Summary: As a Lead Agency, the Community Services Department's Division of Senior Services (DOSS) provides case management, adult day care services, and contracts with vendors to provide a variety of in-home services to assist functionally impaired seniors living independently at home. The CCE grant requires a 10% County match funding in the amount of \$176,821, as well as a County over match of \$1,258,157 for the three grants to cover staff salaries and administrative costs not covered by the grants. Sufficient funding is available in the FY 2021 budget to meet program needs. County match and additional funding required to meet FY 2021 obligations has been appropriated in the adopted FY 2021 budget. In FY 2020, the CCE, ADI and HCE programs collectively provided 266,431 hours of services to seniors and caregivers. The application was submitted through the emergency signature process due to the fact there was insufficient time to submit it through the regular agenda process. DOSS is responsible for providing services north of Hypoluxo Road, including all of the districts, excluding District 3, 4, 5 and 7 south of Hypoluxo Road.
