I. AUTHORITY :

Resolution R-84-1745; amended by Ordinance No. 85-32.

II. APPOINTING BODY :

Board of County Commissioners

III. COMPOSITION, QUALIFICATIONS, TERMS & REMOVAL :

This Board is composed of seven (7) members. The initial terms of the members of the Authority as appointed by their respective County shall be as follows: 1. Palm Beach - 4 years, 2. Palm Beach - 3 years, Palm Beach - 1 year; Broward - 4 years, Broward - 2 years, Broward - 4 years. The President of Florida Atlantic University or his/her designee shall be a permanent member of the Authority. Each member shall continue to serve until a successor has been appointed and qualified. At least three (3) members of the Authority shall be appointed who are employed in the private sector and who are residents of Palm Beach County. Hereafter the BCC shall appoint for terms of four (4) years each a member or members to succeed those PBC representatives whose terms expire. The BCC shall fill any vacancy for an unexpired term. A member of the Authority shall be eligible for reappointment. Any member of the Authority representing PBC may be removed by the BCC for misfeasance, malfeasance, or willful neglect of duty. The members of the Authority shall receive no compensation for the performance of their duties hereunder, but each such member may be paid necessary expenses incurred while engaged in the performance of such duties, as allowed by law.
