Summary: On March 13, 2020, the President declared the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant an emergency declaration for all states, tribes territories, and the District of Columbia pursuant to section 501(b) of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. 5121-5207 (the "Stafford Act") Emergency declaration designated "FEMA-4468-DR-FL" for State, territorial, tribal, and local government entities and certain private non-profit organizations that are eligible to apply for Public Assistance (PA). Public Assistance is a federal grant to aid state and local governments in returning a disaster area to pre-disaster conditions. On March 31, 2020, the County requested approval from FEMA through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management for non-congregate sheltering and support services. Summary: As part of the PA Program, FEMA will typically fund 75% of the cost. FEMA funding will be calculated on actual expenditures incurred and be received from the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management, on a reimbursement basis. The State of Florida will contribute 12.5% of the qualifying actual expenditures leaving the County responsible for absorbing the remaining 12.5%. Countywide (LDC)

Background and Justification: The Governor of the State of Florida issued a Public Health Emergency on Sunday, March 1, 2020, and a State of Emergency on Monday, March 9, 2020. Palm Beach County also issued a local state of emergency on Friday, March 13, 2020. The County's Emergency Operation Center was activated to a Level 2 activation as of 7:00 a.m. on Monday, March 16, 2020.
