RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE ERECTION OF SUITABLE MARKERS ON BRIDGE NUMBER 930361 ON S.R. A1A/JACK NICKLAUS DRIVE IN PALM BEACH COUNTY DESIGNATING THE BRIDGE AS “GOLD STAR FAMILY MEMORIAL BRIDGE, DEDICATED TO ARMY CAPTAIN JOSEPH M. BERKSON”; RECOGNIZING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS THE AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HONORARY DESIGNATION MARKERS; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2018-161, Laws of Florida, provides for the erection of honorary designations of certain transportation facilities in specified counties and directs the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to erect suitable markers; and

WHEREAS, FDOT has been directed to erect suitable markers on Bridge number 930361 on S.R. A1A/Jack Nicklaus Drive in Palm Beach County designating the bridge as “Gold Star Family Memorial Bridge, dedicated to Army Captain Joseph M. Berkson”; and

WHEREAS, Captain Berkson served as a senior combat advisor with the South Vietnamese Rangers during the North Vietnamese army offensive of 1972. While being airlifted from hostile activity, his helicopter was shot down and Captain Berkson will killed in the crash; and

WHEREAS, Captain Berkson is the recipient of the Silver Star Medal, the Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart and the Combat Infantry Badge; and

WHEREAS, Captain Berkson was 25 at the time of his death and is survived by his wife, Joan and daughter Lauren who has lived in Palm Beach County for over 25 years and has dedicated her time to advance efforts to build Gold Star Family Memorial Monuments in locations throughout Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, the roadway is within FDOT’s jurisdictional limits, and FDOT will be responsible for the design, erection, and maintenance of the honorary designation markers; and

WHEREAS, Section 334.071(3), Florida Statutes, requires that the appropriate city or county commission pass a resolution in support of any proposed honorary designation markers prior to their erection; and

WHEREAS, the Roadway where the proposed honorary designation will be erected lies within Palm Beach County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing “Whereas” clauses are true and correct and are made part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida (Board), recognizes FDOT as the agency responsible for the design, erection, and maintenance of the honorary designation markers.

Section 3. The Board supports the erection of suitable markers on bridge number 930361 on S.R. A1A/Jack Nicklaus Drive in Palm Beach County dedicated to Army Captain Joseph M. Berkson..

Section 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any portion of the Resolution is determined by any court to be invalid, the invalid portion shall be stricken, and such striking shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Resolution. If any court determines that this Resolution, or any portion hereof, cannot be legally applied to any individual(s), group(s), entity(ies), property(ies), or circumstance(s), such determination shall not affect the applicability hereof to any other individual, group, entity, property, or circumstance.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
