While the Palm Springs Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) was created at the end of 2019 and did not receive tax increment revenue until Fiscal Year 2021, special districts are to comply with statutory reporting requirements. Pursuant to Chapter 163.371, Florida Statutes, a CRA is to file an annual report by March 31st of each year with the local governing body (the Village Council) and publish the report on the agency's website.

Under this cover, the Palm Springs CRA Annual Report for 2020 is being transmitted to the Village Council. As a newly created CRA with no money, as of yet, in the Redevelopment Trust Fund, an audit report and annual financial report are not required.

The Palm Springs CRA looks forward to initiating redevelopment strategies to revitalize the Congress Avenue and Lake Worth Road corridors within the Village.
