The Department of Community Services requests ratification of the Director of Purchasing's approval of this twelve (12) month emergency Prepaid Business Suite Services Agreement ("Agreement"). Due to the immediate necessity for food for those negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Purchasing Director approved the emergency Agreement with Fidelity Information Services, LLC ("FIS"). This emergency Agreement provides for the implementation of a Purchase Card Program whereby the County issues pre-paid debit cards to approved applicants for the purchase of food products. Although the term for this emergency Agreement is for twelve (12) months, the COVID-19 related Purchase Card Program will be effective through December 30, 2020. The remaining months of the emergency Agreement will be utilized if additional time is provided to CARES ACT grantees for expenditure purposes. Up to \$5,000,000 of CARES Act funds have been allocated to this Purchase Card Program, inclusive of a total estimated \$17,500 cost-per-card fee. FIS required that the County agree to a limitation of liability and indemnification provisions that deviate from the County's standard. In accordance with PPM CW-F-049, the Department of Risk Management, the County Attorney's Office, and FIS, agreed to: (i) the removal of all indemnification requirements; and (ii) a cap on vendor's liability to not exceed the amount of fees paid for services during the twelve (12) months preceding the date the event occurred. Although the term in FIS' standard Agreement is twelve (12) months with four (4) twelve (12) month renewal periods, the County has no intention of exercising the renewals. Awardee is located outside Palm Beach County in the City of Jacksonville, Florida. This emergency term contract is being funded with CARES Act funds and is exempt from the EBO Ordinance.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, resulting in staff workload reprioritization and staff temporary non-availability for work, an additional twelve (12) month extension to the current term contract is necessary to complete the procurement process required for a new term contract and to avoid a gap in service. Based upon the prior enrollment number of employees electing to purchase plans and an increase in the labor force, the total estimated value of this twelve (12) month extension period is \$1,400,000. The County has received \$569,355 (\$28,468/month) in revenue during the previous twenty (20) months of the current twenty-one (21) month term contract. This new revenue generating contract is expected to generate \$1,825,000 in revenue over the thirty-six (36) month term, of which the County will receive a minimum guaranteed amount of \$1,225,000 (comprised of \$1,102,500 from bus advertising, and \$122,500 for intermodal shelter signs) and a credit valued at \$600,000 for a media trade account. In addition, the County will receive net advertising revenue of: (i) sixty-one percent (61%) for the first year; (ii) sixty-one and one half percent (61.5%) for the second year; and (iii) sixty-two percent (62%) for the third year. Awardee is located in Palm Beach County. This contract was established by a competitive RFP process that allowed up to fifteen (15) points for S/W/WBE participation. Awarded to a non S/M/WBE vendor utilizing SBE subcontractors. The Goal Setting Committee recommended SBE evaluation preference up to 15% and an SBE subcontracting goal at 10% for this solicitation.
