The County will provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$4,240,000 from its Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act allocation, through the Palm Beach County Youth Services Department to the United Way of Palm Beach County, Inc. (United Way). The funding will provide advance payment to the United Way, establishing the necessary funding source for the United Way to award Non Profit Grants. The United Way will evaluate applications and award grants based on criteria established by the County. Grants may not exceed \$25,000 per non-profit. All expenditures must be completed by December 30, 2020. Due to emergency circumstances and the immediate necessity for these essential services during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Purchasing Department approved the emergency one-time funding allocation and is seeking the Board's ratification of the Purchasing Director's approval of the Cares Act Funding Agreement. Awardee is located in Palm Beach County. This emergency purchase is being funded with CARES Act funds and is exempt from the EBO Ordinance.

Palm Tran is requesting a new twelve (12) month emergency term contract for Optibus software services with a retroactive start date of September 15, 2020 in the amount of \$99,000. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and the reduction in Palm Tran bus operator's availability, this software is essential to assign bus operator's work quickly and efficiently. This emergency term contract contains limitation of liability and indemnification provisions that deviate from the County's standard. In accordance with PPM CW-F-049, the Department of Risk Management and the County Attorney's office, following negotiations with Optibus, Inc., agreed to: (i) exclude vendor's third-party liability, acts, omissions, gross, negligence and willful misconduct from any limitation of liability which would be uncapped; and (ii) a cap on vendor's liability to County of \$1,000,000. This term contract has no renewal options. Due to emergency circumstances and the immediate necessity for these essential services during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Purchasing Director approved the emergency term contract and is seeking the Board's ratification of the Purchasing Director's approval of said emergency term contract. Awardee is located out of State. This emergency term contract is being funded with CARES Act funds and is exempt from the EBO Ordinance.

Palm Tran is requesting a new twelve (12) month term contract for Doron 460 bus driving simulation system and annual maintenance services. \$6,595 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new twelve (12) month term contract. Vendor, a sole source, requires that the County agree to a limitation of liability provision that deviates from the County's standard. In accordance with PPM CW-F-049, the Department of Risk Management and the County Attorney's office, following negotiations with Doron Precision Systems, Inc., agreed to: (i) exclude vendor's liability for special or consequential damages; and (ii) limit vendor's liability to indemnify and defend County to the extent of vendor's acts or omissions. This term contract has four (4) twelve (12) month renewal options. Awardee is located out of State. This is a sole source vendor who is not a certified S/M/WBE. This sole source contract is exempt from the EBO Ordinance.
