I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF									
Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Amendment #002 to agreement R2012-1731 with the Florida Commission on Community Service dba Volunteer Florida serving as the administrative agency FY 2019-20 Federal Emergency Management Performance Grant Program (EMPG) in the amount of \$5,000 extending the grant period from June 30, 2020 through August 30, 2020.									
Summary: Palm Beach County is currently responding to COVID-19 to ensure the safety of its citizens. Because of this response and the business interruption, an extension was requested to allow significant time to procure the training and associated supplies needed for the Community Response Emergency Response Team (CERT). R2012-1731 authorized the County Administrator or designee to execute these agreements on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners. Countywide (LDC)									
Background and Justification: Palm Beach County has a very active CERT program with over 3,800 citizens that are CERT trained. The CERT program educates citizens about disaster preparedness for all hazards and provides training in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhood or workplace following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help. CERT members are also encouraged to support emergency response agencies by taking a more active role in emergency preparedness projects in their community. On July 1, 2016 the Florida Department of Emergency Management transferred the Citizen Corps/CERT Program to Volunteer Florida. Volunteer Florida has been managing and administering the program since then.


