I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Title and Motion: Staff recommends motion to authorize:

- **A)** the Library Director to submit a Public Library Construction Grant application for \$500,000 to the Florida Department of State, Division of Library and Information Services for the Canyon Branch Library; and
- B) the County Administrator or designee to execute the grant agreements and any other necessary forms and certifications.

Summary: This grant is being submitted for the State's FY 2022 budget. This grant application is for \$500,000 with local matching funds of \$500,000. If awarded, grant funds will be used towards the cost of construction, thus freeing up other funds for furnishing and equipping this library. The estimated cost for construction for the branch library is \$18 million. Construction on this building is scheduled to start at the end of calendar year 2021 and slated for completion in early 2023. The operational costs will be funded through the Library's operating budget. <u>Countywide</u> (AH)

Background and Justification: On January 23, 2018, the BCC approved the addition of the Canyon Branch Library to the Library Capital Improvement Plan and to authorize staff to initiate the process to secure design and construction services for a Palm Beach County Library System branch library in the Canyon Town Center area. (Agenda Item 5B-1). A construction grant application was submitted for the 2020 State Budget year. This project was ranked fourth on the Division of Library and Information Services list. However, only one million dollars was appropriated for the construction grant budget line so our project was not awarded a grant. A construction grant application was submitted for the 2021 State Budget year. This project was ranked second on the Division of Library and Information Services list. One million dollars was appropriated by the Legislature for the construction grant budget line, but the funds were vetoed by the Governor. The County is allowed to roll over an updated grant application to the new fiscal year pending Board of County Commissioners approval.



I regret to inform you that the above-referenced project did not receive funding. The 2020 Legislature did not provide funding for any of the Public Library Construction Grant applications submitted.

According to the Public Library Construction Grant guidelines, if an application was not funded during the previous funding cycle, and if the project has not been placed under a contract for construction before July 1, 2020, then the application may be considered for funding by the 2021 Legislature. The applicant has the following options:

- 1. Update the application already on file.
- 2. Submit a new application.
- 3. Withdraw the application on file or take no action (see below).

If an applicant intends to update an application on file or submit a new application, a letter of intent must be submitted to the Division of Library and Information Services by September 7, 2020 (postmark or electronic submission date). Failure to submit a letter of intent by this date shall result in the application receiving no further consideration.

In addition, the following updated information must be provided for the existing application and submitted to the division by October 7, 2020 (postmark or electronic submission date):

- Applicant information.
- Ordinance or an adopted and certified resolution from the governing body as required and described in Section V.I.1 of the Public Library Construction Grant Guidelines.

If there are no updates to these two items, please advise the division by this date.

If the updated information is not submitted by this date, the application will receive no further consideration. Once the information has been received and reviewed, the applications will be included in the ranked listing along with new applications.

Please submit the updated information via email or U.S. Postal Service. Division staff will then upload the existing application information and updated information for you into the DOS Grants System.

If the applicant chooses to submit a new application to the division, they must do so by October 7, 2020 (postmark or electronic submission date).
