I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Change Order No. 023 to the contract with Hedrick Brothers Construction Company, Inc. (R2017-0164) increasing the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) in the amount of \$385,049 and increasing the project duration by 70 days for the Main County Courthouse Electronics & Security Systems Renewal & Replacement Project.

Summary: On December 18, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved Amendment No. 1 (R2018-2058) to the contract with Hedrick Brothers Construction Company, Inc. in the amount of \$13,580,467 for the renewal/replacement of electronics and security systems within the Main County Courthouse, Central Energy Plant, and State Attorney/Public Defender's building. The project also included the expansion of the Palm Beach Sheriff Office Command Center. This change order authorizes the installation of heating ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) equipment to twenty-six (26) information security system (ISS) communication closets located throughout the Main County Courthouse, and an increase to the project duration by seventy (70) calendar days. When combined with all approved time extensions, the revised substantial completion date is February 26, 2021. The contract and subsequent amendment, was executed according to the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance in place at the time. The SBE goal established for this contract is 25%, with a SBE construction manager (CM) partner goal of 15%. The CM is not a SBE but has partnered with Cooper Construction Management & Consulting, Inc. a Small/Minority Business Enterprise (S/MBE). SBE participation for this change order is 3.55%. To date, the CM has achieved 31.92% SBE participation. Hedrick Brothers Construction Co., Inc. is a Palm Beach County Business. This project is funded by the Infrastructure Sales Tax fund and the Public Building Improvement (Ad Valorem) fund. (Capital Improvements Division) Countywide/District 7 (LDC)

Background and Justification: Construction Manager at Risk is a project delivery method in which the CM provides design phase assistance, evaluation of cost and schedule including implications of alternate designs, systems and materials on cost and schedule, and serves as general contractor bidding the subcontracts for construction. On December 12, 2016, the CM was selected to provide construction management at risk services for the Main County Courthouse Electronics & Security Systems Renewal/Replacement project. Additional network equipment, necessary to support the project, was installed in various ISS communication closets located throughout the Main County Courthouse. The added equipment increased the heat loads within the communication closets above acceptable limits creating the need for the installation of the cooling equipment. Prolonged operation of sensitive equipment in environments with high heat generally results in equipment deterioration and could ultimately lead to equipment failure. Under separate authorizations, the Project Consultant, TLC Engineering Solutions, was employed to provide a heat load analysis, make design recommendations, provide a cost estimate, and to provide design documents, which is the basis of design for this change order. This change order provides for the construction/installation of the recommended HVAC equipment.

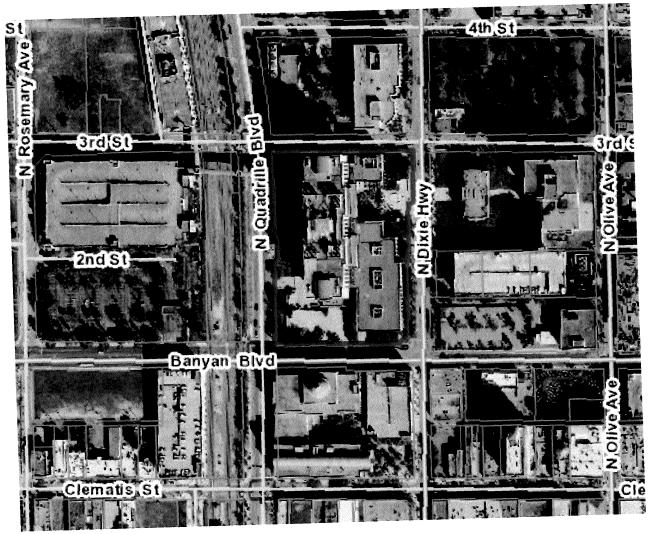

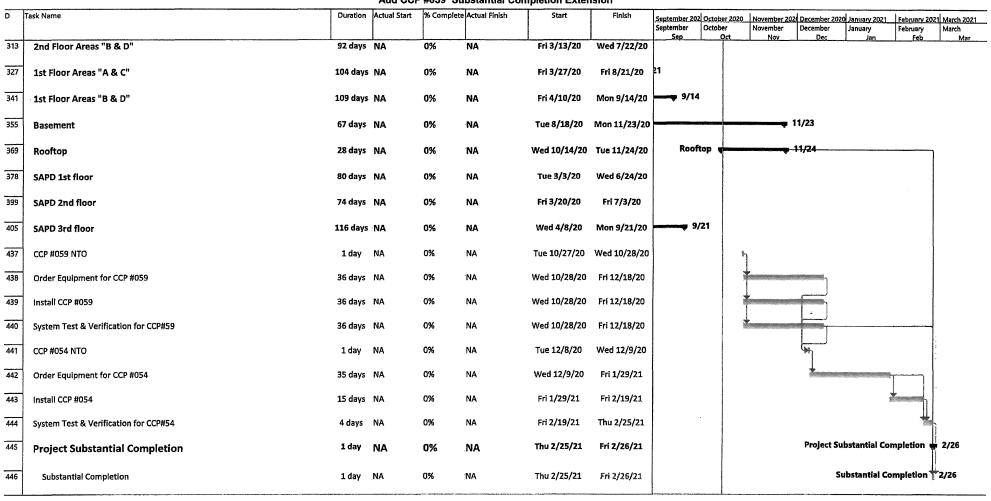
