Summary: On June 19, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the architectural services continuing contracts for projects funded in whole or in part from federal funds. On June 16, 2020, the Board approved Amendment No. 1 (R2020-0656 thru 2020-0657), which authorized an extension of the term of these continuing contracts through June 18, 2021. Amendment No. 2 extends the term of these continuing contracts for architectural services for projects that are federally funded through June 12, 2022. To date, the firms have been awarded a cumulative value of \$114,025.77 in task authorizations. The original contract provided for an initial term of two (2) years with three (3) renewal options each for a period of one (1) year. Amendment No. 2 will implement the second renewal option of these contracts through June 18, 2022 with a cumulative limit of \$700,000 for the twelve-month extension in order to accommodate additional anticipated new projects. Additionally, Amendment No. 2 incorporates the County's standard language regarding "E-Verify-Employment Eligibility" and modifies the hourly rate schedule for each consultant. Work is authorized through individual task assignments when required during the term of these continuing contracts. Projects under these continuing contracts may be funded in whole or in part by federal grants from the United States (US) Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, grants from the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant Program or grants or reimbursements from Department of Homeland Security (DHS)/Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). This contract is exempt from the Equal Business Opportunity (EBO) Ordinance pursuant to section 2-80.22 thereof. (Capital Improvements) **Countywide (LDC)**

Background & Justification: On April 2, 2018, the selection of the consultants was performed under Board adopted procedures, pursuant to the Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) Florida Statute 287.055 and in accordance with the Federal Brooks Act. Two (2) firms were selected for these services. The Amendments will renew the contracts for the second renewal year of the contract. It is the consensus of Facilities Development & Operations Department that these firms have successfully provided the professional services required for this continuing contract. Both firms are in good standing and wish to continue to provide professional services.

AMENDMENT No. 2 TO CONTINUING CONTRACT FOR DESIGN SERVICES (Federal Funds)

This is Amendment No. 2 dated _______to the Contract (R2018-0904) dated June 19, 2018, as previously amended by Amendment No. 1 (R2020-0656) dated June 16, 2020 (collectively the "Contract") by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY and Colome & Associates, Inc., a corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the CONSULTANT.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into the Contract under which the CONSULTANT provided certain professional services to the COUNTY for various projects in accordance with the Brooks Act, the Consultants Competitive Negotiations Act (CCNA) FS 287.055 and County policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend the Contract to extend it for an additional one (1) year period from June 19, 2021 through June 18, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth and for such other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which the parties hereto expressly acknowledge, the parties covenant and agree to the following terms and conditions:

- The term of this Contract is renewed for one (1) additional year through June 18, 2022.
- 2. CONSULTANT certifies that it is still in compliance with the requirements pertaining to scrutinized companies under Florida Statutes Section 287.135.

3. The Contract is modified as follows:

a. The following provision is added to the Contract:

E-VERIFY - EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

CONSULTANT warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), and beginning January 1, 2021, uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the CONSULTANT's subconsultants performing any duties and obligations under this Contract are registered with the E-Verify System and beginning January 1, 2021, use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

CONSULTANT shall obtain from each of its subconsultants an affidavit stating that the subconsultant does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an Unauthorized Alien, as that term is defined in section 448.095(1)(k), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. CONSULTANT shall maintain a copy of any such affidavit from a subconsultant for, at a minimum, the duration of the subcontract and any extension thereof. This provision shall not supersede any provision of this Contract which requires a longer retention period.

COUNTY shall terminate this Contract if it has a good faith belief that CONSULTANT has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.

If COUNTY has a good faith belief that CONSULTANT's subconsultant has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, COUNTY shall notify CONSULTANT to terminate its contract with the subconsultant and CONSULTANT shall immediately terminate its contract with the subconsultant.

If COUNTY terminates this Contract pursuant to the above, CONSULTANT shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by COUNTY for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Contract was terminated. In the event of such contract termination, CONSULTANT shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by COUNTY as a result of the termination.

b. Exhibit B to the Contract is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Exhibit B.1 attached hereto and incorporated herein.

4. Except as specifically modified above, the terms and conditions of the Contract

including the Federal Requirements are hereby confirmed and remain in full force

and effect.

This is Amendment No. 2 dated _______to the Contract (R2018-0905) dated June 19, 2018, as previously amended by Amendment No. 1 (R2020-0657) dated June 16, 2020 (collectively the "Contract") by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY and Williamson Dacar Associates Inc., a corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the CONSULTANT.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into the Contract under which the CONSULTANT provided certain professional services to the COUNTY for various projects in accordance with the Brooks Act, the Consultants Competitive Negotiations Act (CCNA) FS 287.055 and County policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend the Contract to extend it for an additional one (1) year period from June 19, 2021 through June 18, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants hereinafter set forth and for such other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which the parties hereto expressly acknowledge, the parties covenant and agree to the following terms and conditions:

- The term of this Contract is renewed for one (1) additional year through June 18, 2022.
- 2. CONSULTANT certifies that it is still in compliance with the requirements pertaining to scrutinized companies under Florida Statutes Section 287.135.

3. The Contract is modified as follows:

a. The following provision is added to the Contract:

E-VERIFY - EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY

CONSULTANT warrants and represents that it is in compliance with section 448.095, Florida Statutes, as may be amended, and that it: (1) is registered with the E-Verify System (E-Verify.gov), and beginning January 1, 2021, uses the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers; and (2) has verified that all of the CONSULTANT's subconsultants performing any duties and obligations under this Contract are registered with the E-Verify System and beginning January 1, 2021, use the E-Verify System to electronically verify the employment eligibility of all newly hired workers.

CONSULTANT shall obtain from each of its subconsultants an affidavit stating that the subconsultant does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with an Unauthorized Alien, as that term is defined in section 448.095(1)(k), Florida Statutes, as may be amended. CONSULTANT shall maintain a copy of any such affidavit from a subconsultant for, at a minimum, the duration of the subcontract and any extension thereof. This provision shall not supersede any provision of this Contract which requires a longer retention period.

COUNTY shall terminate this Contract if it has a good faith belief that CONSULTANT has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes as may be amended.

If COUNTY has a good faith belief that CONSULTANT's subconsultant has knowingly violated Section 448.09(1), Florida Statutes, as may be amended, COUNTY shall notify CONSULTANT to terminate its contract with the subconsultant and CONSULTANT shall immediately terminate its contract with the subconsultant.

If COUNTY terminates this Contract pursuant to the above, CONSULTANT shall be barred from being awarded a future contract by COUNTY for a period of one (1) year from the date on which this Contract was terminated. In the event of such contract termination, CONSULTANT shall also be liable for any additional costs incurred by COUNTY as a result of the termination.

b. Exhibit B to the Contract is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Exhibit B.1 attached hereto and incorporated herein.

4. Except as specifically modified above, the terms and conditions of the Contract

including the Federal Requirements are hereby confirmed and remain in full force

and effect.
