The County has expended or encumbered \$157,500 (\$9,265/month), inclusive of all three (3) contracts, during the previous seventeen (17) months of the current eighteen (18) month term contracts. On 01/07/2020, the Board approved a six (6) month extension to each contract and an increase of \$52,500 (\$17,500 per contract). The County has expended or encumbered \$70,000 (\$3,043/month) during the previous twenty-three (23) months of the current twenty-four (24) month emergency term contract. On 12/17/2019, the Board approved a six (6) month extension and an increase of \$17,500 to the emergency term contract. Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, resulting in staff workload reprioritization and staff temporary non-availability for work, an additional twelve (12) month extension to the current emergency term contract is necessary to issue a solicitation and complete the procurement process required for a new term contract and to avoid a gap in service. This emergency term contract will be terminated for convenience upon award of a new contract. In addition an increase of \$35,000, over the previously authorized amount of \$70,000.02, is required in order to continue State lobbyist services during the extension of the contract. Awardee is located outside Palm Beach County in the City of Miami, Florida. This emergency term contract is exempt from the EBO Ordinance.
