# I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$1,657,000 within the Golf Course Capital Fund from Golf Course Capital Improvements & Renovations FY20 to the Okeeheelee Golf Course Greens Renovation project.

Summary: This funding will be used to modernize and restore the greens at Okeeheelee Golf Course after twenty years of continuous operation. The intent of the project is to restore the golf course as closely as possible to the original playing characteristics envisioned by the original Project elements include irrigation, putting surface, and sand bunker repair and designer. renovations. Funding for this budget transfer is from the Golf Course Capital Fund. District 2 (AH)

Background and Justification: Okeeheelee Golf Course offers 27 holes of championship golf with three nine-hole courses that may be played in three 18-hole challenging combinations. Okeeheelee Golf Course provides extensive practice facilities including a driving range and 30,000 square feet of putting green, chipping, pitching, and bunker practice areas. Each hole has five tees satisfying every skill level ensuring a comfortable round of golf. With its unique park setting and beautiful vistas of Clear Lake, the facility is aptly named Okeeheelee, or "quiet waters" in the Seminole Indian language. Okeeheelee Golf Course is proud to participate in the Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary Program for golf courses (ACSP), and is committed to environmental stewardship.

The purpose of the modernization and restoration of the Okeeheelee Golf Course greens is to rejuvenate the facility after twenty years of continuous operation. The intent of the project is to restore the golf course as closely as possible to the original playing characteristics envisioned by the original designer.
