I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: a Subrecipient Agreement for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) with Heart, Health and Healing Ministries, Inc., for the period December 1, 2020 through February 28, 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$23,210, for the provision of psychosocial support services for persons with HIV/AIDS.

Summary: Heart, Health and Healing Ministries, Inc. (HHH) is a new agency that provided psychosocial support services to 20 Ryan White clients. This funding allowed the Community Services Department to continue funding much needed medical and support services to Palm Beach County residents with HIV/AIDS, including priority minority populations through the Minority AIDS Initiative (MAI). Clients were assisted with accessing and navigating Ryan White systems. Health Service Representatives provided clients with social support. The Director of Purchasing has authority to execute this agreement pursuant to section 2-54(f)(4) of the Palm Beach County Code. In accordance with County PPM CW-0-051, all delegated contacts, agreements, and grants must be submitted by the initiating Department as a receive and file agenda item. **No County match is required.** (Ryan White Program) <u>Countywide</u> (HH)

Background and Justification: Palm Beach County Board of County commissioners has been receiving this grant since 1994, and has assisted thousands of persons with HIV/AIDS with medical and support services.
