# AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL CODE CORPORATION FOR ORDINANCE CODIFICATION AND LOOSELEAF SUPPLEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2017, the Parties entered into the Contract, under which the Contractor furnishes to the County ordinance codification and looseleaf supplement services as set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the Contract's current expiration date is August 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Contract may be renewed for one (1) additional twelve (12) month period; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties wish to exercise the remaining renewal option under the Contract to extend the expiration date of the Contract to August 1, 2022, with no renewal periods remaining.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Parties agree to exercise the remaining renewal option under the Contract to extend the expiration date of the Contract to August 1, 2022.
- 2. The Parties hereby insert the following into the Contract:

#### ARTICLE 31 - E-VERIFY - EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

CONTRACTOR warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended. No later than January 1, 2021, CONTRACTOR shall: (1) register with and use the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) verify that all of the CONTRACTOR's subcontractors performing the duties and obligations of this Contract are registered with and use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

CONTRACTOR shall obtain from each of its subcontractors an affidavit stating that the subcontractor does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an Unauthorized Alien, as that term is defined in section

448.095(1)(k), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. CONTRACTOR shall maintain a copy of any such affidavit from a subcontractor for, at a minimum, the duration of the subcontract and any extension thereof. This provision shall not supersede any provision of this Contract which requires a longer retention period.

COUNTY shall terminate this Contract if it has a good faith belief that CONTRACTOR has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended.

If COUNTY has a good faith belief that CONTRACTOR's subcontractor has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, COUNTY shall notify CONTRACTOR to terminate its contract with the subcontractor and CONTRACTOR shall immediately terminate its contract with the subcontractor.

If COUNTY terminates this Contract pursuant to the above, CONTRACTOR shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by COUNTY for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Contract was terminated. In the event of such contract termination, CONTRACTOR shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by COUNTY as a result of the termination.
