I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF					

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to Receive and File: the 2020 Crime Statistics Report for the Palm Beach County Urban High-Crime Job Tax Credit (UJTC) Program and the UJTC Re-ranking Status Letter/Program.

Summary: Palm Beach County has participated in the UJTC Program since 1999. The County is required by the Florida Legislature to triennially prepare and submit the Crime Statistics Report to the State for review. The UJTC Program is an incentive for eligible businesses located within one of the 13 State designated urban high-crime areas to create new jobs. The Department of Housing & Economic Sustainability coordinated with the Sheriff's Office, Delray Police Department, Riviera Beach Police Department and West Palm Beach Police Department to finalize the statistics for the 2019 report. The 2020 Crime Statistics Report was executed on August 3, 2020 by the County Administrator under authority delegated by Agenda Item 3I-A of March 10, 2015, and was provided to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO). The report includes the crime volume and number of arrests that took place for various crimes within the UJTC area during the 2019 calendar year. Upon review of the 2020 Crime Statistics Report, due to a reduction in crime the State again ranked the County UJTC a Tier 2, allowing eligible businesses to receive State tax credits of \$1,000 per qualified job. The ranking of the UJTC is prioritized based on the following criteria: Highest arrest rates within the geographic area for violent crime and for such other crimes as drug sales, drug possession, prostitution, vandalism, and civil disturbances; Highest reported crime volume and rate of specific property crimes such as business and residential burglary, motor vehicle theft, and vandalism; Highest percentage of reported index crimes that are violent in nature; Highest overall index crime volume for the area; and Highest overall index crime rate for the geographic area. This ranking will become effective on January 1, 2021, and will remain in effect until December 31, 2023. Districts 2 & 7 (DB)

Background and Justification: On April 21, 1998, the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) adopted a Resolution (R98-553) authorizing the nomination and submittal of a UJTC Program application to DEO. The County's UJTC area consists of portions of the municipalities of Delray Beach, Lake Park, Mangonia Park, Riviera Beach, West Palm Beach and the unincorporated area of Westgate/Belvedere Homes. The County is required to update its crime statistics every third year. On January 23, 2018, the BCC received and filed the 2017 Crime Statistics Report for Palm Beach County. On March 10, 2015, the BCC received and filed (R2015-0298) the 2014 Crime Statistics Report, ratified the Mayor's signature on the 2014 Crime Statistics Report and authorized the County Administrator, or designee, to execute future UJTC Program reports and all related amendments and documents. From 1998 to 2017, Palm Beach County's UJTC area was ranked as Tier 1, which allowed businesses to receive State tax credits of \$1,500 to \$2,000 per qualified job. In 2018, the crime statistics improved and the County ranked as a Tier 2 allowing businesses to receive tax credits of \$1,000 to \$1,500 per qualified job. Businesses may take the tax credits against either Florida Corporate Income Tax or the Florida Sales and Use Tax. From 2009 to 2019, the County's UJTC Program provided tax credits in the amount of \$3,096,000 for the creation of 2,064 jobs.

The Division of Strategic Business Development of the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity ("<u>DEO</u>") has concluded the re-ranking process required by section 212.097(1)(e) of the Florida Statutes. We are pleased to inform you that based on the 2020 Crime Statistics Request Package that was submitted by Palm Beach County and other information provided to us, we have determined that the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners's Urban High-Crime Area UA-5001 shall be re-ranked as a Tier <u>Two (III)</u> Urban High-Crime Area.

This designation will provide qualified businesses that create a required number of new jobs within your Urban High-Crime Area the opportunity to apply for credits against their corporate income tax or sales tax obligations. The effective date of this designation will be January 1, 2021, through December 31, 2023. During the summer of 2023, we are scheduled to conduct another re-ranking process of the thirteen designated Urban High-Crime Areas.
