I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: four (4) Grant Adjustment Modifications (GAM) with the US Department of Justice (DOJ), Office on Violence Against Women (OVW), Grants to Improve Criminal Justice Response Program (ICJR) (2017-WE-AX-0034), which facilitated administrative filing and approvals through December 31, 2021 as follows:

- 1) #68244: Training Materials;
- 2) #68245: Budget Modification;
- 3) #68246: Project Period Extension; and
- 4) #68248: Grantee Advocate Change

Summary: As per grant guidelines, certain expenditures and work products require approval from the OVW ICJR grant manager. The approval process is facilitated by drafting a GAM and submitting it through the OVW's JustGrants Grant Management web portal. 1) GAM #68244 approved the "Teal Tag" work product. The Teal Tag will be used to train hospital emergency department physicians on the services available to victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking who may enter their emergency room as a result of these crimes. The Teal Tag is designed to act as a badge buddy that can be attached behind hospital staff's identification badges and utilized as a quick reference guide to contact PBC Victim Services when encountering victims of these crimes. 2) GAM #68245 denied a budget modification to add an additional Consultant Contract for contracted therapy services. The Grant Manager denied the request due to the old Grants Management System being phased out and no new GAMs were being reviewed during the time of transition to the new system. 3) GAM #68246 approved a one-year no-cost extension of the award period. The award period will now end September 30, 2021. 4) GAM #68248 approved the Grantee Advocate Change from Carrie Gale to Tessa Jacobson. R2014-1633 authorized the County Administrator or designee to execute future awards, contracts, sub-recipient agreements and sub contracts and amendments/modifications utilizing funding from the DOJ, OVW on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners. **Countywide** (JW)

Background and Justification: The DOJ, OVW awarded Palm Beach County funding in the amount of \$900,000 through the Improving Criminal Justice Responses Program for the project period October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2020. The award was extended through September 30, 2021. The focus of the grant is to increase collaboration among responders, build capacity for the Sexual Assault Response Team, and reach underserved populations. In order to meet this need, Palm Beach County Victim Services collaborated with Aid to Victims of Domestic Abuse, Inc., Catholic Charities Diocese of Palm Beach, Inc., Coalition for Independent Living Options, Inc., and Destiny by Choice, Inc. to maintain services and strengthen our community's coordinated response to victims of sexual violence, domestic violence, dating violence and stalking, especially in underserved marginalized communities.

Justification

The "Teal Tag" is a work product used to address Goal 1, Objective 1: Increase support by strengthening legal advocacy service programs and other victim services for victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking - provide legal advocacy and therapy services. The Teal Tag will be used to train hospital emergency department physicians on the services available to victims of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking who may enter their emergency rooms as a result of these crimes. Victim-centered best practices on the reverse side of the Teal have been simplified for physicians to reference when treating victims of these crimes. The best practices highlight topics such as victim blaming, behavior of victims, a victim' s sense of control, and showing compassion. The Teal Tag is designed to act as a badge buddy that can be attached behind hospital staff' s identification badges and will be utilized as a quick reference guide to contact Palm Beach County Victim Services when encountering victims of these crimes. The Teal Tag will be provided to emergency department physicians and nurses who complete a Palm Beach County Victim Services SART training provided by our SANE Program Coordinator and Victim Services staff.

This budget modification is needed to add an additional Consultant Contract for contracted therapy services. Due to COVID-19, our program has seen an increase in individual and crisis therapy sessions in the past 120 days as many victims are forced to quarantine with their abusers. Victims' symptoms are acute and need immediate trauma-focused therapy. We are unable to meet the current demand therefore, these additional therapy services are requested as part of the contractual budget. The proposed consultant has already been approved through our purchasing vendor approval process and is able to deliver services upon OVW approval.
