## **I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file:** Task Assignment Change Order No. 3, to Task Assignment No. IP8, Contract No. FWC11357 (R2012-0573) with Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC), to add 150 acres to the total acreage to be treated (390 acres total) to control floating plants in Lake Osbourne. This Change Order No. 3 does not alter the original cost reimbursement of \$65,852, nor the original completion date of June 30, 2020.

**Summary:** On April 17, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners approved FWC Contract No. FWC11357 (R2012-0573) (Contract) for aquatic vegetation control services in the following lakes: Clarke, Ida, Osborne, and Pine. Delegated authority to execute all future time extensions, task assignments, certifications, and any other forms associated with this Contract was approved at that time. This Contract facilitates County treatment and control of aquatic exotic plants within the Chain of Lakes. County work is reimbursed by FWC. In accordance with County PPM CW-0-051, all delegated contracts/ agreements/grants must be submitted by the initiating Department as a receive and file agenda item. There is no cost to the County. Districts 2, 3, 4 (SS)

**Background and Justification:** FWC Contract No. FWC11357 reimburses the County for its efforts in controlling aquatic invasive plants within the Chain of Lakes. The FWC Contract Manager for the Invasive Plant Management Section may issue modifications to this Task Assignment No. IP8, altering the scope of the invasive plant control measures periodically. Adaptive management techniques with local government oversight allows staff to determine and use the most effective chemical agents and to apply them to particularly dense areas of vegetation within the Chain of Lakes.




