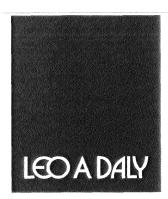

The Design Team has reviewed the information provided as part of Construction Change Proposal number Eight dated May 13, 2020 related to supplemental information provided in regard to anchoring requirements at the base of structural concrete tilt-up wall panels (Ref. Field Bulletin # 1) which represents an added cost to the Owner in the amount of \$49,700.00.

The Design Team has reviewed the submitted information and have the following comments:

- The submitted cost and back-up for labor and materials associated with added structural steel anchoring at the base of the of structural concrete tilt-up wall panels appears to be appropriate for the associated scope of work. Refer to attached input from Structural Engineer in regard to this item (Ref. Exhibit A).
- These anchoring requirements at the base of structural concrete tilt-up wall panels were addressed as a response to the building departments plan review comments and were identified prior to the issuance of the building permit.
- No remedial or corrective work was necessary as these requirements were added as part of a plan review responses; and represents added value to the Owner.
- 0 days were requested for proposed contract time as part of this CCP as the scope is being performed within the established project duration.

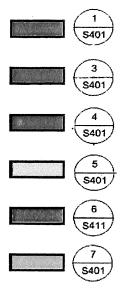
