I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 26 to the Consulting/Professional Services Utility Distribution & Collection System Engineering Services Contract (Contract) with Mock, Roos & Associates, Inc., (Consultant) for the Century Village South Water Main Improvement (Project) for a total amount of \$255,518.70.

Summary: On June 20, 2017, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2017-0818) with Consultant. CSA No. 26 provides for professional engineering services relating to design and permitting of the Project. These services include survey, construction plans, permitting, and bid support services for the installation of approximately thirty-nine (39) meter assemblies which includes thirty-four (34) 6-inch meters, four (4) 3-inch meters and one (1) 1-inch meter with backflow preventers to be installed with each meter assembly. This Contract was procured under the requirements of the 2002 Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance (R2002-0064) prior to the adoption of the new Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance on October 16, 2018. The SBE participation goal established under the 2002 Ordinance was 15% overall participation. The Contract provides for 97% SBE participation. CSA No. 26 includes 91.20% SBE participation. The cumulative SBE participation including CSA No. 26 is 72.32%. Consultant is a Palm Beach County Company. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY 20 Budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 20-056) District 5 (MJ)

Background and Justification: PBCWUD is providing potable water service to Century Village South through two (2) 8-inch master meters. PBCWUD has agreed to take ownership of the existing 12-inch water main and will be installing 39 meter assemblies and appurtenances throughout the sixteen (16) communities within the Project. The installation of the meter assemblies will eliminate the two (2) existing 8-inch master meters and will improve the service, reliability and redundancy of the water distribution system.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

PBCWUD Project No.: 20-056

Project Title Century Village South Water Main Improvement

INTRODUCTION:

Century Village South is located within unincorporated Palm Beach County and is bounded by the Florida Turnpike to the east, Lyons Road to the west, Yamato Road to the north, and the Brentwood of Boca subdivision to the south. Century Village consists of sixteen (16) individual communities (neighborhood enclaves), each governed by their own homeowner's association. These enclaves are Ainslie, Brighton, Cornwall, Dorset, Exeter, Fanshaw, Guildford, Hythe, Lincoln, Mansfield, New Castle, Preston, Rexford, Suffolk, Wolverton, and Yarmouth.

The existing distribution system inside of Century Village is owned and operated by Century Village. The water provider for Century Village is Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD). The water is supplied from a water main on Lyons Road and enters Century Village at two (2) locations through two (2) 8-inch master meters. The master meters are connected to a 12-inch looped water main that follows along the spine road connecting from East Kimberly Boulevard to the east end of the community along the Florida Turnpike and up to East New England Boulevard. All of the smaller communities are fed from this looped main. This water main provides both fire protection and potable water to the communities. The Century Village Clubhouse and Temple are fed from a separate meter and are not currently connected to this looped system.

The intent of this project is to remove the existing master meters and instead provide individual meters at each of the sixteen (16) internal communities. PBCWUD estimates that thirty-nine (39) new meters with backflow devices will be required, ranging in size from one (1) to six (6) inches. These modifications require severing up to four (4) locations of looped water mains between the internal enclaves. This will enable each enclave to be metered separately and allow PBCWUD to take over ownership and maintenance responsibility for the 12-inch looped water main and other mains upstream of the new meters.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Mock, Roos & Associates, Inc. (CONSULTANT) shall perform: The engineering Scope of Services as described herein and will be responsible for the following tasks:

Task 1 - Project Management

CONSULTANT will provide project management for engineering and related services and act as

the Project's Engineer of Record for the above-described project including tracking project scheduling, preparing monthly progress reports, and providing Quality Assurance/Quality Control (QA/QC) of all communication and project deliverables, including:

- Contract Administration The progress of the project will be monitored, and resources will be managed to achieve the schedule, budget, and work quality goals of the project. CONSULTANT will keep PBCWUD informed as to the status and progress of the project. Communications with PBCWUD will be conducted under this task. Invoices shall be prepared monthly.
- QA/QC CONSULTANT will be conducting internal QA/QC review of the deliverables for conformance to Contract requirements. The results of these reviews will be incorporated into the deliverables prior to submission to PBCWUD for review and comment.
- 3. Monthly Status Report CONSULTANT will submit a monthly status report summarizing the progress of the project along with an updated project schedule. This report and schedule will be submitted with each monthly invoice.

Task 2 - Preliminary Engineering Services

- 1. Meet with PBCWUD staff to review the scope of the project, previous engineering report, all information PBCWUD has on the existing system, general location of proposed improvements, and obtain all PBCWUD's input regarding expectations for the project.
- Develop an overall exhibit depicting the existing platted easements for the water distribution system and PBCWUD Geographical Information System (GIS) information. This exhibit will assist in selecting final meter locations.
- 3. Perform a preliminary field review of the proposed water distribution system improvements relative to the platted easement limits, current GIS information, and existing hard surface features such as curbs, sidewalks, drives, etc.
- 4. Determine/confirm new meter and backflow device locations for up to forty (40) new meter installations and up to four (4) cut-off locations. The goal is to locate the new meters within the existing platted easements.
- 5. Coordinate subsurface utility targeting service and subsurface utility locating by test hole, up to forty-four (44) locations. Ground penetrating radar will be utilized to assist in locating existing water mains .
- 6. At selected locations where the meter assembly can not be located in the existing platted easements, the CONSULTANT or surveyor will provide topographic survey of the area (approximately 50' x 50') in the immediate vicinity of each of the proposed new meters and provide base maps of the survey data for these sites. The topographic survey will consist of

field topography and horizontal and vertical locations for the project and the existing distribution system. CONSULTANT will coordinate survey file transfer and confirm limits of the survey matches the project requirements, and existing platted easement lines will be shown on these surveys. For purposes of this proposal, the budget includes up to forty-four (44) locations.

- 7. Prepare construction base maps based on the surveyor-provided data and/or aerial photo graphs where survey is not provided.
- 8. Submit base drawings to other local utilities for mark-up of their existing utilities. Plot utility locations received on the drawing base sheets. Local utilities include but are not limited to, telephone, cable, and gas.
- 9. Submit preliminary base sheets to PBCWUD for review and comment.
- 9. Utilizing PBCWUD standards, develop preliminary meter and backflow preventer assembly details for use on this project. Using meter and backflow device literature, calculate the peak flow capacity of each size meter using PBCWUD provided system upstream pressure information and minimum twenty pounds per square inch (psi) downstream pressure in the most remote location of the existing distribution system.
- 11. Develop a preliminary construction sequencing plan to facilitate construction of proposed improvements while maintaining water service to existing residences during project construction. The plan will utilize existing working valves when possible and temporary line stop only where necessary.
- 12. Meet with PBCWUD staff to review preliminary submittal and respond to questions or comments. Prepare meeting agenda and minutes.

Task 3 - Design Phase Services

- Provide design phase engineering services to develop the final details of the replacement water meter assembly and details for removal of the existing 8-inch meters. Confirm number and size of meter assembly required to provide the targeted fire flow potential in each community.
- 2. Develop one (1) set of construction drawings consisting of a cover page, key page, approximately eleven (11) plan pages, and detail pages. It is anticipated that four (4) meter installations will be shown on each plan sheet.
- Prepare technical specifications and a unit price bid form for the project using PBCWUD
 annual pipeline continuing construction contract bid prices, anticipated to be bid as a single
 project.
- 4. Submit progress drawings at the 60-percent and 90-percent completion for review and comment.

- 5. Meet with PBCWUD after each submittal to review progress drawings, discuss design options, and respond to questions.
- 6. Estimate quantities and prepare an Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (EOPCC) at 100-percent completion using PBCWUD annual continuing construction contract bid prices.
- 7. Prepare a Palm Beach County Health Department (PBCHD) and Palm Beach County (PBC) Fire Marshall permit application packages including attachments and submit for approval (PBCWUD will pay application fees). Prepare and submit responses to PBCHD comments, if required.
- 8. Provide final design phase deliverables consisting of four (4) 22" x 34" and two (2) 11" x 17" construction drawings and bid form in paper copies, signed and sealed, electronic Portable Document Format (PDF) files, and Autodesk Computer Aided Design (AutoCAD) and Microsoft Word files, as applicable. Print and provide all permits and documents.
- 9. Coordinate easement sketch and descriptions for facilities located outside of existing easements to be dedicated to PBCWUD for future ownership, operation, and maintenance (12 locations anticipated). The cost for the signed and sealed easement sketch and descriptions will be negotiated as a project supplement after the exact number of additional easement parcels has been identified.
- 10. Provide limited support services to assist PBCWUD to negotiate with annual continuing construction contractor.
- 11. Provide anticipated Global Positioning System (GPS) Locations for all proposed new meters.

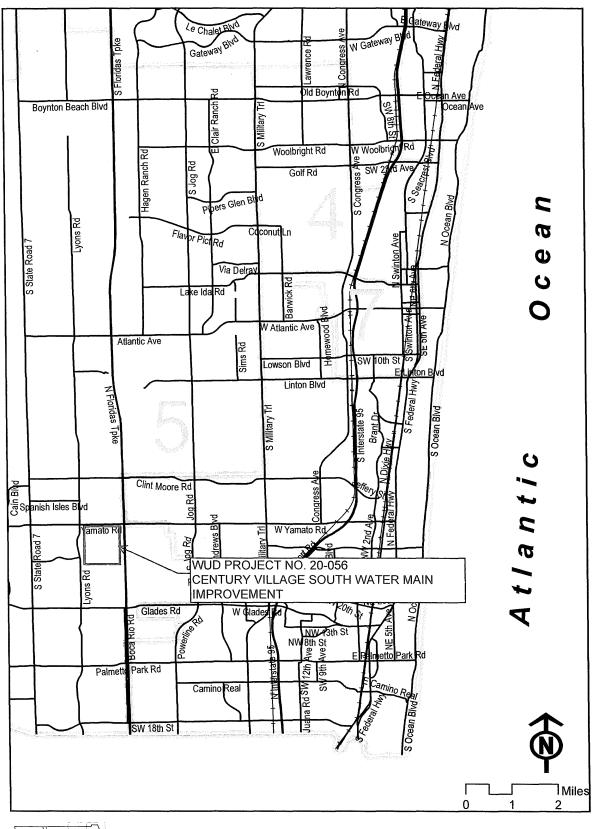

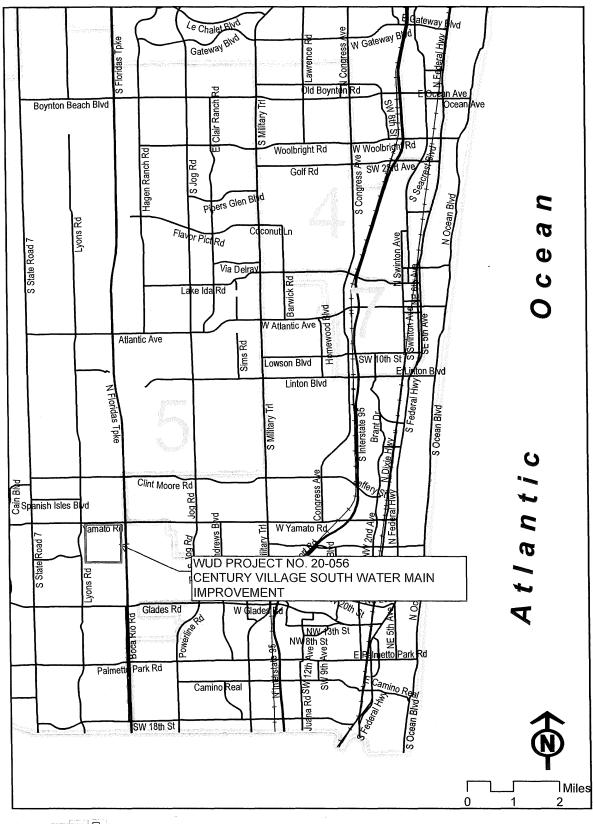
