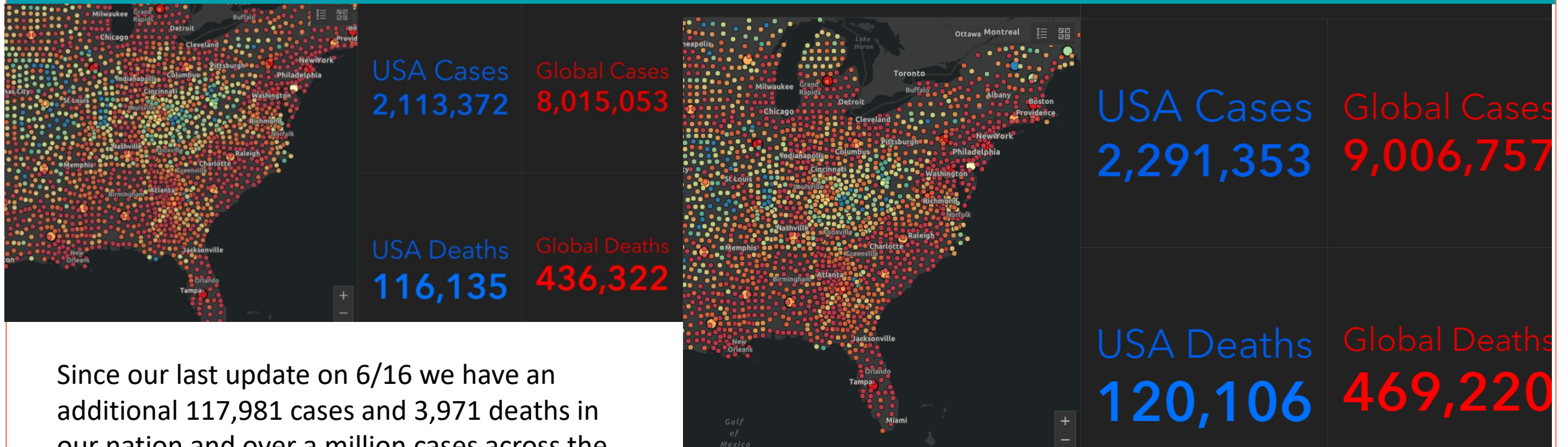

# Total COVID Cases – Global and U.S.



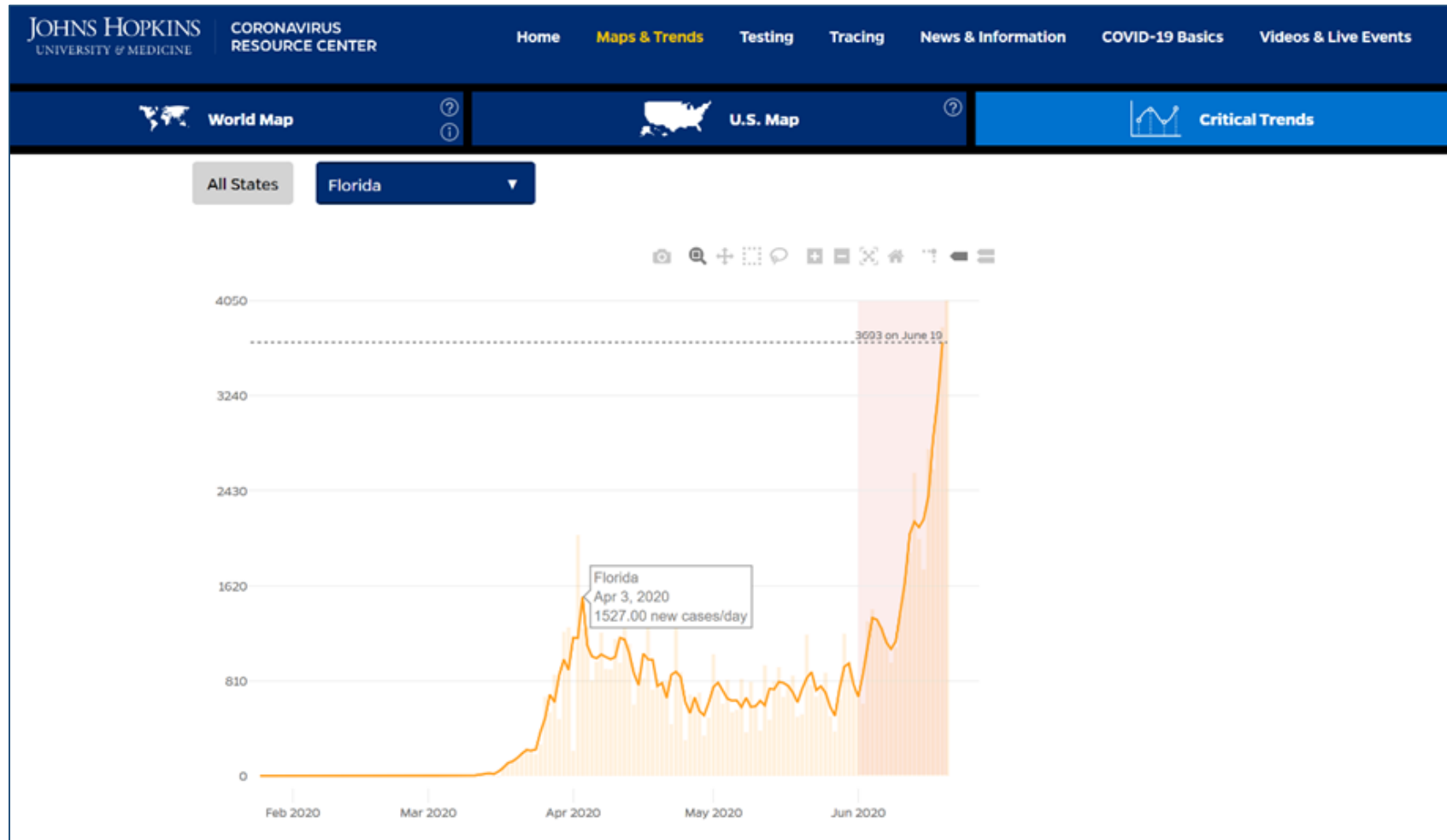
Since our last update on 6/16 we have an additional 117,981 cases and 3,971 deaths in our nation and over a million cases across the globe.

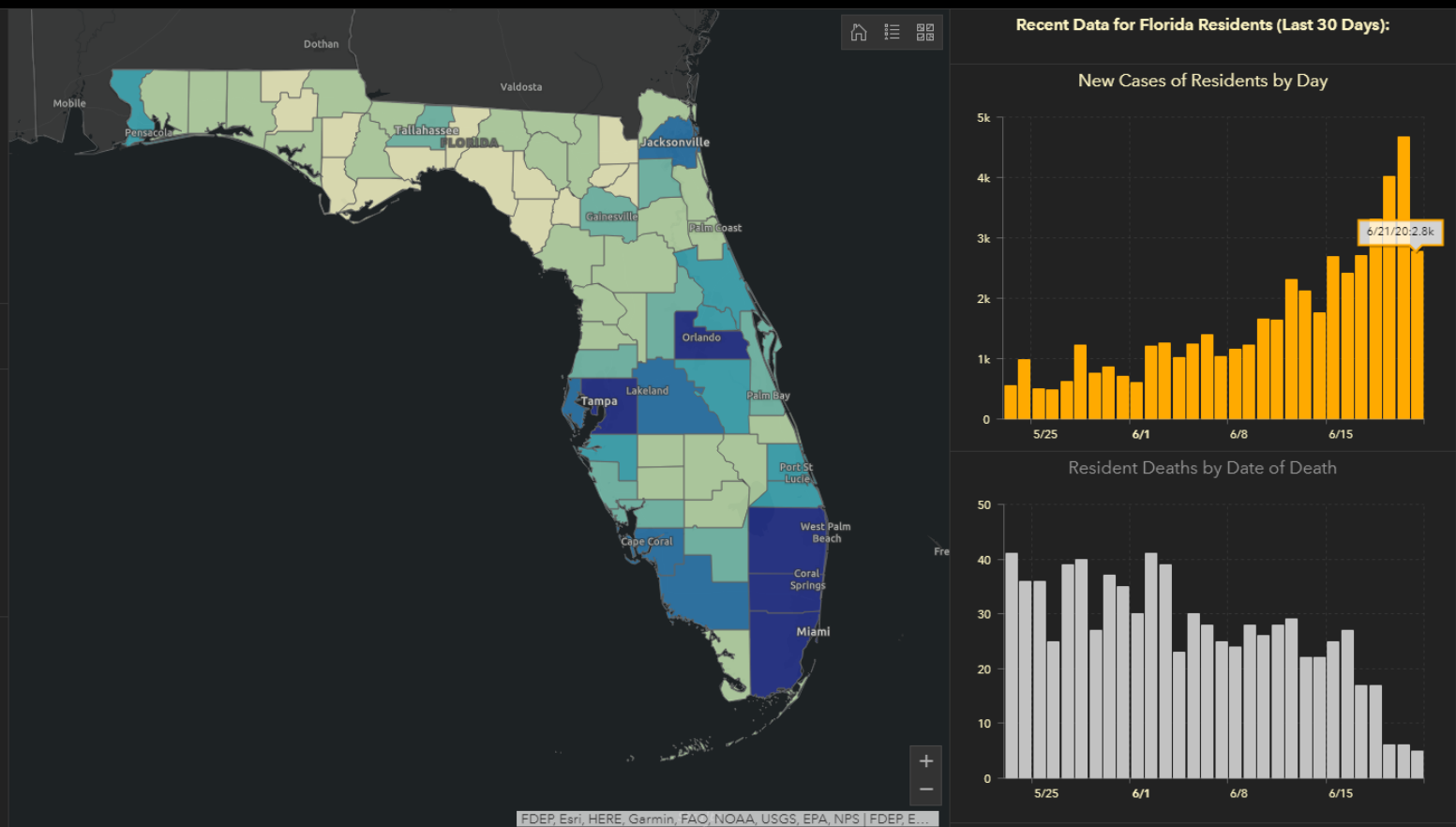

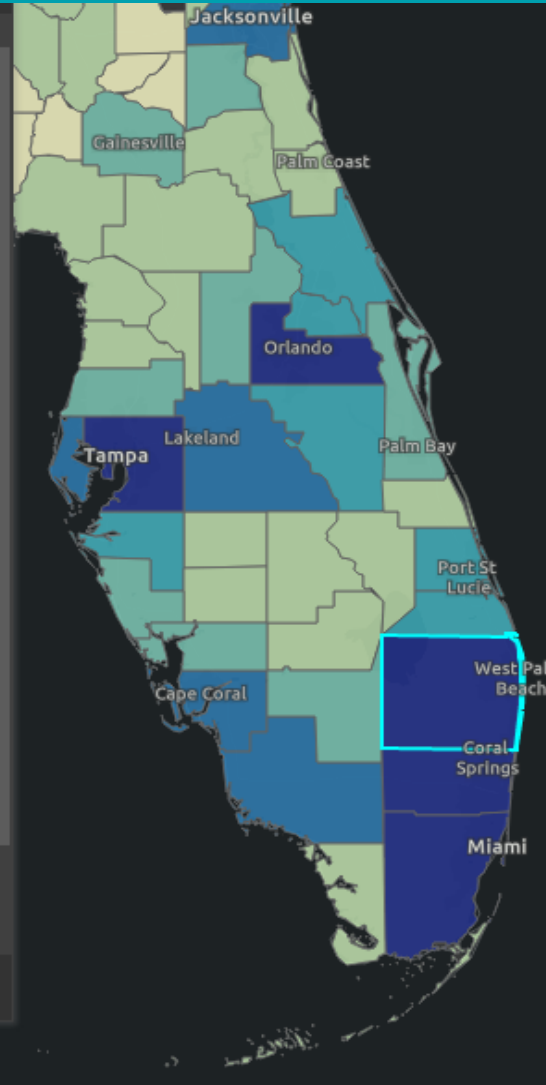

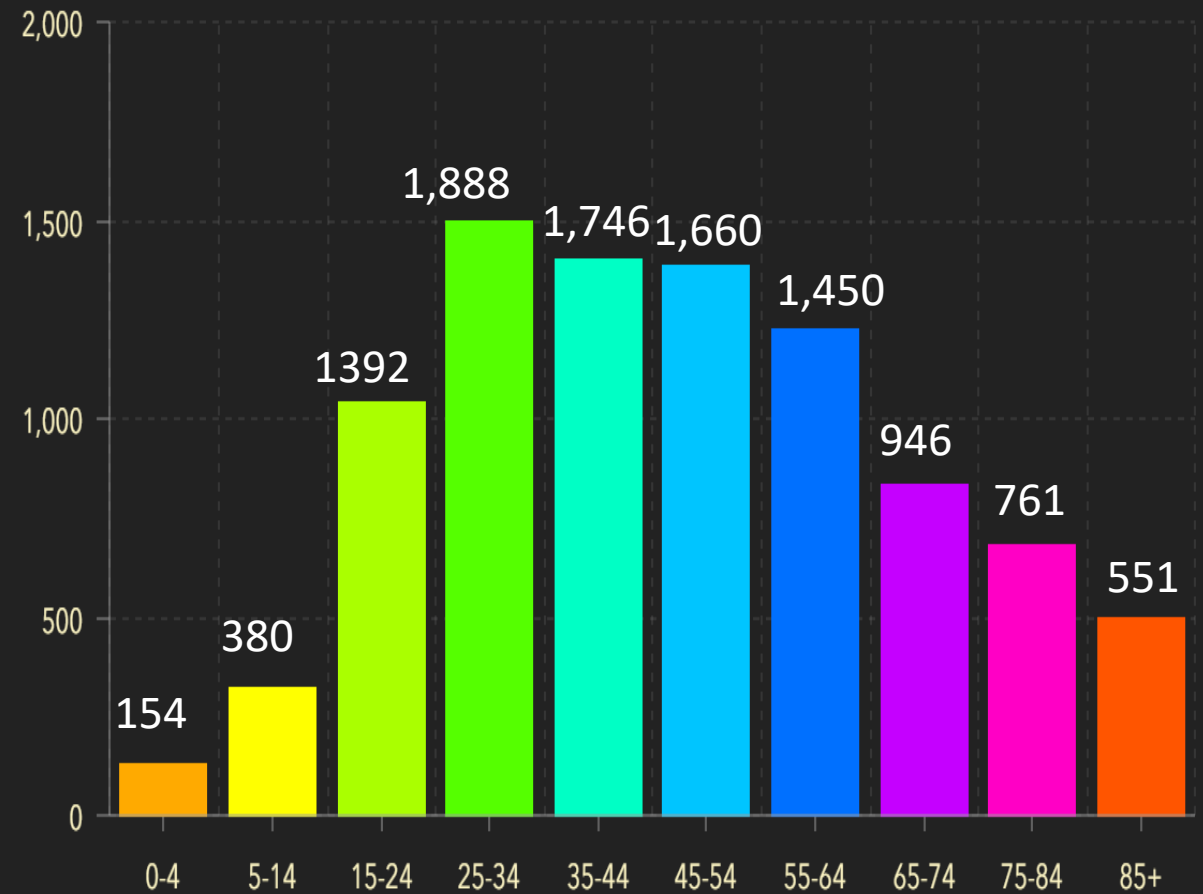

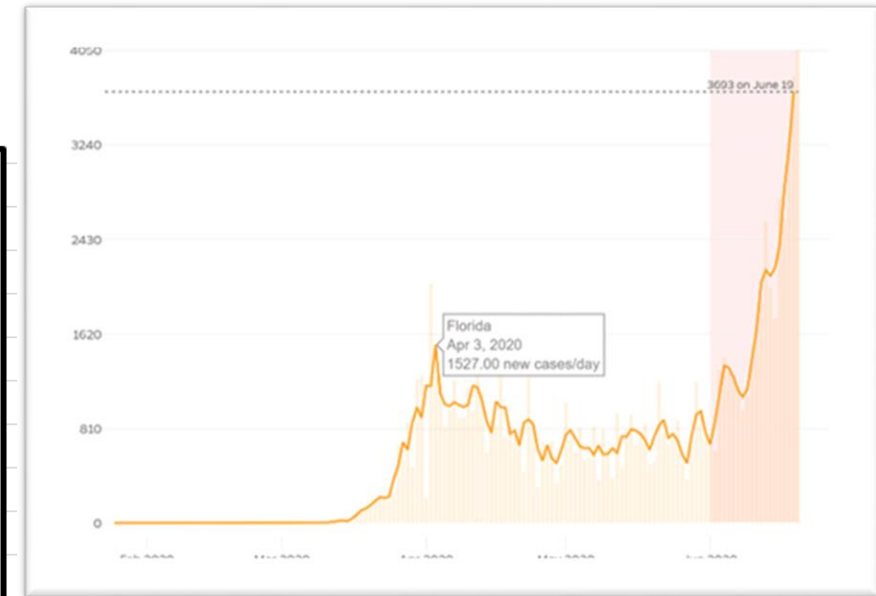

# Total COVID Cases per Day for PB County



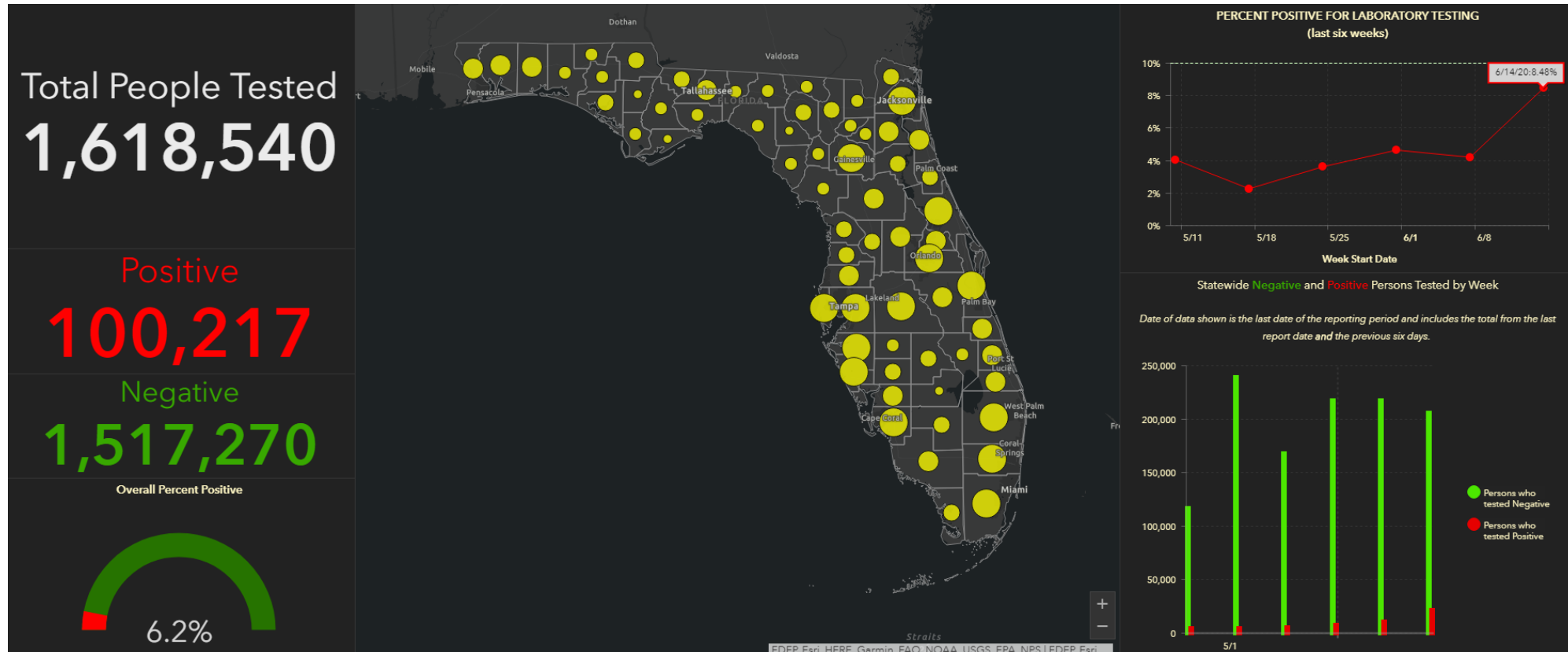
Florida COVID cases by Day

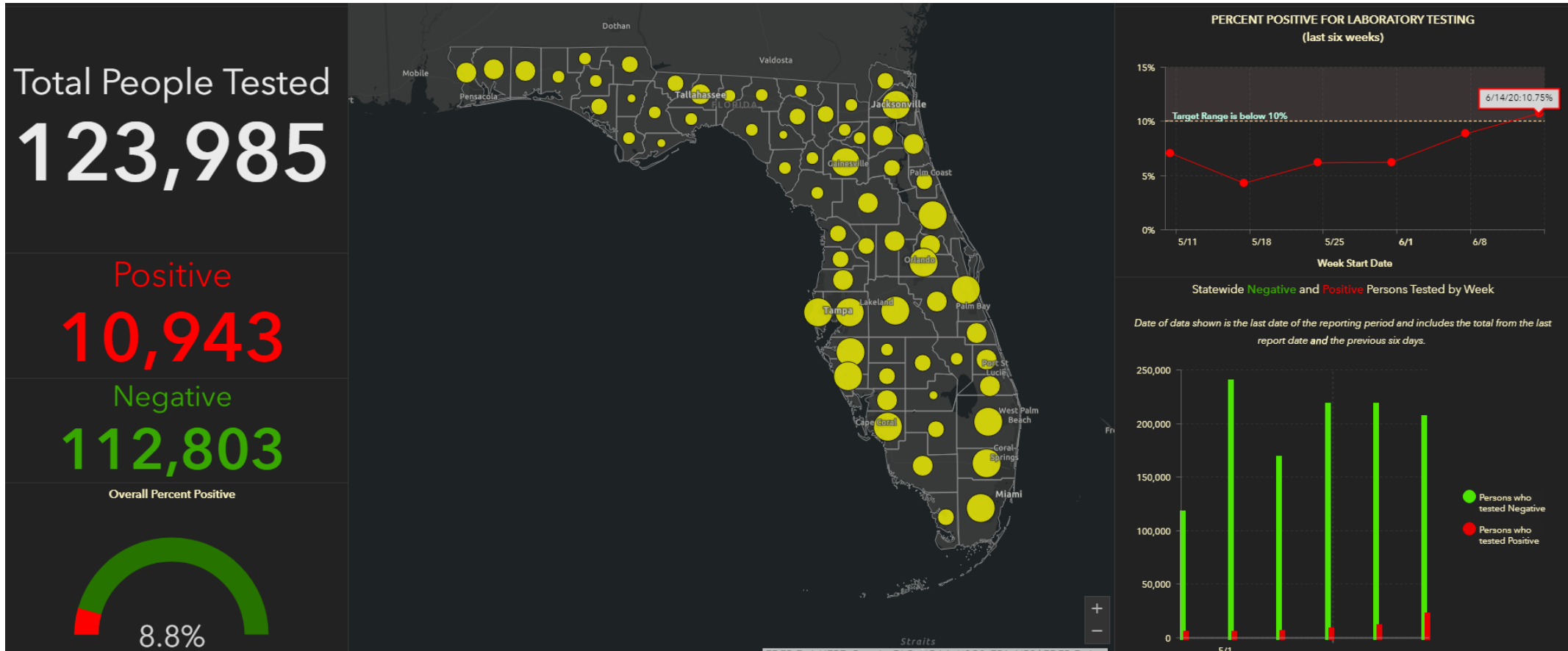
# FL COVID Testing and Positivity

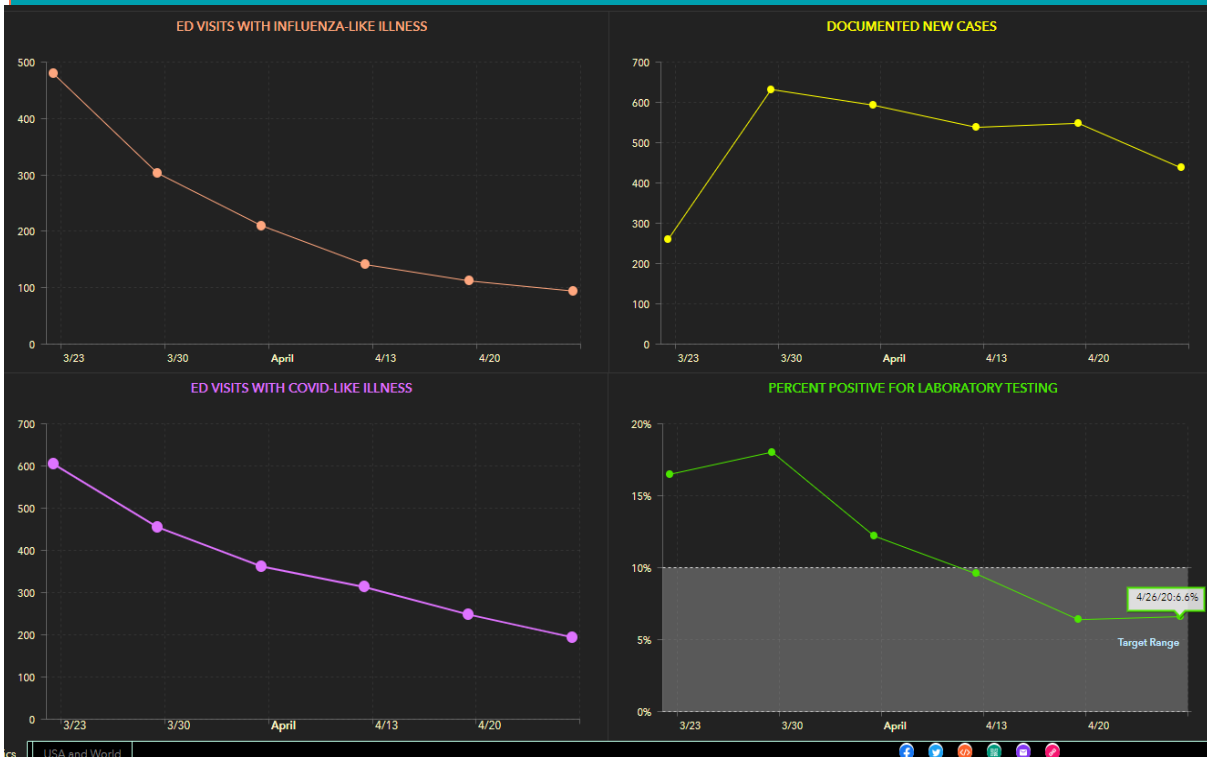

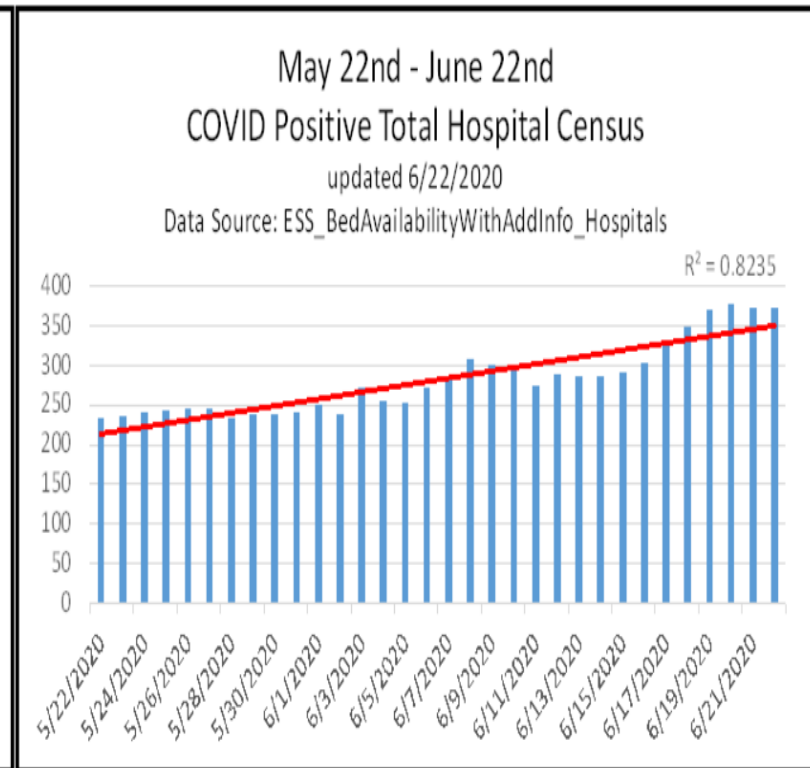
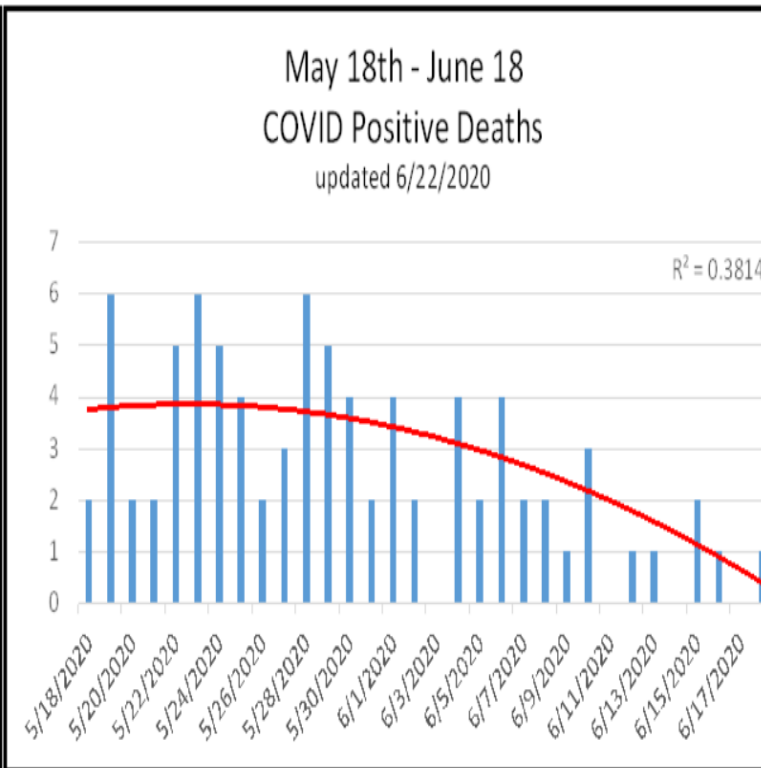
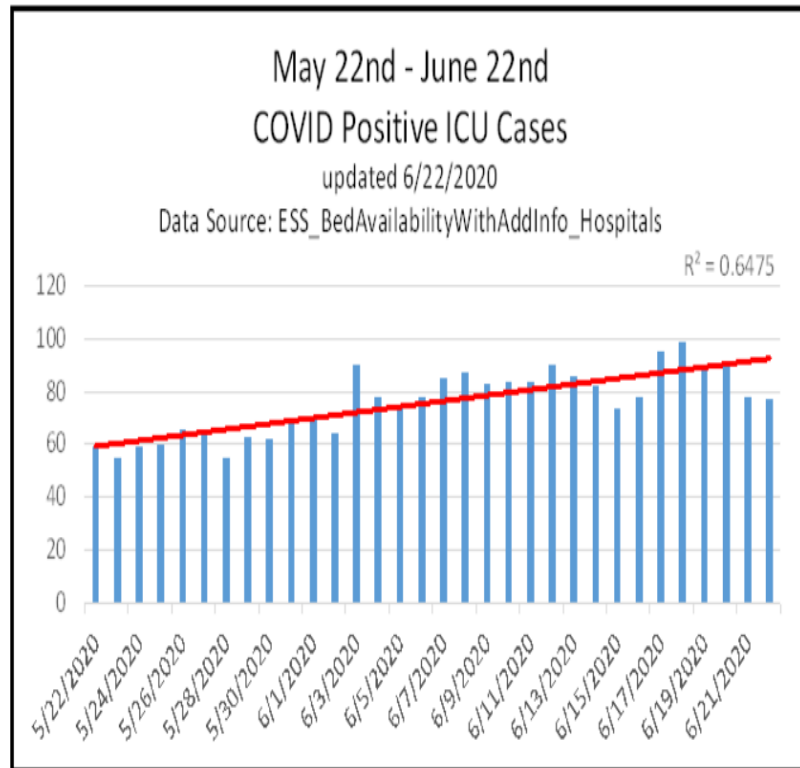
Hospital Bed Utilization Rate

**74.06%**

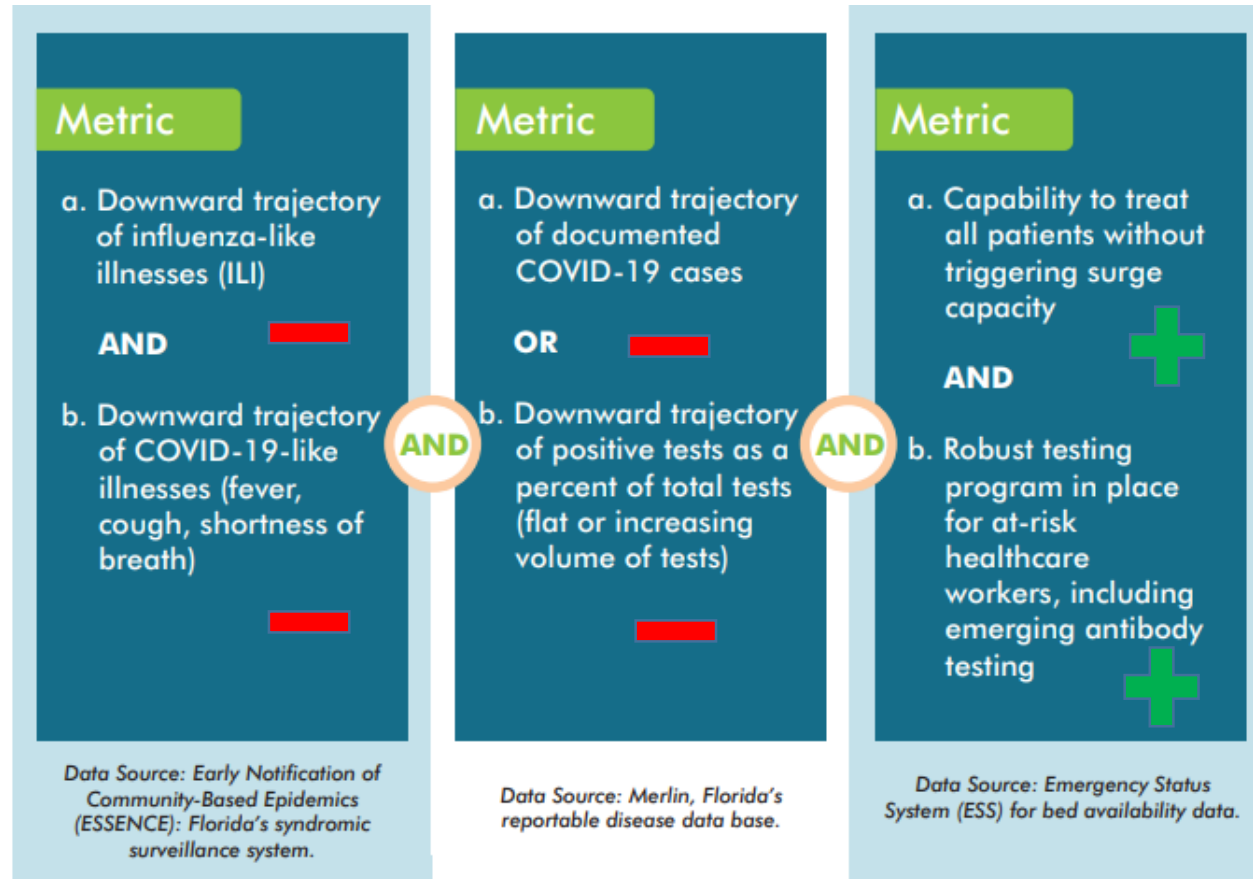
ICU Bed Utilization Rate
