I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) waiving a portion of Section 7-11.6.1 of the contract dated September 26, 2017 (R2017-1197) with Ranger Construction Industries, Inc. (Ranger) for the Hood Road east of Florida's Turnpike to west of Central Boulevard, and Hood Road and Central Boulevard Improvements (Project); and
- **B)** Change Order No. 18 with Ranger in the amount of \$56,534 and a contract time extension of 13 days.

SUMMARY: Approval of this waiver will eliminate a conflict between the contract's Sections 7-11.6.1 and 8-7.3.2, and will allow for the approval of Change Order No. 18. The Engineering Department recommends that the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) waive a portion of Section 7-11.6.1 of this contract which states, in relevant part, that Palm Beach County is not liable for added expense to the Contractor due to activities of utility companies. The Department recommends this limited waiver and approval of Change Order No. 18 in this specific circumstance, due to Ranger's diligence and performance, including but not limited to, taking all reasonable measures to minimize the effect of the Project's unforeseen overhead utility conflicts on job progress.

Per PPM CW-F-050, this change order exceeds the cumulative threshold relating to staff approvals of change orders to contracts and requires BCC approval. Change Order No. 18 will compensate Ranger for costs and delays associated with overhead utility conflicts, and will extend the contract time by 13 days resulting in a new completion date of September 13, 2019.

The contract was approved on September 26, 2017, prior to the effective date of the Equal Business Opportunity Ordinance and pursuant to the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Ordinance at the time. The SBE goal for all contracts was 15%. Ranger committed to 16.7% SBE participation. Their SBE participation for this change order is 0%, and their cumulative SBE participation, including this change order, is 15%. Ranger is a Palm Beach County based company. District 1 (YBH)

Background and Justification: On September 26, 2017, the BCC approved the contract with Ranger to construct improvements on Hood Road. On October 4, 2018, Ranger had submitted a claim for additional contract time and compensation. The final walk through confirming construction was completed per project specifications on October 10, 2019. Negotiations with Ranger commenced and an agreement was reached on August 28, 2020. After submitting all required documentation, Change Order No. 18 was prepared and the Engineering Department recommends BCC approval. Change Order No. 18 is due to unforeseen field conditions resulting in utility delays.



tember 10th, 2018. From the dates provided Ranger Construction's critical path was impacted a total of 62 cale first ten cumulative calendar days and the one holiday (Labor Day) for this delay date range, a total of 51 days has been defined as comp

The following timeline below is provided as to the Actions Ranger Construction had taken to mitigate this utility delay to Hood Road.

- On 11.27.17, Ranger Construction conducted its first site visit 57 days prior to the NTP. Upon completion of this site visit Ranger Construction provided an email voicing its concerns along with highlighted plans showing the conflicts that need to be resolved prior to the start of construction.

 On 1.16.18, a mandatory utility coordination meeting was held prior to the preconstruction meeting to discuss onsite coordination, constructability, and timeframes for relocation. Ranger Construction provided a role plot at this meeting outlining every single foreseeable delay on the project that would impact new construction.

 On 2.1.18, Ranger Construction presented an email to the County of every definitive conflict after the NTP that will be encountered by new construction on Hood Road. This was to be used as a resource as to what needs to be relocated prior to critical path work.

 On 2.16.18, Ranger conducted an onsite meeting with FPL to discuss relocation work and any assistance they would need in doing so.

 On 3.5.18, Ranger Construction had an onsite meeting to discuss relocation work with all utility owners on the existing poles in conflict. From this meeting it was determined that no relocation permitting, scheduling, or work progress had been made.

 On 3.6.18, AT&T was still going through the permitting process with Palm Beach County. The county had denied previously submitted permits.

 On 3.18.18 Comcast had not completed their permitting process and was denied by the County.

 On 3.28.18, a formal letter of concern was provided to Palm Beach County discussing the possible impacts to the critical path of the construction schedule if the overhead utility conflicts are not removed in the upcoming month.

- On 3.29.18, Ranger, The County, AT&T, Comcast, and FPL met to discuss the location of the utility easement for new proposed relocated work.
- On 4.9.18 Ranger met with SUA and FPL to assist in the location of the utility easement for new propo sed relocated work.

- On 4.9.18 Ranger met with SUA and FPL to assist in the location of the utility easement for new proposed relocated work.

 On 4.17.18, Ranger Construction placed the County on notice for the impacts to utility conflicts (NOI #3).

 On 5.5.18, AT&T's permit for relocation was rejected by the County again.

 On 6.5.18, Ranger Construction receives email from FPL stating relocation efforts have been halted do to power restorations from inclement weather.

 On 6.7.18, Ranger Construction held an onsite meeting to discuss removal of the overhead conductors with FPL.

 On 7.10.18, Ranger Construction updated NOI#3 to confirm that the critical path was affected by the overhead Utilities.

 On 7.29.18, Ranger Construction provides the County with a revised MOT plan which would mitigate and reduce the delay time by shifting traffic.

- On 8.10.18, Ranger Construction requests an update on direction to proceed with the revised MOT plan as delays are still being uncured.
- On 8.20.18, Ranger Construction requests an update on direction to proceed with the revised MOT plan as delays are still being uncured.

 On 8.28.18, the County expresses in the bi-weekly progress meeting that it does not want to pursue with the revised MOT plan.

 On 9.9.18, all but two poles remain in conflict with new Hood Road construction with no time frame of when they were to be taken down.

 On 9.10.18, with no further updates from the County or FPL as to when the poles would be removed, Ranger Construction takes the last two poles down with their own
- uipment subsequently ending the delay to NOI N3.

As outlined by the Palm Beach County spec 7-11.6, Ranger Construction after reviewing the plans, had verified that there were overhead utility conflicts in the field. Ranger Construction then proceeded to notify and coordinate the County, EOR, and Utility owners as outlined above. Even though the proper actions were taken per the County spec, the delay existed resulting in 13 days requested.

This Request is made in good faith, and all supportive data provided is accurate and complete to the contractor's Best Knowledge and belief, and the amount of the request accurately reflects what the Contractor in good faith believes to be Palm Beach County's responsibility.
