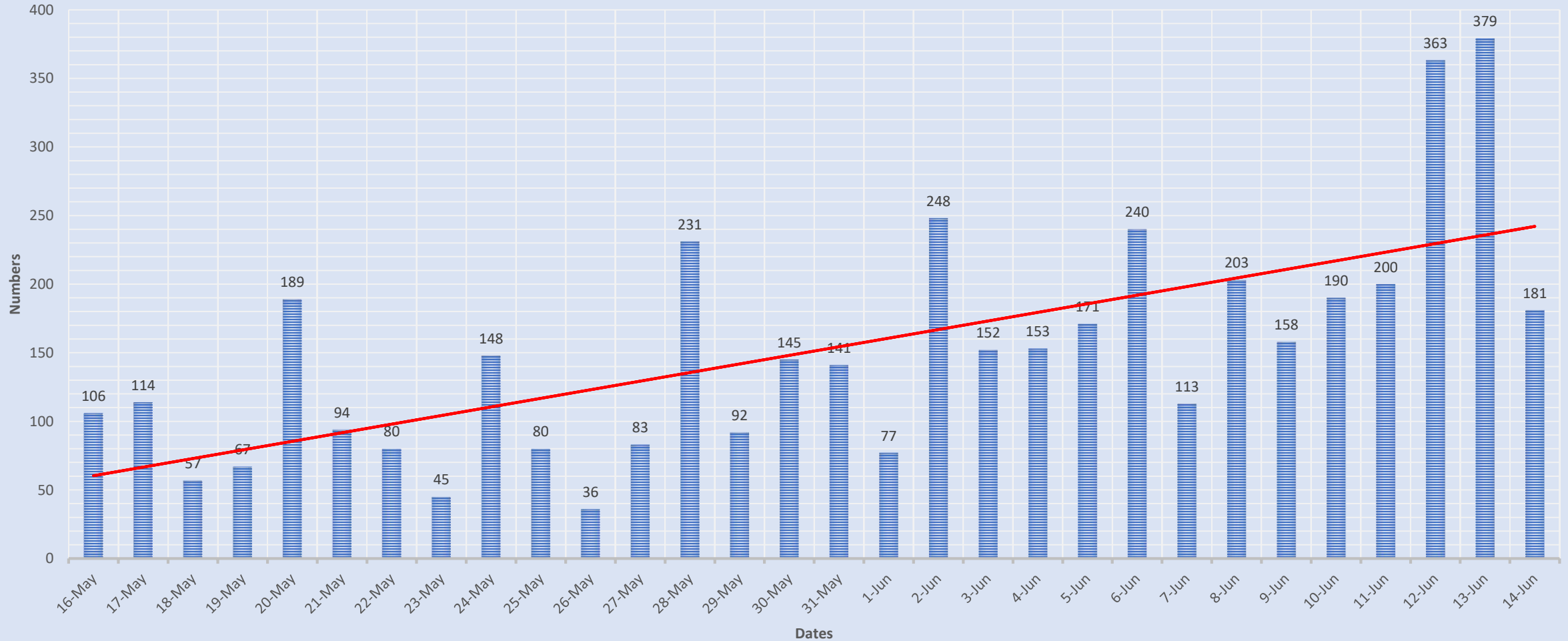
Age Distribution of Cases

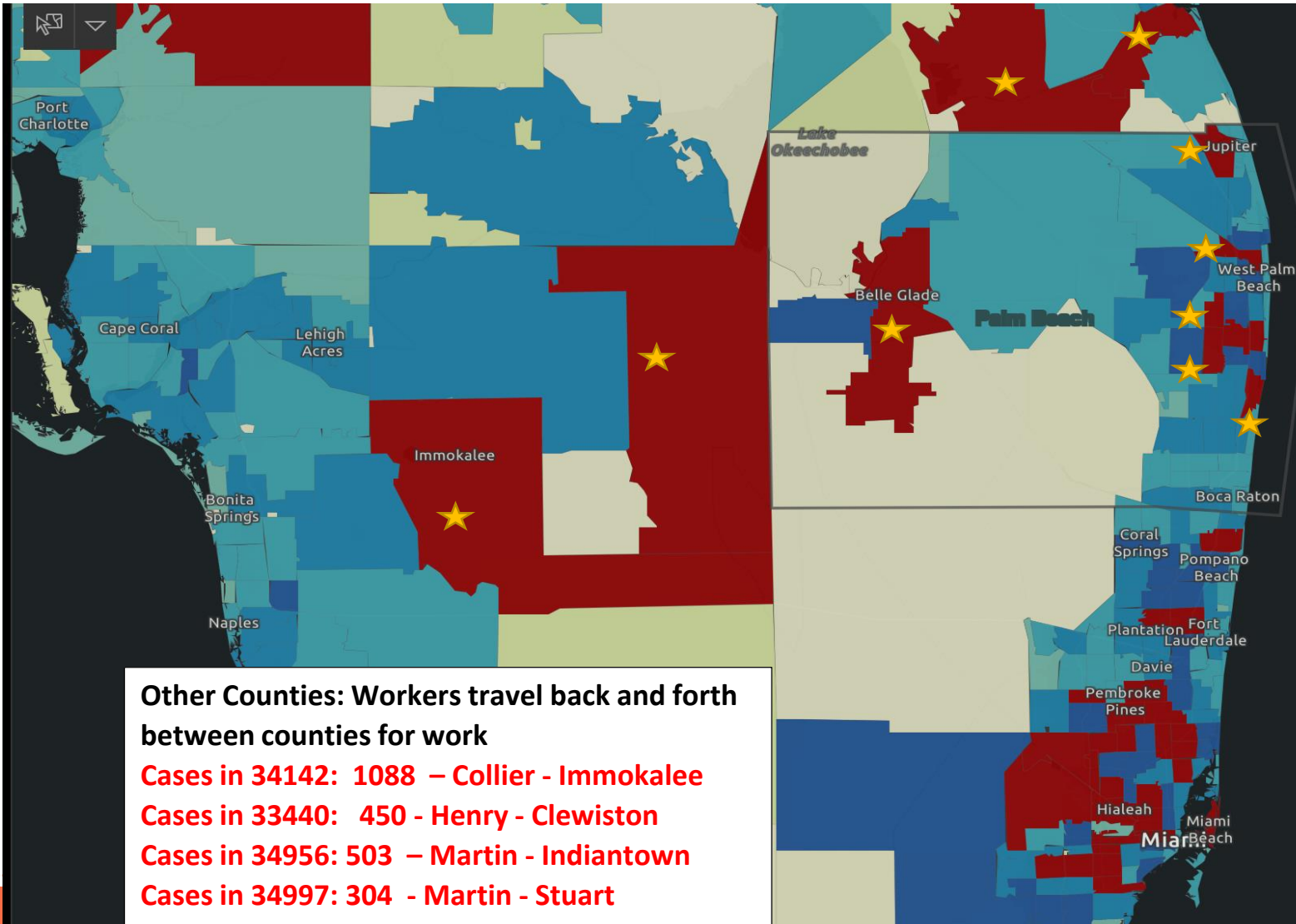
COVID CASES PER DAY 5/15 TO 6/14

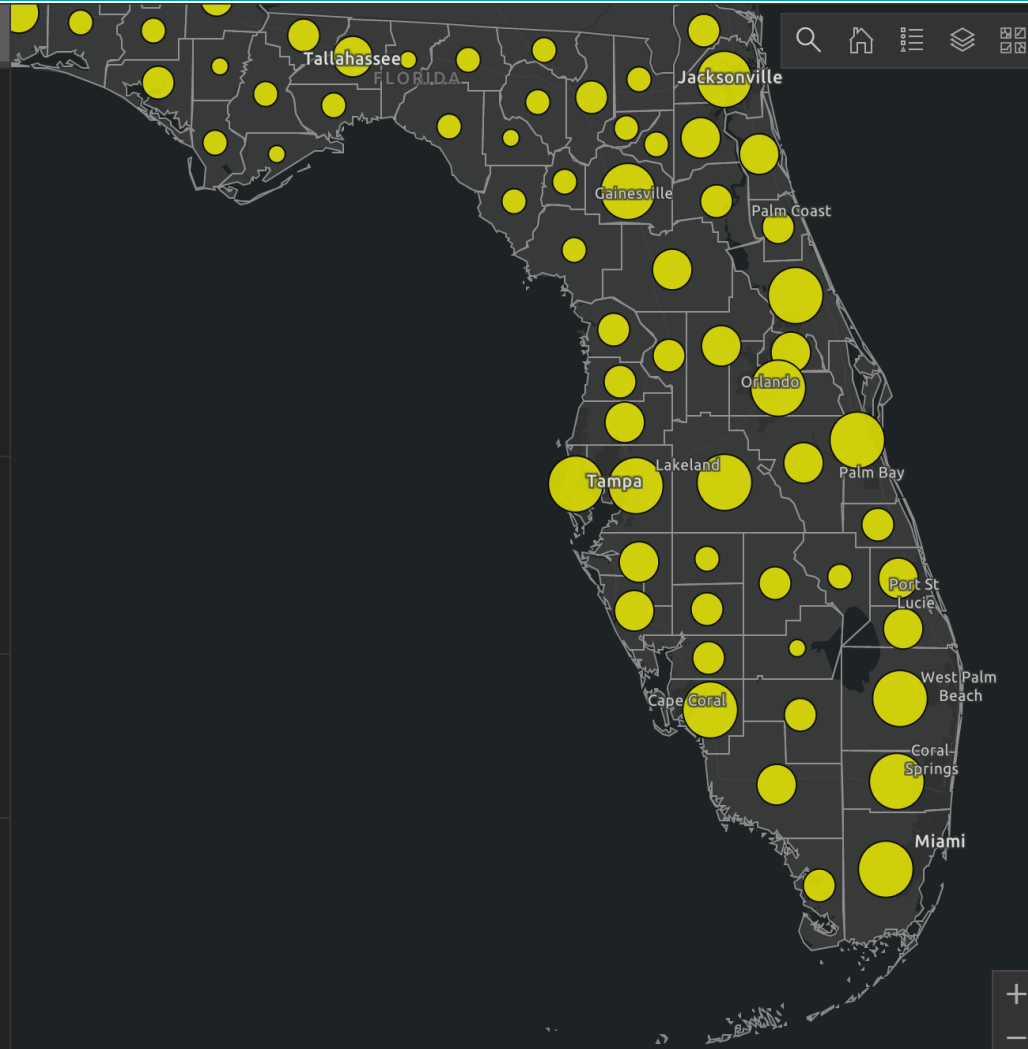
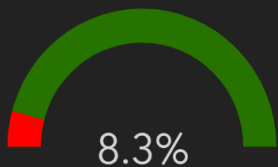

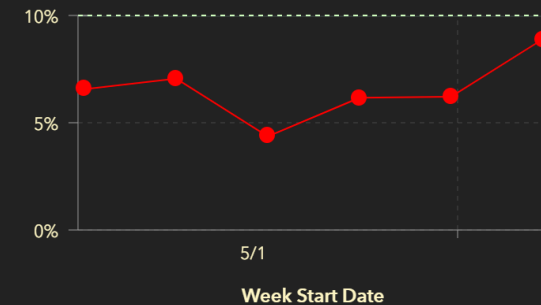

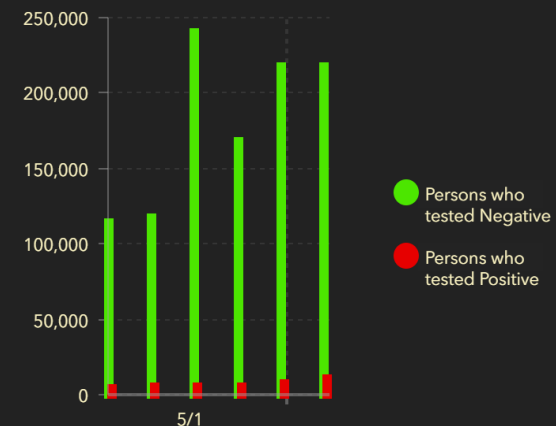
PERCENT POSITIVE FOR LABORATORY TESTING
(last six weeks)



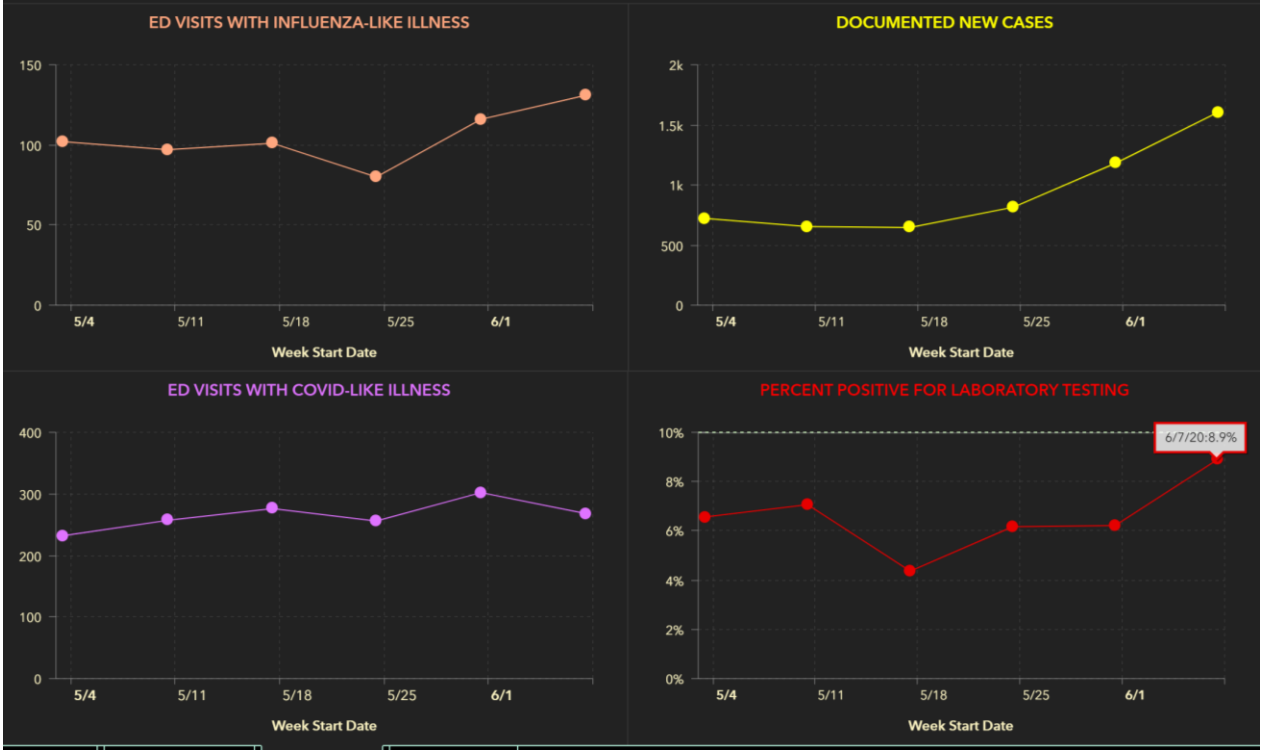
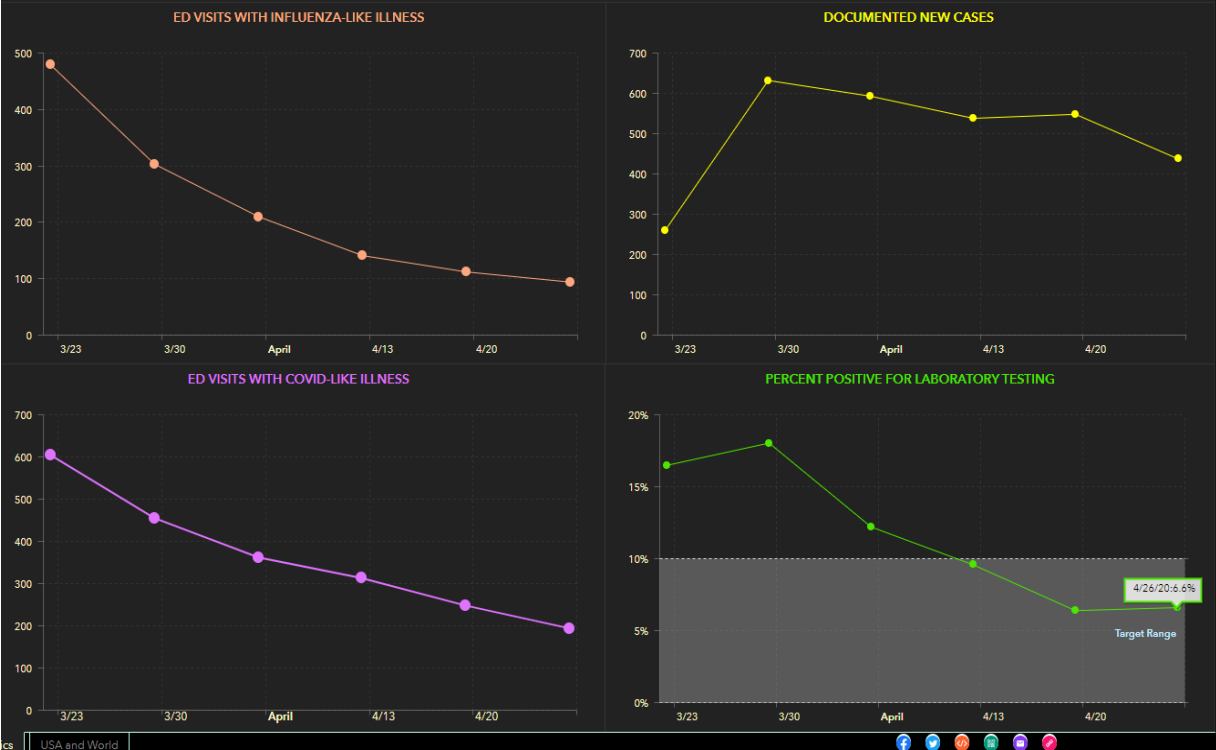
