#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** Work Authorization (WA) No. 6 to the 2019 Pipeline Continuing Construction Contract (Contract) with Johnson-Davis Incorporated (Contractor) for the Utility Adjustments for the City of Belle Glade Road Resurfacing Project - Phase 1 (Project) in the amount of \$1,904,713.79.

Summary: On February 11, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (PBCWUD) Contract (R2020-0160) with Contractor. WA No. 6 provides for the replacement of the existing water mains along NE Ave I, NE 20th St, NW 7th St, NW Ave C, NW Ave F, NW Ave J and SE 4th St in the City of Belle Glade. The Project includes the installation of approximately 1,000 linear feet of 6-inch and 8,700 linear feet of 8-inch water mains including the associated valves, fire hydrants, water services, site restoration and appurtenances in accordance with the construction documents and governing regulations. This Contract was procured under the requirements of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance. On April 3, 2019, the Goal Setting Committee applied an Affirmative Procurement Initiative of a mandatory 20% Small Business Enterprise (SBE) subcontracting participation. The Contract provides for 20.07% SBE participation. WA No. 6 includes 26.28% SBE participation. The cumulative SBE participation including WA No. 6 is 23.46%. Contractor is a Palm Beach County company. The Project is included in the PBCWUD FY21 budget. (PBCWUD Project No. 20-006) District 6 (MJ)

Background and Justification: The City of Belle Glade, in coordination with the Florida Department of Transportation, is undergoing roadway improvements and PBCWUD wishes to perform water main improvements prior to the start of the roadway project. PBCWUD has been experiencing water pressure concerns associated with the existing water system servicing the community. The existing water mains to be replaced under the Project are undersized and lack adequate fire protection. Completion of the work provided for in WA No. 6 will increase fire protection in the area, restore the service life, and increase efficiency and effectiveness of the water distribution system. The Project will also help to reduce the operations and maintenance workload and associated cost.






ATTACHMENT H LOCATION MAP WUD PROJECT No. 20-006 WORK AUTHORIZATION No. 6
