The County has expended or encumbered \$1,490,941 (\$20,999/month) during the previous seventy-one (71) months of the current seventy-two (72) month term contract. To maintain warehouse stock, new pipe installations, and repairs and replacements throughout the County, \$1,329,000 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new sixty (60) month term contract. Approval is also requested to add vendors that may become pre-qualified during the term of the contract. Pre-Qualification contracts allow for the addition of new vendors during the full term of the contract. This term contract has no renewal options. Awardees are located in Palm Beach County. No S/M/WBE vendor submitted a bid on this project. This item was reviewed by the OEBO and a SBE Price Preference was approved.

The County has expended or encumbered \$14,093,224 (\$237,860/month) during the previous fifty-nine and one quarter (59.25) months of the current sixty (60) month term contract. \$14,625,810 is needed to meet the County's requirements through the expiration of this new sixty (60) month term contract. Approval is also requested to add vendors that may become pre-qualified during the term of the contract. Pre-Qualification contracts allow for the addition of new vendors during the full term of the contract. This term contract has no renewal options. Two (2) Awardees are located in Palm Beach County, five (5) Awardees are located out of State, and three (3) Awardees are located outside Palm Beach County in the cities of Pompano Beach, Tampa, and Miami, Florida. No S/M/WBE vendor submitted a bid on this project. This item was reviewed by the OEBO and a waiver of API requirements was approved.

The County has expended or encumbered \$1,778,974 (\$77,347/month) during the previous twenty-three (23) months of the current twenty-four (24) month term contract. This revenue generating contract is anticipated to generate \$69,630,000 during this new thirty-six (36) month term contract. Of this amount, the contractor will be paid three point five percent (3.5%) of the non-Medicaid gross monthly collections plus an annual flat fee of \$81,500, which is estimated to be a total of \$244,500 (\$74,488/month). This term contract has two (2) twelve (12) month renewal options. Awardee is located out of State. The original contract was established by a competitive RFP process that allowed up to ten (10) points for S/M/WBE participation. Awardee is a non-SBE vendor utilizing an SBE subcontractor. This item was reviewed by the OEBO and a goal of 15% SBE subcontractor and up to 15 evaluation points for M/WBE participation was approved.
